NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

2026 has been a roller coaster for Omaha, with the Storm Chasers currently playing some of their best baseball this season.

Of 18 series this year, the Chasers have won 7, lost 8 and split 4 ... the Storm Chasers have gone unbeaten their last 3 series, with wins over Lehigh Valley and Salt Lake and a split with St. Paul.

Month by month, the Chasers went 13-12 in April, 13-14 in May, and 10-15 in June ... their first back-to-back losing months since May/June 2025 ... July was a turnaround: at 14-10, Omaha had the club's second winning month this season.

Since the All-Star Break, Omaha has gone 12-5 (.706 win %) ... Omaha's 12 wins since July 17 are tied for the 2nd-most in the International League, tied 5th-most in the Minor Leagues.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Chasers have 30 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 31 losses this year.

30 comeback wins are tied 3rd-most in the International League, tied 5th-most in Triple-A and tied 14th-most in the Minor Leagues ... Omaha's 31 blown leads rank 3rd in the International League, 5th in Triple-A and tied 11th in the Minors.

Over the last 74 games (since May 9), Omaha is 36-38 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 24 of their 36 wins in that stretch, and led at some point in 21 of their 38 losses ... meaning 45 of Omaha's last 74 games (61%) have featured a comeback from the eventual winner ... it's also been a tight stretch overall: 48 of those 74 games (65%) have been decided by 3 runs or fewer.

7 of Omaha's last 14 wins have been comebacks, with the Chasers trailing for at least 2.0 innings in 5 of them and overcoming multiple deficits in 4 ... over the last 6 comeback wins, Omaha has erased 10 separate deficits.

CROSS ME UP

Gavin Cross had one of the league's slowest starts to the season, but has heated up with the weather as the season has gone on.

Over his first 36 games (March 27 to May 15), Cross hit just .128 (15-for-117) ... but in his last 61 games (since May 16), he's hitting .305 (69-for-226), with 26 extra-base hits and 36 RBI, with 21 multi-hit games, including 11 of his last 22 games.

From July 2 to 28, Cross hit safely in a career-best 19 straight games, the International League's longest hitting streak this season and Omaha's longest since 2018, a stretch where he hit .370 (30-for-81) with 16 extra-base hits, 21 RBI and a 1.178 OPS ... additionally, Cross homered in a club record 6 straight games, July 22 to 28, the first Minor Leaguer to do so since 2024 ... he drove in a run in 8 straight games, July 22 to 31 and scored a run in 8 straight, July 19 to 28.

In July, Cross led the International League in total bases (64), while tied 2nd in home runs (7) and ranking 3rd last month in RBI (23) and tied 6th in hits (31).

HONEST ABE

Abraham Toro started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May.

Toro hit just .189 (21-for-111) from March 27 to May 10, but since May 12, he has a .326 average (72-for-221) ... since May 12, he ranks 1st among qualifiers in the International League in OPS (1.009), 2nd in SLG (.615) and 4th in AVG (.326) ... his 51 RBI over 59 games since May 12 rank tied for the 6th-most in the league.

Overall in 2026, he ranks tied 5th in the IL in RBI (66) and extra-base hits (43), 6th in total bases (178), 9th in SLG (.536) and tied 9th in homers (19).

SUMMER HEAT

A pair of Storm Chasers bats have especially been performing well in recent weeks.

In his last 32 games (since June 21), Brett Squires is slashing .305/.386/.602 (36-for-118) with 26 RBI ... from June 16 to July 2, he hit safely in a career-best 14 games, Omaha's 2nd-longest hitting streak this season.

Since returning to Omaha's lineup on June 18, Brandon Drury has reached base in 23 of 25 games played and is slashing .276/.422/.506 (24-for-87) with 24 RBI and 21 walks to 18 strikeouts.

HITTERS HEAVEN

The Storm Chasers were on an offensive turnaround during the month of July, seeing some of the biggest success throughout the season.

Since July 9, Omaha has had 10+ hits in 11 of 21 games (52%), and have won the last 10 games with 10+ hits ... before this 20-game stretch, the Chasers had 10+ hits in just 30 of its 88 games (34%), and won 20 of 30 double-digit hit games.

In the month of July, the Storm Chasers batted .283 (234-for-828) as a team, which ranked 2nd in the International League ... Omaha also ranked 1st in total bases (392) and hits (234) and 2nd in OPS (.832), SLG (.473) and runs scored (144).
