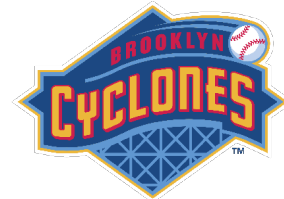

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones swept Saturday's single-admission doubleheader, beating Wilmington 1-0 in eight innings in game one and 4-1 in game two. In the opener, LHP **Nick Zwack** and LHP **Mitchell Parker** each traded zeros over the first six innings. Zwack tossed six scoreless with three strikeouts and no walk. OF **Rowdey Jordan** drove in the ghost runner in the top of the eighth and RHP **Justin Courtney** slammed the door in the bottom of the inning. In the nightcap, home runs from C **Nic Gaddis** and OF **Tanner Murphy**, along with RHP **Garrison Bryant's** six innings of one-run ball, sent the Clones to a game to win.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs in Coney Island, Brooklyn has completely turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 24 home runs in the past 28 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

FIRST HALF CLOSING: The first half of the season ends next Thursday, June 23 during the six-game series with the Jersey Shore BlueClaws. The second half begins on Friday, June 24th. Aberdeen clinched the first half division title on Wednesday night, beating Jersey Shore. The first half division winners in the North and the South clinch a playoff berth against the winners of the second half. In case of a repeat winner at the top of the division, the team in that division with the best full season record is awarded the playoff spot.

BYE-BYE BMAC: OF **Brandon McIlwain** earned a promotion to Double-A Binghamton Saturday. Prior to his call-up, he had been on base in 21 of his past 23 games and 14 straight. Since April 30th, McIlwain was hitting .330 with a .430 OBP in 35 games.

THANKS, FOG!: This week, the Cyclones and Blue Rocks are playing eight games in six days, playing

In that series, Wilmington won three of the four games played, winning Tuesday, twice on Sunday, and losing Wednesday.

GRRR-ERRERA: Watertown, CT native OF **Justin Guerrero**, who attended Fairfield University, earned the promotion from Low-A St. Lucie on June 10. Guerrero earned All-MAAC First Team honors and Fairfield University Male Athlete of the Year in 2021 before being selected by the Mets in the 20th round.

ROUGH N' ROWDEY: OF **Rowdey Jordan**, the Mets' 11th-round selection out of Mississippi State leads the team with 74 total bases and 16 doubles to lead the entire Mets organization.

PALMER'S POP: Brooklyn native OF **Jaylen Palmer**, the team's top prospect according to *MLB Pipeline* (No. 14), leads the club with six home runs, including a grand slam to win the game last Sunday against Aberdeen. His career high is seven home runs which game during his second professional season in 2019, playing with Rookie-level Kingsport.

'CLONES ON THE RISE: OF **Jake Mangum** and INF **Luke Ritter**, two Cyclones from both the 2019 and 2021 clubs, are now with Triple-A Syracuse.

MORE-ENO: Luis Moreno makes his second start at High-A and third South Atlantic League appearance.

WELCOME: Moreno earned the promotion on Wednesday, June 1 coming to Brooklyn with fellow St. Lucie Mets pitcher LHP Nathan Lavender. The promotions from RHP Hunter Parsons and RHP Jordan Yamamoto to Double-A Binghamton made room for two new arms.

BIG YEAR: The Dominican righty has made three starts and six relief appearances with Low-A St. Lucie, striking out eight over six innings in relief against the Daytona Tortugas on May 31 before the promotion. Moreno tossed consecutive outings which would qualify as “quality starts.”

2022: With St. Lucie, Moreno posted a 3.56 FIP and a 2.68 ERA with a 22% strikeout rate and a 12% walk rate, compiling 40 1/3 innings in the Florida State League.

ELIMINATING HOMERS: Moreno’s 2021 season with Low-A St. Lucie featured nine home runs allowed in 73 innings and 21 games, leading to a 6.20 FIP and 5.42 ERA. This season, Moreno allowed just one home run in 40 1/3 innings at the same level.

JUMP IN: Moreno signed with the New York Mets in June of 2019 at 20 years old. While young pitchers usually sign with teams at either 16 or 17 years old, Moreno signed and pitched with the DSL Mets1 and DSL Mets2 in 2019.
