#### Leading Off

The Fightin Phils continues a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, on Thursday. It is the third of 18 matchups between the teams this season, and first of 12 in Reading. The Fightin Phils won the season-series over Hartford in 2023, going 14-10.

#### Walking It Off, Literally

The Fightin Phils battled from behind to tie and eventually win over Hartford on Wednesday night, 4-3. With bases-loaded in the bottom of the ninth, Robert Moore worked a four-pitch walk to score Casey Martin and give Reading its second-straight win. It was Reading's first walk off win of the season after having five-walkoff wins last season. Reading also had a walk-off walk on July 26 of last season against Binghamton, when Jhailyn Ortiz drew the base on balls. Reading's bullpen remained hot in the win, not allowing an earned run over 4.2 IP, marking 8.2 innings of shutout ball for the releivers this week.

#### Taylor's Hot Streak Continues

Carson Taylor continues to pick up where he left off in April, after being named the Phillies Minor League HItter of the Month. On Tuesday, Taylor had two hits and another RBI with a runner in scoring position. Taylor is up to 25 RBI on the season, which ranks as the most in the Eastern League and tied for the best in all of Double-A. Taylor is also riding a 10-game on-base streak, and over his last five games, he's slashing .333/.500/.400, with a .900 OPS.

#### Lee Sang Rolling

Marcus Lee Sang's recent hot-stretch continued with a two-run home run on Tuesday. Over his last 12 games, dating back to Apr. 23, Lee Sang is slashing .317/.378/.732, with a 1.110 OPS. Over that stretch, Lee Sang has three doubles, one triple and four home runs, with 10 RBI. The stretch has propelled Lee Sang to first on the team in home runs and second in RBI. He also is riding an nine-game on-base streak, his longest of the season. Lee Sang has also found much success in the bottom of the lineup. When batting ninth this year, Lee Sang is hitting .316. In all other spots of the lineup, he's hitting .183.

#### On the Move

Reading has seen a bunch of roster movement lately. Last weekend, Beau Burrows and Jim Haley both earned promotions to Triple-A Lehigh Valley. Max Lazar joined them with a call-up prior to Wednesday's game. Other moves include Andrew Baker being transferred to High-A and Tyler McKay transferred to Reading from Triple-A Lehigh Valley. McKay saw much success with Reading last season, before a call-up to Lehigh Valley last July.

#### A Look at the Numbers

Reading has found most of its success this season during the first half of series. On Tuesday-Thursday, the Fightin Phils hold an 8-4 record. But, on Friday-Sunday, Reading is just 5-12. Additionally, Wednesday night was Reading's second win of the season when scoring less than five runs. The Fightin Phils are 11-1 when scoring north of five runs, and 2-15 when failing to reach the five-run mark.

#### Extra Extra Read All About It

Wednesday night, Jose Rodriguez tripled, marking the second-straight game with an extra-base hit for him, as he had two doubles on Tuesday. Carlos De La Cruz had a double off the center field wall, marking his first extra-base hit sine Apr. 7, and second this season. Ethan Wilson also legged out a hustle double in last night's win for his first extr-base hit of the season.

#### The Goat

Hartford enters today with a 14-12 record, which is third in the Northeast Division. The Yard Gosts continue a two-week road trip after going 2-3 at Binghamton last week. They won the first two games, before dropping the last three, and Sunday was cancelled. After this week, Hartford returns home and welcomes New Hampshire. Last season, Hartford finished with an Eastern League-worst 57-76 record. The Yard Goats roster includes nine of the Rockies top-30 prospects, featuring No. 1 Adael Amador and No. 3 Yanquiel Fernandez.

#### Goat on the Bump

Righty Jarrod Cande makes the start tonight for Hartford. It will be Cande's sixth start of the season, and he is 2-1, with a 3.86 ERA (23.1 IP, 20 H, 11 BB, 25 SO). He last pitched May 2 at Binghamton, sufferering the loss. But, he allowed just one hit and one-earned run over 5.1 innings, with six strikeouts. Cande spent all of 2023 with High-A Spokane, going 4-4, with a 3.25 ERA. He pitched for Single-A Fresno in 2022 and made his pro debut with the ACL-Rockies in 2021. The 24-year old was drafted by the Rockies in the 17th round of the 2021 draft out of Florida Southern. Cande spent 2020 and '21 at Florida Southern and began his college career at Santa Fe College in Gainesville from 2018-19. He was a 2017 graduate of Hillsborough High School, just outside of Tampa, Florida.
