**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Curve, 9-7. **Nick Sincola** started and threw three scoreless innings. **Wade Meckler** opened the scoring with an RBI single in the third and **Will Wilson** followed with a two-run single later in the inning. In the fifth, Wilson brought home a run with a sac fly to open a 4-0 lead. **Matt Higgins** hit a two-run double and later scored on a single by **Turner Hill** to open a 7-0 lead in the top of the seventh. The Curve scored seven runs in the seventh to tie the game. Brenden Dixon hit a RBI single, Kervin Pichardo added an RBI hit, Sammy Siami hit a two-run single, Nick Cimillo plated a run with a hit, Tres Gonzalez hit an RBI double and Dustin Peterson tied the score with a sac fly. In the eighth, Cimillo hit a go-ahead single and Gonzalez brought in another with a sac bunt to open a 9-7 lead.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, in the third of a sixgame series at PNG Field. This is the first of two trips to Altoona for Richmond this year. The Flying Squirrels won two-of-six at The Diamond from June 4-9, dropping the final four games of the series. The Curve also return to Richmond for a six-game set from August 20-25 and the Flying Squirrels close the regular season in Altoona from September 10-15.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 4-10 in their last 14 games dating back to July 13 after winning their previous four games. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .228 and averaging 3.75 runs per game (191 runs/51 games) at home compared to a .235 batting average and 4.68 runs per game on the road (220 runs/47 games). The Flying Squirrels are 11-7 in their last 18 road games since June 12. Richmond is 8-17 in its last 25 home games dating back to June 6.

**THE CURVE** are 3-8 in their last 11 games since July 19 after going 9-1 in their previous 10 games from July 3-11. Altoona's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 1), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 5), INF/OF Charles McAdoo (No. 12), INF Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 13) and LHP Hunter Barco (No. 16). MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list includes seven Altoona players, including Chandler (No. 1), Harrington (No. 6), Cheng (No. 8), Barco (No. 13), OF Jase Bowen (No. 19), OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 26) and McAdoo (No. 29).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Seth Lonsway** makes his fifth Double-A start and sixth appearance. Last time out, he worked five scoreless innings and struck out six against the Rumble Ponies on Friday night at The Diamond in a win, lowering his season ERA with Richmond to 1.69. He has not allowed a run in his last three outings dating back to July 10, spanning 15.2 innings. Among full-season Giants minor league pitchers, Lonsway ranks third in ERA (3.21), third in WHIP (1.25), fourth in innings pitched (89.2), eighth in BAA (.253) and 10th in strikeouts (79). All five earned runs he has allowed at Double-A scored in the third inning during his start on July 3 at Bowie. In his debut on June 28, he threw six scoreless innings and allowed four hits with five strikeouts against the Patriots at The Diamond. It was the first six-inning scoreless debut for the Flying Squirrels since **Conner Menez** in 2018. In his final four High-A starts from June 128, Lonsway posted a 2.95 ERA (7 ER/211 IP). Lonsway pitched at Ohio State before being selected in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Giants. He was also selected by the Reds in the 2017 MLB Draft out of high school but did not sign. Lonsway spent last season with Eugene and went 2-9 with a 5.87 ERA in 28 outings, including 17 starts. *For more on Lonsway, see page two*.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander Emmanuel Chapman makes his second start of the season and his 15th appearance at Double-A. He last pitched on Sunday at Erie and allowed four runs over three innings. In his previous three outings, he had worked 8.2 combined innings without allowing a run from July 10-24. Chapman signed a free agent with the Pirates in December. He began the season with High-A Greensboro and went 2-0 with a 3.00 ERA in 12 appearances. He was promoted to Double-A on May 28. Prior to signing with the Pirates, he pitched three seasons in the Cuban National Series 59 dating back to 2019.

**DEADLINE DEALS:** The MLB trade deadline was Tuesday at 6 p.m. and Flying Squirrels reliever **Eric Silva** was traded to the Detroit Tigers for Mark Canha and will join the Erie SeaWolves. Silva became the fifth player all time traded from the Flying Squirrels at trade deadline time. The most recent deadline day trades directly impacting the Flying Squirrels were in 2021. That year, pitcher **Caleb Kilian** was traded to the Cubs as part of a deal for Kris Bryant and reliever **Jose Marte** was sent to the Angels as part of a package for Tony Watson. In 2012, catcher **Tommy Joseph** was traded from the Flying Squirrels along with two other players to the Phillies for Hunter Pence. In 2010, pitcher Daniel Turpen was swapped to the Red Sox for Ramon Ramirez. Current Flying Squirrels catcher **Andy Thomas** was a trade deadline acquisition for the Giants along with reliever **Michael Stryffeler** in 2022 for Matthew Boyd and Curt Casali. In 2022, **Tristan Peters** became the only players sent straight to Richmond after being traded at the deadline when he was picked up from the Brewers for Trevor Rosenthal.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Flying Squirrels have turned 70 double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Altoona is ranked second with 68. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 15 double plays this year, which is the most in the league, ahead of three pitchers tied for second with 11, including Altoona's Po-Yu Chen. It is also the second-most in the minors. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on Saturday night against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. On July 10 against the Sentors, **Seth Lonsway** induced three double plays, which is tied for the most by one pitcher in a game in the league this year. Bertrand matched that with three double plays behind him on July 19 against the RubberDucks.

**GO, DIEGO, GO!:** On Friday in his second Double-A game, **Di-ego Velasquez** hit a solo home run in the fourth inning for his first Double-A hit. He finished the night with three hits, adding an RBI single in the eighth inning. In his debut last Thursday, he walked twice and added a sacrifice bunt. Between Richmond and High-A Eugene this year, Velasquez has hit .275, which is fifth-best in the Giants organization. He is also ranked fourth in hits (80), fourth in stolen bases (18), tied for sixth in doubles (17), tied for sixth in triples (3), ninth in OBP (.358), ninth in SLG (.395), ninth in OPS (.753) and 10th in total bases (115). With his debut on July 24, Velasquez became the sixth-youngest player in Flying Squirrels history, the ninth player to debut for Richmond at age 20 or younger and the first player in team history born in 2003. On Saturday night, he made a diving stop to begin a double play that landed at No. 3 on ESPN's SportsCenter Top 10 Plays.

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 40 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .312 (49-for-157) with three homers, eight doubles, eight walks and 18 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he has not homered in his last 30 games. In his last 50 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .302 (57-for-189) with six homers, nine doubles, 14 walks and 27 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 14-of-32 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .312 (38-for-122) in that stretch.

**RETURN OF THE MECK:** In his 10 games with Richmond this year, **Wade Meckler** has picked up 12 hits, batting .324 (12-for-37). He first reached the Flying Squirrels last season and batted .336 (50-for-149) over 39 games, which as the third-highest average in the league (min. 170 PA) for the year. He hit .371 (115-for-310) in the minors last year, which was the highest in MiLB (min. 350 PA). It was the second straight year that a Flying Squirrels player led the minors in batting average, with **Vaun Brown** topping the charts (min. 350 PA) with a .346 average in 2022.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked eighth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,653), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Two of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Wade Meckler** (No. 12) and SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Meckler is rated the best hitter for average and best strike-zone discipline and LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including McDonald (No. 12), Meckler (No. 16), Velasquez (No. 18), OF/1B **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).
