Giving up one run (earned) on four hits, two hit batsmen and a walk, he struck out five on 92 pitches (56 strikes). Patrick is the first Sounds pitcher to reach three quality starts this season - he has not received a decision in any of them.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** This is Patrick's first start against Jacksonville.
