NOTES AND NUGGETS

DON'T STOP ME NOW

Saturday's 23-7 win over the Clippers has an argument for the best offensive game in the Storm Chasers era of the Triple-A Omaha franchise (since 2011) and one of the best in modern Omaha era (Since 2005)

- 10 home runs set a new modern franchise record ... this outburst passed Omaha's previous modern franchise record of 9, set on July 4, 2022 vs. Toledo ... the Storm Chasers are just the 4th full season Minor League team since 2005 to hit 10+ homers in a game, the first Triple-A team since 2019 (Las Vegas, 7/26/19 @ El Paso) ... the July 4, 2022 game was also the last time multiple Omaha players hit multiple homers in the same game, 3 had 2-homer games yesterday.
- 23 runs in a game in the most in the Storm Chasers era ... it tied a modern era franchise record, matching a 23-5 win over the Round Rock Express on August 30, 2010 ... 23 runs is the most a Triple-A team has scored in a game this season, the 3rd-most scored by a full-season affiliate (Greensboro, 8/9/25 @ Asheville).
- Switch-hitting outfielder **Drew Waters** hit 2 home runs, one from each side of the plate ... he's the first Triple-A Omaha player to homer from both sides of the plate in the same game since **Tim Raines Jr.** on August 20, 2009 @ Tacoma ... in that game, Raines hit a right-handed solo shot in the 4th inning, followed by a 3-run left-handed homer in the 8th ... Waters' 2 homers combined to travel 887 feet, the furthest combined distance from a Storm Chaser hitter's 2-homer game since Statcast tracking was introduced to the IL in 2023.

2ND HALF SLUGGERS

While Omaha has had a slow start to the 2nd half, a few hitters have had a hot start offensively to the back half of the season.

- Harold Castro is hitting .306 (53-for-173) since June 24 ... he leads the team with 53 hits, 96 total bases, 12 home runs and 36 RBI this half. acstro was just named the IL's Player of the Week for the 2nd week in a row. going 14-for-25 (.560) with 3 HR & 14 RBI last week in the Chasers' series against Columbus.
- MJ Melendez is hitting .296 (45-for-152) in the 2nd half and leads the team with 16 doubles ... he is 2nd on the team with 45 hits, 89 total bases and 21 walks, while tied 3rd with 23 RBI and 8 homers.
- Carter Jensen joined Omaha for the 2nd half and despite a slow start, he has hit 11 homers with 31 RBI since arriving ... 21 of his 37 hits have gone for extrabases (9 doubles, 1 triple & 11 homers), for 81 total bases ... his 26 walks lead the team, while batting .272 (37-for-136) with the Chasers.

HITTIN' HAROLD

- Storm Chasers infielder **Harold Castro** is having one of the best offensive months by an International Leaguer this year.

 Castro has a case to be the IL's Player of the Month in August, as he's hitting .467 (35-for-75) this month, with a league-best 35 hits, 68 total bases, 9 homers and 25 runs batted in ... among full season Minor Leaguers, he's 1st in total bases, 2nd in hits and home runs and tied 2nd in runs batted in.

 In 11 games since August 9, he's 25-for-47 at the plate (.532 average) with 22 RBI ... in this stretch, he has 10 multi-hit games with an RBI in every game ... he has homered 7 times in the last 11 games with 6 multi-RBI games.
- From August 9 to 20, Castro recorded multiple hits in 7 straight games, with an RBI in all 7 games as well ... in that stretch he went 16-for-30 (.533) with 1 double, 1 triple, 5 homers and 12 runs batted in ... 7 consecutive multi-hit games tied a modern Omaha franchise record (since 2005) ... Nick Loftin did so last year, hitting .517 (15-for-29) between August 3 and 10.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

The Storm Chasers are not near the league lead in stolen bases, but Omaha has

- one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

 Omaha has successfully stolen 148 bases this year, and only been caught 27 times on Tuesday ... 148 steals rank tied 7th in the International League and tied 12th in Triple-A.
- 147-for-175 in steal attempts is a 84.6% success rate, the 2nd-best stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 6th among the 120 full-season Minor League teams (1st: South Bend Cubs, 85.6%, 219-for-256).

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha has played many close games this season ... with incredible success recently.

- Last Friday marked the Storm Chasers' 11th 1-run win this year... Omaha is 11-19 in 1-run games this year, including 8-0 in their last 8 games that have been decided by 1 run, after starting the year 3-19 in 1-run games.
- On August 5, the Storm Chasers snapped a stretch of nearly 2 months without winning a 1-run game ... Omaha had lost its last 10 games that were decided by 1 run, then beat Indianapolis in extras and have now won 8 straight..
- Last Friday was Omaha's 29th "comeback" win of the year, a win after trailing at any point in the game ... it was the 14th time winning while trailing for more than 2 innings ... August 17 was the 8th time winning after trailing for half the game.

A Kansas City area native who went to Blue Valley Southwest (Kan.) High School, Kudrna won Kansas baseball Gatorade Player of the Year honors as a senior as his Draft stock climbed. He was a Louisiana State commit but decided to go pro when the Royals selected him No. 43 overall in the 2021 Draft and gave him an over-slot \$3 million. He's had a steady climb in the Minor Leagues, reaching Double-A in 2024, his third full season of pro ball. Kudrna threw 115 1/3 innings between two levels last year, with a 3.49 ERA at High-A (14 starts) before the jump to Double-A, where he got hit around a bit more and posted a 5.32 ERA in nine appearances (eight starts).

Kudrna throws from a three-quarters arm slot and has always had solid strikeout and walk rates. His four-seam fastball sits at 92-95 mph, a few ticks down from his peak prep velocity, but he can flash in the upper 90s at times. He's bigger and stronger than he was in high school, but there still might be a bit more in the tank. The pitch was more vulnerable to slug at Double-A in '24, likely a result of command. Kudrna's best secondary pitch is his changeup, a plus to double-plus pitch that plays well off his fastball. He also features a mid-80s gyro slider with late bite, and consistency with the pitch was his biggest offseason focus. Kudrna introduced a two-seam fastball into his repertoire in 2024, a pitch that has the same velocity as his four-seam but with more run -- and something he's very comfortable throwing. something he's very comfortable throwing.

Kudrna's delivery is good overall, although the Royals targeted his hip-shoulder separation as needing to be more consistent, and he focused on that this past offseason too. His physical frame makes him a durable and reliable rotation arm, projecting as a back-end starter, although his velocity might tick up more if he's in the bullpen. He needs to adjust a little more to a higher level, so he'll head back to Double-A this year with a chance for a Triple-A promotion later in the season depending on performance.

Track Record: Kudrna and fellow 2021 draftee Carter Jensen were planning on attending LSU together until the Royals drafted the pair in back-to-back rounds. Kudrna signed for an over-slot \$3 million bonus, the largest handed out in the second round that year. After not pitching in an official game in his draft year, Kudrna has since moved steadily through the system, splitting 2024 between High-A Quad Cities and Double-A Northwest Arkansas. In both of his last two seasons, Kudrna has taken time to adjust to the higher level, so the higher 5.72 ERA at Double-A does not concern the Royals.

Scouting Report: Cudrna has a solid 6-foot-3 frame to which he's added strength since turning pro, but it's already a mature body, raising projection questions. He attacks hitters with a fourseam fastball that sits 91-95 mph with good carry. It touches 97, which is similar to his peak prep velocity, but with limited deception. Some wonder whether Kudrna's velocity would tick up in the bullpen. A newer pitch in his toolkit is a two-seam fastball with sinking action thrown at the same velocity as the four-seamer. He uses it as his fourth pitch to run in on righthanded batters and down and away to lefthanded batters. Kudrna relies heavily on a sharp 83-88 mph gyro slider with late bite and depth that he can throw for strikes. Kudrna's best secondary pitch is a changeup with sink that flashes plus, delivered at 84-88 mph with the same arm speed as his fastball. It plays against both righthanded and lefthanded hitters. The effort in Kudrna's delivery from a high three-quarters arm slot affects the consistency of his changeup.

The Future: With the upside projection of a No. 4 or 5 starter, Kudrna will return to Double-A for





Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game <u>since 2000</u>. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
