LAST TIME OUT: Wilmington swept Wednesday's doubleheader from Brooklyn...The Blue Rocks captured game one, 7-4, and game two, 7-1...C **Kevin Parada** picked up a pair of hits for the Cyclones in the opener, adding a 3-run double in the 7th...RHP **Robert Colina** (3.1 IP) and LHP **Quinn Brodey** (1.0) combined to hurl 4.1 innings of 2-hit shutout relief in the lid-lifter...C **Drake Osborn** provided Brooklyn's lone run in the nightcap with a solo home run in the 3rd...CF **Alex Ramirez** registered a multi-hit game in the finale...CF **James Wood** clubbed a 3-run home run for the Blue Rocks in their 7-run 2nd inning in the opener...RHP **Andry Lara** tossed 6.0 shutout innings for the win...LF **Jared McKenzie** and SS **Jordy Barley** delivered 2-run triples for Wilmington in the nightcap.

FEELING BULL-ISH: The Cyclones' bullpen has been dominant over the last 4 games...Dating back to Sunday, Brooklyn relief pitchers have permitted just 2 runs (1 earned) over 21.1 innings (0.42 ERA)...In that span, Cyclones relievers have surrendered just 10 hits, walked 7, and struck out 25...Entering play on Thursday, Brooklyn holds the 3rd-best bullpen ERA (3.66) in the South Atlantic League...Only Rome (3.44) and Wilmington's (3.66) relief arms have posted a better earned run average.

NEW MONTH, NEW MAN: C **Kevin Parada** has been on a tear since the calendar flipped to May...In 9 games during the season's second month, the 21-year-old is slashing .303/.378/.576 with a .954 OPS...Parada is 10-for-33 at the dish (.303) with 5 runs scored, 4 doubles, a triple, a home run, and 5 RBI...In that time frame, the Los Angeles native holds a .420 wOBA and a 148 wRC+...In the month of May, Parada is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (6) and doubles (4), tied for 5th in hits (10), and tied for 7th in total bases (19).

ALEX SMACKS: OF **Alex Ramirez** had his team-season-long 19-game on-base streak snapped in game one on Wednesday, but has reached in 20-of-21 games dating back to April 12...In that span, Ramirez is slashing .305/.380/.378 with a .758 OPS and a 110 wRC+...Alex is 25-for-82 at the dish with 9 runs scored, 4 extra-base hits, 1 home run, 14 RBI, 8 walks, and 4 stolen bases in 5 attempts...Since joining Brooklyn's roster on July 4 of last year, Ramirez leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (50), hits (91) and doubles (21)...He only trails teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** in extra-base hits (28) and is tied with him for the league-lead in total bases (132).

GEBER FEVER: RHP **Jordan Geber** has been dominant over his last 3 outings for Brooklyn...Since his first start of the season on April 22 vs. Wilmington, the 23-year-old holds a 1-0 record with a minuscule 0.64 ERA (1 ER in 14.0 IP) over 3 appearances...Geber has permitted only 5 hits and 2 walks, in addition to racking up 13 strikeouts...Since that date, Geber has the 3rd-lowest ERA (0.64) in the SAL among pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched...The right-hander's WHIP (0.50) is also the lowest in the circuit during that time frame (min. 10.0 IP).

ESTEP UP: INF **Chase Estep** has broken out of a major slump in a big way...Over a 9-game span between April 12 and May 2, the Corbin, Ky. native was 0-for-32 at the plate with 3 runs scored, an RBI, 3 walks, and 14 strikeouts...Estep ended that stretch with a towering 2-run home run to right field on Friday night...The former 9th-round pick out of Kentucky has reached base safely in each of his last 4 games...Estep is 5-for-his-last-13 (.385) with 4 runs scored, a double, a home run, 2 RBI, and 2 walks.

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: Brooklyn pitching did nothing but post zeroes on the scoreboard in Sunday's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...It was the Cyclones' first shutout victory of the season...It was Brooklyn's first shutout win since September 9, 2022, at Winston-Salem...RHP **Jeffrey Colón** (7.0 IP) and RHP **Daison Acosta** (2.0) combined on a 3-hit, 3-0 blanking of the Dash...It was the first for the Cyclones at Maimonides Park since August 5, 2022, also against Winston-Salem...LHP **Keyshawn Askew** (4.1), RHP **David Griffin** (3.2), and RHP **Dylan Hall** (1.0) united on a 6-hit, 2-0 victory.

PUNCHING TICKETS: Cyclones pitchers matched a season-best with 17 strikeouts vs. Aberdeen on Saturday afternoon...RHP **Joander Suárez** struck out a season-high 8...RHP **Benito García** (4), RHP **Jace Beck** (2), and LHP **Quinn Brodey** (3) each sat down multiple hitters...Brooklyn previously whiffed 17 batters at Winston-Salem on April 14...The 17 K's were the most for the 'Clones at Maimonides

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn heads south for a 6-game set against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks boast 5 of Washington's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...OF **James Wood** (1), OF **Jeremy De La Rosa** (8), OF **T.J. White** (10), RHP **Andry Lara** (15), and INF **Trey Lipscomb** (24)...The Cyclones went 13-14 in 27 matchups against Wilmington in 2022...Brooklyn held a 8-9 record at Frawley Stadium last year...The Blue Rocks captured 3-of-5 games from the Cyclones at Maimonides Park from April 18-22.

Park since Brooklyn punched out 18 batters — also against Aberdeen — on July 23, 2016, when both were members of the Short-Season New York-Penn League...RHP **Justin Dunn** (5), LHP **Kyle Regnault** (2), and RHP **Nabil Crismatt** (11) combined for the 18 K's.

STU-PENDOUS: RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent as any starting pitcher in the SAL in 2023...The 23-year-old punched out a career-high 9 batters over 5 innings in a no-decision last Tuesday vs. Aberdeen, adding 2.0 more shutout frames on Sunday...Entering Thursday, Stuart leads the league in ERA (1.74)...He is also 7th in batting average against (.200)...The right-hander is also 3rd in xFIP (3.20) and 4th in strikeout rate (35.3%) plus strikeouts per nine innings (13.06).

OMNIPRESENT OMAR: In addition to his 13 stolen bases in 14 attempts in 2023, OF **Omar De Los Santos** remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 83 stolen bases in that span, which is 4th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (90), Athletics OF **Esteury Ruiz** (85), and Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (85) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 49 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 34...Omar is already 19 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

DANIEL'S DOMINANCE: LHP **Daniel Juárez** has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 9 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 2-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted a run on 3 hits and 3 walks, striking out 13...In 14 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 13.2 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 22 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 4-0 with 8 hits allowed, 12 walks, and 28 strikeouts in 24.0 innings.

ATOP THE WONDER WHEEL: Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramirez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...INF **William Lugo** (27/26) and RHP **Christian Scott** (30/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.
