NOTAS Y NOTICIAS

THE BIRDS ARE BACK IN TOWN: The Hudson Valley Renegades welcome in the Aberdeen IronBirds for their third of four series meetings this season. The Renegades made their lone visit to Maryland earlier in May, splitting the series. After the six game set this week, the two sides won't face each other again until the end of August.

LAST TIME OUT: Eduardo Torrealba's go-ahead single in the eighth inning on Saturday night propelled the Renegades to a 3-2 victory over the Aberdeen IronBirds. The win snapped their season-long four-game losing streak. **Chase Hampton** allowed just two earned runs in a career-high 7.0 innings on the hill while striking out 10 batters which also tied his career-best. Hudson Valley trailed for the entire contest until they plated two in the eighth to take a 3-2 lead. **Ben Cowles** tallied an RBI single and **Aldenís Sánchez** hit a sacrifice fly to score the other two runs. **Jack Neely** faced the minimum in the ninth to earn his third save of the season.

REHAB-PALOOZA: On Tuesday, LHP **Josh Maciejewski** commenced a Minor League rehab assignment with the Renegades, becoming the second Minor League rehabber on the team, joining **C Josh Breaux**, who began his rehab on Saturday, May 27. This is the first time in the Yankees Era (2021-Present) that the Renegades have had two rehabbers on the team at the same time.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER: Hudson Valley's bullpen has been nails during the current series with Aberdeen. Across the first five games of the series, Renegades relievers have combined for a 0.86 ERA (21.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R/2 ER, 9 BB, 26 K). Between Wednesday and Friday night's games, the bullpen retired 20 consecutive batters at one point. Over the last 13.1 innings, the bullpen has allowed just three walks and one hit. Jacob Teter's single in the eighth inning on Saturday was the first IronBirds hit against the Renegades bullpen since his single in the seventh on Wednesday.

TEXAS SIZED: After punching out another 10 batters in his start on Saturday, Renegades starter **Chase Hampton** is now tied for 1st in the South Atlantic League in strikeouts with 69 in 41.1 IP. The Kilgore, TX native owns a 15.02 K/9 ratio that ranks 3rd in MiLB. Four of the Renegades' six starters rank Top 10 in the SAL in strikeouts.

BIG WINS AND LOSSES: The Renegades have already played in an extraordinary number of lopsided games this season, with 21 of the team's 50 games (42.0%) being decided by 5-or-more runs.

- Hudson Valley sports a 11-10 (.523) record in game decided by 5+ runs.
- The club has already played six games decided by 11-or-more runs, and has a 3-3 (.500) record in those games.
- The 'Gades have also played nine one-run games, and are 4-8 (.333).

WALK FEST: On Wednesday, the Renegades pitching staff collectively walked 10 IronBirds hitters setting a new season-high. The team had

walked nine batters three times this season including twice last week in Wilmington. The 10 walks in a game are tied for the 12th most in the South Atlantic League this year with the Bowling Green Hot Rods (TB) leading the way. They issued an astounding 18 walks against the Hickory Crawdads (TEX) back on April 21st.

SPENCE HENCE: **Spencer Henson's** season-long eight-game hitting streak was snapped on Friday night against Aberdeen. Over the course of the streak, Henson hit .366/.488/.854 with two doubles, a home run, and four RBIs. The 'Gades infielder tallied a multi-hit game in four out of the eight contests, including a season-high four against Wilmington on May 24th.

DOUBLE OR NOTHING: **Spencer Jones** collected his 16th double of the season on Thursday versus Aberdeen. Jones is 2nd in the South Atlantic League only trailing Wilfred Veras (WS) who has amounted 21 total. The 16 doubles are good for third in High-A and are the most among all NYY Minor Leaguers.

DON'T RUN ON ME: Renegades catcher **Antonio Gómez** caught Jackson Holliday on Tuesday to bring his total to 18 in 27 games behind home plate this year.

- He owns the highest mark in the South Atlantic League and High-A, and good for t-3rd in MiLB.
- Gómez has thrown out 28.5% of would-be basestealers this year. The SAL average is around 21%.
- Nick Clarno (AUG -- A, ATL) leads MiLB with 25 CS while Gómez is t-3rd.
- In the month of May, Gómez caught 34.1% of attempted runners (14-for-41).
- After catching just four opponents in April, the 'Gades backstop has improved his CS% by nearly 18% month over month.

MY NAME IS INDIGO DIAZ: One of a flurry of roster moves made by the Yankees effecting the Renegades included receiving **RHP Indigo Diaz** from the Somerset Patriots. Diaz was acquired by the Yankees on December 28, 2023 from the Atlanta Braves along with INF Caleb Durbin in exchange for LHP Lucas Leutke. In his Hudson Valley debut on Thursday against Aberdeen, the right-handed pitcher retired all six batters he faced, striking out three.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: With a pair of hits on Saturday, **Eduardo Torrealba** has tallied 113 career hits with the Renegades and passed Matt Rico (112) for fifth all-time. Angel Perez holds the franchise record with 125.

A DOZEN IT IS: Friday night's 12-inning affair against the Aberdeen IronBirds was the longest game played by Hudson Valley this season. It's also the longest game played by the Renegades since a 5-4 victory in 12 innings on September 18, 2021, against the Greensboro Grasshoppers. The 'Gades played three 12-inning games during that 2021 season.

CRISP: Was hitting .400/.625/.400 in three games (2-for-5) with Double-A Somerset to start the season.
COWLES: Back-to-back multi-hit games on 4/30 & 5/3 for first time since 6/25/22 (2) & 6/26/22 with Tampa.
FLORES: Held hitless in back-to-back games for the first time in his career on 5/2 & 5/3 vs Wilmington.
GARCÍA: After only playing in only one game (2 AB) since 5/3, went 1-for-3 vs ABD (6/4).
GÓMEZ: Hit .151/.200/.233 in May after batting .271/.358/.339 in April.
HENSON: Back-to-back-to-back multi-hit games on 5/24, 5/25, and 5/26 at Wilmington -- 9-for-16, 2 2B, HR, 3 RBI
JONES: Yankees 2022 first-round draft pick out of Vanderbilt University... Ranked as the Yankees' No. 4 prospect by MLB Pipeline.

LAST TIME OUT: Thorpe battled some early struggles last Sunday night to get the win in an 8-4 Renegades victory at Wilmington. He allowed three runs in the first and a solo home run to Trey Lipscomb in the third, but Hudson Valley easily cruised to a win. Thorpe allowed four runs on six hits, two walks and seven strikeouts, though five of his six hits allowed came in the first three innings. At one point he retired 10 straight Wilmington batters before giving up a double against the shift to Leandro Emiliani as the last batter he faced.

QUALITY STUFF: Thorpe has fired three quality starts in his last five outings (QS = at least 6.0 IP, 3-or-fewer ER). He is one of only four pitchers in the South Atlantic League with three quality starts this season, and is joined by Greenville's Isaac Coffey (5) and Hunter Dobbins (3), Wilmington's Dustin Saenz (3), Greensboro's Anthony Solometo (3), Winston-Salem's Jonathan Cannon (3), and Hickory's Josh Stephan (3).

YANKEES DIRECTOR OF PITCHING SAM BRIEND ON THORPE: "The first thing that sticks out in my mind about Thorpe is he's just a competitor. You always want those kinds of guys. New York is a really tough place to play so you want to draft and sign guys that have a makeup that says that this guy is going to be able to handle pitching there and Thorpe hands down has that. He's really impressive out there, nothing rattles him. And then on top of that the secondary pitches are great. The changeup was a weapon to both hands in college, he's a high raw spin guy, the slider is disgusting. He throws two kinds of sliders -- he does throw the sweeper one and he has the shorter, tighter one and he just has such command of the zone with those offspeed pitches. It makes it really tough when you've got three different shapes there that are all going in different directions and he can move them around in the zone. As a hitter you can't really sit on anything and it's been awesome to watch."

2023 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season on the Renegades Break Camp Roster.
- Allowed a leadoff home run to Greensboro's Mike Jarvis on his first professional pitch on April 9, then struck out four of the next five batters.
- Struck out 10 batters in 4.2 innings on April 23 at Rome, becoming the first Renegades pitcher to strike out 10+ batters in a single game since T.J. Sikkema on July 16, 2022 against the Greenville Drive. HV tied a franchise record (for 9-inning game) in that game by striking out 19 Rome batters.

- Selected in the 2nd round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft

PERSONAL:

- Full name is Andrew Robert Thorpe.
- Over parts of the three seasons with Cal Poly, he went 17-8 with a 3.03 ERA (223.0 IP, 170 H, 82 R/75 ER, 70 BB, 284 K, 9 HR) in 35 games (34 starts).
- As a redshirt sophomore in 2022, went 10-1 with a 2.32 ERA (104.2 IP, 65 H, 31 R/27 ER, 25 BB, 149 K, 5 HR) in 15 starts... His 149 strikeouts ranked second in the nation, trailing only Oregon State's Cooper Hjerpe (161 K), who was selected by St. Louis with the 22nd overall selection in 2022 First-Year Player Draft.
- Ranked third in the country in H/9.0IP (5.59), sixth in WHIP (0.86), 10th in wins (10), 13th in K/9.0 IP (12.81) and 17th in ERA... Was named to six All-America First Teams, including Collegiate Baseball, American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA), Perfect Game, Baseball America, D1Baseball.com and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association, becoming the first six-time All-American in program history.
- Was named one of five finalists for National Pitcher of the Year, as well as a semifinalist for both the Dick Howser Trophy and Golden Spikes Award.
- Was also named the Big West Conference Pitcher of the Year, becoming the first pitcher in school history to earn the accolade... Prior to the 2022 First-Year Player Draft, was ranked as the No. 61 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline and the No. 62 prospect by Baseball America.
- Attended Desert Hills HS in St. George, Utah.
