YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Portland Sea Dogs, 2-1. The Sea Dogs took a 1-0 lead in the fourth inning with a solo homer by Hudson Potts. In the sixth, Potts extended the lead to 2-0 with an RBI double. The Flying Squirrels broke the shutout in the eighth with an RBI groundout by **Diego Rincones**. Richmond starter **Bryan Brickhouse** set a new career high with 11 strikeouts and allowed two runs in six innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. This series is the first between the two teams since 2019. That year, the Flying Squirrels won two in a three-game set at Hadlock Field from June 4-6 before being swept in a three-game set at The Diamond from July 30-August 1. This year, the Flying Squirrels and Sea Dogs will also face each other in a six-game series in Portland from August 9-14. Richmond 4-7 in games against teams from the Northeast Division this year.

PLAYOFF HUNT: Richmond is in second place in the Southwest Division, one game behind Akron. The Flying Squirrels hold the tiebreaker against the RubberDucks with a winning head-to-head record. One game remains before the Eastern League's first half closes at the end of play today. The first-half and second-half division champions will meet in a best-of-three series in the Eastern League Postseason, followed by a best-of-three championship series. The Flying Squirrels need a win and a loss by Akron against Harrisburg to win the first-half title.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 16-8 since May 29 after losing nine of their previous 12. Last week, they won four-of-six on the road against Harrisburg, maintaining first place in the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost three and split one this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 751 strikeouts and 58 HBPs. They are second with 88 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 21-14 at home this year.

THE SEA DOGS have gone 6-4 in their last 10 games after losing their previous seven games from June 7-14. Portland is 8-18 since May 27. The Sea Dogs are 10-7 against the Southwest Division this season, having faced Harrisburg in two sets prior to this week. Portland's roster includes four of MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including LHP Chris Murphy (10), LHP Jay Groome (11), SS Christian Koss (26) and OF/INF Ceddanne Rafaela (27).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Kyle Harrison** makes his sixth Double-A start and second against the Sea Dogs. He started the series opener on Tuesday against the Sea Dogs and allowed one run over five innings with a Double-A-high nine strikeouts. Over his last two starts since June 15, Harrison is 1-0 with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER/11.0 IP). He enters today's start ranked sixth in MiLB with 98 strikeouts this season. With his Flying Squirrels debut on May 27, he became the youngest pitcher in team history. He also picked up the second-most strikeouts in a debut in franchise history with nine. Harrison began the season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, where he went 0-1 with a 1.55 ERA in seven starts. At the time of his promotion to Richmond, Harrison ranked third in the Northwest League in ERA (1.55), second in strikeouts (59), third in BAA (.179) and tied for fifth in WHIP (1.00). Harrison was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2020 MLB Draft by the Giants out of De La Salle High School in Concord, Calif. He is currently rated by MLB.com and *Baseball America* as the Giants' No. 2 prospect. **For more on Harrison, see page two.**

FOR PORTLAND: Left-hander Jay Groome makes his 14th appearance of the season and his second against Richmond. He was on the mound for the first game of the series on Tuesday night at The Diamond and struck out 10 batters over six innings, allowing two runs. Over his last four starts since June 4, Groome is 1-1 with a 1.96 ERA (5 ER/23.0 IP). Groome was selected in the first round (12th overall) by the Boston Red Sox in the 2016 MLB Draft out of Barnegat High School in New Jersey. In 2021, Groome spent most of the season with High-A Greenville, going 3-7 with a 5.29 ERA in 18 starts. He received a late-season promotion to Double-A Portland in September and went 2-0 with a 2.30 ERA in three starts. This year, Groome is ranked eighth in the Eastern League in ERA (3.61) and sixth in BAA (.214).

STRONG ARMS: Richmond pitchers have combined for a 1.94 ERA (20 ER/93.0 IP) in 11 games since June 14, the best in the Eastern League, with 115 strikeouts and 42 walks. Opposing batters are hitting .195 in that span.

THE STARTING LINE: Over the last 11 games since June 14, Flying Squirrels starting pitchers have combined to go 6-3 with a 1.79 ERA (13 ER/65.1 IP), picking up 66 strikeouts with 21 walks. Over that span, **Bryan Brickhouse** is 1-2 with a 1.59 ERA (3 ER/17.0 IP) in three starts, **Kyle Harrison** is 1-0 with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER/11.0 IP) in two starts, **Jake Dahlberg** is 0-1 with a 3.48 ERA (4 ER/10.1 IP) in two starts, **Matt Frisbee** is 2-0 with a 1.84 ERA (3 ER/14.2 IP) in two starts and **Kai-Wei Teng** is 2-0 with a 1.46 ERA (2 ER/12.1 IP) in two starts.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,197) and total attendance (210,698). Richmond is 11th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 88 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (91). **Sean Roby** is second in the league with 18 homers on the season, with 15 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 179 home runs. The Flying Squirrels have already hit more homers than entire seasons in 2010 (71), 2011 (83) 2012 (76), 2014 (74) and 2015 (61), 2016 (83) and 2019 (84).

GO, DIEGO, GO! After hitting .173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, **Diego Rincones** is batting .381 (16-for-42) with three doubles, four homers and 14 RBIs over his last 11 games since June 7. He started the stretch with two doubles on June 7 against the SeaWolves and hit his first homer of the season the next day. He collected a season-high three hits in the series finale against the SeaWolves on June 12, capping the game with a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning. It was his second walk-off hit as a member of the Flying Squirrels. He has homered in three of his last four games played.

SHANE TRAIN: Since May 1, **Shane Matheny** is batting .298 (34-for-114) with six homers, four doubles, a triple and 20 RBIs. He has picked up a pair of two-homer games, one on May 1 at The Diamond against Bowie and another on May 12 at Harrisburg. They were the second and third multi-homer games of his professional career and his first since 2019. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season, even with a 13-game streak for Portland's Pedro Castellanos from May 6-22. He was placed on the 7-day IL on May 29 and reinstated on June 7. In his return, he picked up a pair of RBI singles. From May 1-June 11, Matheny posted a 24-game on-base streak, which was the second-longest in the league this season.

TOASTY: **Frankie Tostado** went hitless over his five-game stretch from June 9-15, going 0-for-19 in that span with six strikeouts before picking up eight hits over his last eight games since June 16. From April 22-June 8, Tostado hit .342 (51-for-149) with seven homers, nine doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs in 39 games. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked seventh in batting average (.294), fourth in hits (69) and tied for sixth in total bases (114).

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** hit his 17th and 18th homers of the season in the second game of Thursday's doubleheader. He is second in the EL in home runs this year, trailing Erie's Kerry Carpenter (22). He has hit 15 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvall** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He also extended his franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four. Roby is also now tied for the second-most homers in a single season in team history with 18, even with **Jarrett Parker** (2013) and **Mario Lissou** (2014) and trailing only **David Villar's** record 20 homers last season.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked seventh in batting average (.294), fourth in hits (69) and tied for sixth in total bases (114). **Sean Roby** is second in home runs (18) and 10th in SLG (.490). **Shane Matheny** is ninth in batting average (.287) and fifth in OBP (.415). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for seventh in stolen bases (16). **Ryan Walker** is tied for first in wins (6). **Chris Wright** is tied for fifth in saves (6). **Matt Frisbee** is tied for first in complete games (1).

WHERE THE SEA DOGS RANK: In the Eastern League, Pedro Castellanos is ninth in RBIs (42), sixth in hits (67), tied for fourth in doubles (18), tied for eighth in extra-base hits (27) and tied for ninth in total bases (111). David Hamilton is first in triples (6) and second in stolen bases (25). Devlin Granberg and Jonathan Guzman are tied for second in triples (4).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Ricardo Genovés** (24) and **Chris Wright** (27). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Dabovich (16), **Brett Auerbach** (27), Genovés (29) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
