ABOUT LAST NIGHT... Errors sunk the Sea Dogs on Thursday night in a 6-2 loss against the Rumble Ponies, the tenth straight win for Binghamton. Brooks Brannon was three-for-four with three doubles, tying a franchise record. He was stranded at second base all three times. Both Miguel Bleis and Johanfran Garcia hit solo home runs, but that was all the offense the Sea Dogs could muster, going 0-for-9 with runners in scoring position.

TRAGEDY OF ERRORS The Sea Dogs' six errors last night is their most in a game since recording a franchise-worst eight errors against the Hartford Yard Goats on September 5, 2015. Those errors contributed to five unearned runs for Binghamton, tied for the most unearned runs the Sea Dogs have allowed in a game this season.

ALL FOR EXTRA BASES The Sea Dogs have been one of the best extra-base hitting teams in Double-A. Six of their seven hits last night were for extra bases (four doubles and two home runs). Portland has the third most home runs in the Eastern League (143), and the fourth most doubles (194). The Sea Dogs' 354 total extra base hits is fifth best out of 30 Double-A teams. Last night's two-home run affair was their 44th game of the season with two or more home runs.

BRANNON BOMBS Brooks Brannon hit his team-leading 19th home run of the season on Tuesday. It was his second home run in August, following the seven he blasted in July. He tied a Sea Dogs franchise record with three doubles in a single game last night, upping his SLG% to a league-best .583. His .946 OPS is the second best mark behind Alex Binelas' .948 OPS.

BLEIS ON BASE Miguel Bleis is on fire to start the month of August, with a hit in seven straight games and eight RBI since August 1. Bleis is batting .379 (10-for-28) with an OPS of 1.058. He hit two home runs last week against New Hampshire, and blasted his third of the month last night.

FACES IN NEW PLACES Both SS/2B Henry Godbout and RHP Morgan McSweeney have made their Sea Dogs debuts this week. Godbout, the No.4 prospect in the Red Sox farm system according to MLB.com, batted .277 with seven doubles and seven home runs through 34 games with High-A Greenville prior to sustaining a hand injury. McSweeney signed as a free agent with the Red Sox on August 12 and was assigned to Portland. He last pitched in the Chinese Professional Baseball League for the Rakuten Monkeys and was released on June 21.

ABOUT THE RUMBLE PONIES The Rumble Ponies are the hottest team in Double-A baseball right now, riding a ten game win streak. As of a few weeks ago, Binghamton was in last place in the Northeast Division of the Eastern League, 10.0 games back of first place. Now, the Rumble Ponies are in fourth place in the division, just 5.0 games back of first place. Their offense has seen major improvements from trade deadline acquisitions (Jefferson Rojas, Billy Amick, Emilien Pitre) and call ups from High-A Brooklyn (Mitch Voit, John Bay, Corey Collins).

THIS DAY IN SEA DOGS HISTORY August 14, 2012 – Brandon Workman tosses six scoreless innings on two hits in his Double-A debut, as Portland clobbers Altoona 13-2...Workman retired the first 12 batters faced. Seven of nine starters had at least two hits.

ON THE MOUND LHP Devin Futrell (0-0, 7.20 ERA) makes his second start for Portland today after being assigned to Double-A on August 4. He made his Portland debut on August 7 against New Hampshire, allowing four runs in 5.0 innings pitched on eight hits including a two-run home run. He walked one batter and struck out five. In 2026, he has split his time between Single-A Salem and High-A Greenville, but spent most of the season in Greenville. For the Drive, he went 5-1 with a 4.22 ERA in 15 games (12 starts). Overall, he allowed 35 runs on 73 hits in 74.2 innings pitched with 85 strikeouts. Futrell played three seasons of college baseball at Vanderbilt University, and was drafted by the Red Sox in the 10th round of the 2024 first year players draft.

Leading the Sea Dogs

Acting Manager - Kyle Sasala

Kyle Sasala enters his third season on the Portland staff after a highly successful tenure at Grove City College, where he served as Associate Head Coach from 2016 to 2023. During his time with the Wolverines, Sasala played a key role in the program's rise, highlighted by a school-record 30-win season in 2023 and a 16-4 conference mark. He also helped guide Grove City to a then-record 28 victories in 2019 alongside head coach Matt Royer. Sasala later stepped in as interim head coach for the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, leading the Wolverines to a runner-up finish.

Pitching Coach - Juan Rivera

Juan Rivera also returns to the Sea Dogs coaching staff as a pitching coach for his second season. In 2025, Rivera helped guide a Portland pitching staff that recorded 1,435 strikeouts, the second-most in the Eastern League, while posting a 3.65 team ERA, the fourth-best mark in the league. Rivera spent the previous three seasons as the Salem Red Sox' pitching coach, where he led the staff to a 3.61 ERA, the fourth-best in Single-A. A graduate of Eastern Nazarene College, Rivera has been part of the Boston Red Sox organization since 2022, serving as a Development Coach with Salem before joining the Sea Dogs coaching staff.

Hitting Coach - Trevor Burmeister

Trevor Burmeister joins the Sea Dogs coaching staff as hitting coach after spending the previous five seasons in the Colorado Rockies organization. Burmeister began his coaching career immediately following his collegiate playing career at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse, where he spent two seasons on the coaching staff. He then served one season at the University of Minnesota Duluth, where the offense ranked third nationally in NCAA Division II with a .352 team batting average and second in the nation with 102 home runs. Burmeister later returned to his alma mater, Madison College (NJCAA), spending three seasons under head coach Mike Davenport. During his time there, he was named the 2019 NJCAA Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Baseball Coaches Association and Baseball America.

Defensive Coach - Kyle Schmidt

Kyle Schmidt joins the Sea Dogs as defensive coach after spending two years with the Red Sox' Single-A affiliate, the Salem Ridge Yaks. Originally from Smithville, TX, Kyle attended the University of Richmond and became a starting catcher for the Spider Baseball Team. Following his 2019 season, Kyle was drafted in the 33rd Round of the 1st Year Player Draft by the Minnesota Twins. Kyle voluntarily retired after the 2023 season. During his playing career, Kyle played at every Minor League level while also being involved in multiple Major League Spring Trainings.

Athletic Trainer - Kelsey Branstetter

Kelsey Branstetter joins the staff as Portland's Athletic Trainer, her first year with the Sea Dogs and second season in the Red Sox organization. She spent last season as the Athletic Trainer for the Greenville Drive (High-A) and served in the same role for Triple-A Louisville (Cincinnati Reds) from 2023-2024. Branstetter graduated from Middle Tennessee State University, where she played four years of soccer. Following her undergraduate studies, Branstetter obtained a master's degree from Wichita State University.

Strength and Conditioning Coach - Jonah Mondloch

Strength and Conditioning Coach Jonah Mondloch returns to the staff for his second season in Portland and his third year in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as an Assistant Rehab Strength and Conditioning Coach, where he supported the strength and conditioning programs for players returning to the field. In that role, he collaborated closely with Major League sports performance and on-field staff to ensure the highest level of care for injured athletes.
