NOTES AND NUGGETS

WHAT A RELIEF!

Yesterday saw the end of a 12.1-inning scoreless streak from Omaha's bullpen, a streak that went from Friday through Saturday, including scoreless outings from the Storm Chasers' relievers Saturday and Sunday.

12.1 consecutive scoreless innings from Omaha's relievers represented the bullpen's longest scoreless streak of the season, passing a 7.2-inning scoreless streak between April 12 and 13 ... 12.1 scoreless innings ties the club's longest bullpen shutout streak last year, a 12.1-inning stretch between August 14 and 17, 2024 vs. Louisville.

Sunday's game marked the 7th time this season the Storm Chasers relievers combined to not allow a run ... Omaha is 6-1 when its bullpen combines for a scoreless effort.

On Saturday, the Storm Chasers got 7.1 scoreless frames from the bullpen ... since 2021 Omaha's bullpen has combined for 7.0 scoreless innings or more 7 times ... the 7.1 scoreless innings against Indianapolis were the most since they worked 7.1 scoreless innings on July 28, 2024 @ St. Paul.

DON'T LEAD ME ON

Saturday and Sunday's wins put an end to a stretch of games where the Storm Chasers rarely held a lead.

Omaha led for 22 of 63 innings (35%) during last week's series against Indianapolis, including 17 of the final 18 innings ... however, they played from behind for 36 of 63 innings (36%).

In an 8-game stretch between April 24 and May 2, Omaha led for just 5 of 68 innings (7%), while the Chasers played from behind for 53 of 68 innings (78%) ... in that included a stretch of 50 innings without a lead from April 23 to 30.

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff ranks near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 321 strikeouts this season placing 4th in the league, 5th at the Triple-A level and just 7 strikeouts behind first place.

Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.34 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

With 321 strikeouts through 32 games, an average of 10.03 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,494 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

GET RATIOED

A pair of Storm Chasers have some of the best ratios in the Minors right now.

With 27 walks this season to just 16 strikeouts, Nick Loftin's 1.688 BB/K rank as the 3rd-highest walk-to-strikeout rate in the Minors (min. 100 PA)220 walks per plate appearance is the 7th-highest in Minor League Baseball.

Omaha reliever Andrew Hoffmann has struck out 28 batters in 17.1 innings, with just 4 walks ... his 14.02 K/9 ranks as the 3rd-best strikeout rate in Triple-A (min 15.0 IP), while 6.75 K/BB is the 7th-highest strikeout-to-walk rate at the level.

MASHIN' MERV

While his first week in Triple-A was slow, outfielder MJ Melendez picked up the pace offensively last week against Indianapolis.

Melendez went 6-for-23 (.261) against the Indians last week, with a pair of doubles, a home run, 4 RBI and 1 walk ... he drove in a run in 4 of 6 games.

In 13 games with Omaha, MJ has an average exit velocity of 93.3MPH ... that's the hardest average exit velo on batted balls among all 20 Omaha hitters this year ... his average exit velo ranks 13th among 338 Triple-A League hitters with at least 50 plate appearances this year.

MJ has 2 of Omaha's top 3 highest single exit velocities and 3 of the team's top 7 ... that includes the team's hardest hit ball of the year: a double on May 1 vs. Indianapolis that rocked off his bat at 112.0MPH ... that was his 3rd-hardest batted ball recorded by Statcast (since MLB debut in May 2022).

LET'S RAVE

Outfielder John Rave has been a consistent presence at the top of the Omaha all season long, contributing in all facets of the game.

Rave is leads the league lead in triples (4), is tied 5th in steals (12) and tied 5th in runs scored (23) ... he leads Omaha in all 3 categories, as well as total bases (51) and extra-base hits (12), while tied for the team lead in homers (4).

Rave has served as Omaha's leadoff hitter in 26 of 32 games this year ... he's reached base to begin 9 of 26 games (.346 OBP leading off the 1st inning) ... that includes 6 hits (1 single, 3 doubles, 2 homers), 2 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch ... his 2 leadoff homers this year are tied for 2nd in the Minor Leagues.

CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN SCOUTING REPORT

MLB Pipeline

A well-regarded high school pitching prospect, Champlain honored his Southern California commitment in 2018 and stayed close to home. Three years later, the Yankees selected him in the ninth round of the 2021 Draft and then traded him to the Royals as part of a three-pitcher package for Andrew Benintendi in 2022. Champlain returned to Double-A in '24 and showed he had mastered it with a 3.50 ERA, a 0.92 WHIP and a 34.5% strikeout rate in seven starts. The move to Triple-A was more challenging; Champlain made 28 appearances (27 starts) there for a 5.61 ERA, 15.5% strikeout rate and a 1.56 WHIP while batters hit .283 against him.

Champlain's average cutting fastball sits 91-94 mph, touching 97 in 2024. He spins the ball well and has improved his upper-70s curveball into a solid weapon. That pitch is different from his low- to mid-80s slider which has good depth and got some chase in '24 in a limited sample. Champlain also shows a cutter, which could be an out pitch eventually because of his natural movement, and his mid-80s changeup is still a work in progress, as it has been for several years. The lack of a pitch against lefties has hindered Champlain as he's faced better hitters. He has some effort in his delivery which affects his command at times, but he showed up to Spring Training over 100 pounds lighter.

Champlain has the look and mentality of a workhorse on the mound and has proven durable in the Minors, throwing 135 and 140 innings the past two seasons respectively. But he'll need to develop a weapon against lefties for him to reach his ceiling, otherwise there's thought he would have more in the tank as a multi-inning reliever with a fastball-curveball combination. He wasn't added to the 40-man when eligible for the Rule 5 Draft, but he'll return to Triple-A, be part of the Royals' depth and could make his debut in '25.

Baseball America

Track Record: Champlain was off to a good start in his return to Double-A in his second full year in the Royals organization since being acquired from the Yankees midway through 2022. In seven starts with Northwest Arkansas, the most noticeable statistic was an impressive 12 strikeouts per nine innings compared to just 1.8 walks. His promotion to Triple-A Omaha proved to be more challenging for Champlain. His strikeout rate decreased to 6.2 per nine innings, his walk rate rose to 4.0 and opponents hit .282 with 17 home runs in 104.1 innings.

Scouting Report: Champlain's four-seam fastball comes to the plate on a downward angle, sits 92-94 mph and touches 97—but he struggled to command it when he got to Triple-A. His 76-80 mph curveball improved enough in 2024 to be graded a plus pitch. At times it looked like one of the better benders in the minor leagues and misses plenty of bats in the zone with 12-to-6 shape and great finish. The slider is a distinct pitch from the curveball, averaging 85 mph with good depth. Champlain rounds out his repertoire with an 85 mph changeup and 86 mph cutter, both still in development. There's not a lot of athleticism in his delivery, making it more difficult to repeat and affecting his command.

The Future: Champlain projects as a big-bodied back-of-the rotation starter, although his stuff would tick up in shorter stints if he moved to the bullpen. He was not added to the 40-man roster when eligible after the 2024 season.
