FRES-NOTES

STOCK-PILING SOME FACTS: The Fresno Grizzlies and Stockton Ports (Athletics Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Banner Island Ballpark. This is the fourth series between the clubs in 2022 and the second meeting in Stockton. One name on Stockton's coaching staff that may seem familiar to Fresno fans is hitting coach Kevin Kouzmanoff, who played seven MLB seasons and played against Fresno from 2011-2014. The Ports are managed by Franklin Font, who was initially tabbed to be the assistant hitting coach. Font will continue his managerial career at the helm in Stockton, coming back to the states from France where he served as the manager for the Aigles of France in 2021, an independent team of the ESBL (European Super League of Professional Baseball). He was a part of the Chicago Cubs organization for over 10 years where he started as a development manager and minor league rover instructor in 2008 before being promoted to the major league staff as the assistant hitting coach in 2012 and ultimately a staff assistant from 2013-2020. Finally, Stockton broadcaster Alex Jensen coached Grizzlies righty Cullen Kafka when he played JV baseball at De La Salle High School.

STATEMENT AGAINST STOCKTON: The Grizzlies have found success against the Ports over the past two seasons. Thanks to yesterday's 13-6 win, the Grizzlies improved to 15-2 (+83 run differential, 148-65) against the Ports this year, 32-9 against Stockton over the past two seasons and 19-1 at Banner Island Ballpark (85-24 run differential this year). Fresno has mashed 43 homers over their 17 affairs against Stockton this season, with four contests of five taters or more. On the other side of the ball, the Grizzlies pitching staff has struck out 149 batters over the past 13 contests against the Ports.

LARGEST MARGIN OF VICTORY: The Grizzlies roared past the Ports 22-2 Tuesday night from Banner Island Ballpark. Fresno's 20-run margin of victory tied the franchise record that was initially set on June 30, 2016, against the Salt Lake Bees (23-3) at Smith's Ballpark. The 22 runs ranks third in Grizzlies history and the most scored by Fresno since they became a Rockies affiliate. The Grizzlies plated franchise-best 24 runs on August 25, 2006 versus Sacramento. Fresno's offense supplied season-highs in runs (22), hits (20), homers (6), triples (1), extra-base hits (12) and total bases (45), All 10 batters who appeared for Fresno enjoyed at least one hit with nine of them scoring at least once. Every Grizzlies started rrove in one run with five separate hitters tallying multiple RBI. Fresno relished a run in six different innings, plating five in the fifth and eight in the eighth. Those two frames have been the highest scoring innings for the Grizzlies of the property is very market.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: After scoring 22 runs on 20 hits with six homers Tuesday, the Grizzlies offense decided to add to their series totals with another double-digit effort yesterday. Fresno powered 13 runs on 16 hits with another six longballs. The 12 clouts over two contests are the most hit by the Grizzlies in a two-game span since July 17-18, 2017 at Las Vegas. For the second consecutive contest and scored three times, extending his hit streak to nine games. Yanquiel Fernandez, Zach Kokoska, E.J Andrews Jr. and Aiverson Rodriguez all chipped in with solo bombs to help the Grizzlies earn the win. Fernandez collected five hits, the most by a Fresno batter since Andrew Stevenson and Matt Reynolds on June 23, 2019 at Salt Lake. He scored four times and ended his evening a triple shy of the cycle for the second straight game. Kokoska lengthened his hit streak to seven games, joining Bernabel and Fernandez on going deep in back-to-back affairs. Andrews Jr. ripped three hits and drove in a pair of runs while Rodriguez notched his third round tripper of 2022.

HE'S JUST WARMING UP: Warming Bernabel is currently riding a nine-game hit streak. In that stretch, Bernabel is 15-for-39 (.385) with four homers, two doubles, 15 RBI, 11 runs, three walks, one HBP and four stolen bases. Over the past two games in Stockton, Bernabel has blasted four homers and drove in 10 RBI (two clouts and five RBI each contest). Prior to Bernabel, the last Grizzlies batter to have back-to-back two-homer games was JD Davis on August 16-17, 2018 at Taccoma. Also, the last time a Fresno batter had 10 total RBI's in back-to-back games was Tyler White vs. New Orleans in 2015. White had 6 RBI on August 17th and 4 RBI on August 18th.

TORRID START FOR TORREALBA: Grizzlies' newcomer Yorvis Torrealba is just the second Fresno batter in the Colorado Rockies era to have multi-hit games in his first two contests. The other was Isaac Collins last season. Collins did it in his first three games from May 6-8 at San Jose. On May 6th and 7th, Collins had two hits and then added three knocks on May 8th.

2022: Enters second professional season with the Colorado Rockies organization...listed as the Rockies #29 overall prospect...assigned to Fresno from ACL Rockies on May 2nd...made Fresno debut (start) 5/5 vs MOD, lasting three frames...hurled a career-high five innings, allowing one earned run on two hits and two walks while fanning a career-best 10 5/12 at VIS, the 10 strikeouts were the most by a 2022 Fresno pitcher at that time...tossed 4.2 frames of two-run ball, allowing three hits and punching out six 5/19 vs RC...career-high five innings 5/26 vs STK, striking out seven...hurled career-high five innings, allowing one run (unearned) on five hits and two walks while fanning seven 6/2 at MOD...struck out five over 4.1 innings of work 6/9 vs VIS...struck out nine over a career-high five innings of work (4 H, 1 ER, 2 BB) 6/16 at SJ...tossed a career-high six innings, striking out 10...the 10 punchouts tied his career-best and a season-high by a Fresno pitcher 6/23 vs MOD.

2021: Started professional career with ACL Rockies (rookie ball), appearing in four games (three starts)...hurled eight innings, allowing seven runs (six earned), striking out nine...career-high three scoreless innings in final start at ACL Angels (September 16)...allowed two hits and did not walk a batter while striking out three.

Personal: Selected by the Rockies in the 3rd round of the 2021 MLB June Amateur Draft out of Indiana University...spent three years with the Hoosiers...in final season, anchored into the rotation for the first time...made 12 starts and had a 5-4 record with a 3.39 ERA...was an important piece of an Indiana pitching staff that finished No. 3 in the country in ERA...was named Second-Team All-Big Ten and Academic All-Big Ten...in 2020, posted a 0-1 record with a save over four appearances, including one start...in 2019, made two starts in midweek games his freshman campaign...allowed one hit and three runs in 2.2 innings of work against Wright State in his career debut...played for Chris Hawkins at Normal West HS, where he was a two-year letterwinner...was named the Big 12 Conference Pitcher of the Year and an All-State honoree...team won regional championships in 2017 and 2018, and a conference championship in 2018...went 8-2 on the mound, striking out 124 batters (single-season school record) in 61 innings with a 1.84 ERA...was also a four-year letterwinner in soccer.
