Leading Off

Today, the Reading Fightin Phils continue a six-game series with game two at the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. It's the second of four series between the teams this season with New Hampshire, holding the edge 5-2. The Fisher Cats came to Reading from May 9-14 and return from Aug. 29 to Sept. 3. Reading goes back to New Hampshire from Aug. 8 to 13.

Cats Claw Back

Last night, Reading fell behind big early, down 7-1 after four innings. But, the Fightin Phils put up two runs in the sixth and five in the seventh to take the 8-7 lead. But, a two-run home run from Will Robertson in the eighth put New Hampshire up 9-8 for good to secure the win. Johan Rojas had three hits, but Griff McGarry struggled, allowing six-earned runs over four innings.

No Donuts for the Fightins

R-Phils.

Through 45 games this season, Reading has yet to be shut out. The Fightin Phils are one-of-two teams in double-A (Arkansas) and one-of-10 in all of Minor League Baseball who have yet to be blanked. Reading's pitching earned its first shutout of the season Sunday.

A Look at the Bullpen

Last weekend, Reading's bullpen was lights out. From Friday to Sunday, the bullpen allowed three earned runs in 12.1 innings pitched, which is good for a 2.19 ERA. In wins this season, the R-Phils bullpen has a 2.42 ERA, but it balloons to 7.46 in losses.

Home Run Merchants

Reading continues to pile on home runs as of late. The Fightin Phils have hit home runs in eight-of-nine games, having 14 home runs over that span, which is second the Eastern League since May 20. Reading now sits with 51 home runs on the season, which is third in the Eastern League and just six behind first-place Somerset. Nick Podkul, who also owns a 17-game on-base streak, had three home runs last week, including back-to-back games. To add, Johan Rojas hit two home runs Sunday, the first time an R-Phils has hit multiple home runs in a game this season.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies were quiet offensively, with just tow hits, in last night's 2-0 loss to the Mets. Ranger Suarez looked solid in 6.2 innings of work. Lehigh Valley fell to Scranton-Wilkes/Barre 4-1 in the series-opener last night in Allentown. Jersey Shore returned home to Lakewood and suffered an 8-0 defeat to the Brooklyn Cyclones. Clearwater opened up its series with neighboring Dunedin with a 6-3 win over the Blue Jays to improve Florida State League-best 32-12 on the season.

A Look at New Hampshire

This is the second meeting between these teams in the span of just 16 days. The Fisher Cats are 23-22 and tied for third in the Northeast Division, five games ahead of Reading. Last week, New Hampshire 2-4 at Portland, winning the final two games of the series. Up next, New Hampshire returns home for a six-game series against Reading's last opponent, Harrisburg.

Fisher Cat Starter

Righty Sem Robberse gets the start for the Fisher Cats this morning. Overall, he is 0-4 with a 4.95 ERA over nine starts this season. Robberse has 47 strikeouts to 17 walks over 43.2 innings pitched, with 33 hits allowed. At Portland on Thursday, he went six innings, allowing five hits and three-earned runs, while striking out seven and walking one. At Reading on May 12, Robberse was roughed up for six runs and six hits accorss just three innnings of work. The native of the Netherlands signed with the Blue Jays in 2019 and spent 2022 between New Hampshire and Vancouver.
