YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels snapped their four-game losing streak with a 4-0 win over the RubberDucks at Canal Park. John Michael Bertrand started and pitched five scoreless innings, extending his scoreless streak to 15.1 innings, and struck out six batters. Reggie Crawford struck out four over two relief innings. Evan Gates and Nick Garcia covered the final two frames. The Richmond bullpen did not allow a hit over the final four innings. Grant McCray hit a solo homer in the top of the first inning on the second pitch of the game. Carter Howell hit a two-run single in the top of the fifth inning. Adrián Sugastey added an RBI single in the sixth to open a 4-0 lead. The win snapped Akron's 10-game win streak.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, in the fifth of a six-game series at Canal Park. The two teams split a series at The Diamond from April 9-14. Along with this series, the Flying Squirrels return to Akron for three games from July 19-21 following the All-Star Break. The RubberDucks return to Richmond from Sept. 3-8 for six games.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS snapped a four-game win streak with their win on Friday night. It was their second shutout of the year and the second straight start by **John Michael Bertrand** to end in a shutout. Last week, the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win of the year, taking four-of-six against the Baysox. The Flying Squirrels have gone 7-5 in their last 12 games since April 20, including winning four straight from April 20-24.

THE RUBBERDUCKS had won 10 consecutive games, the longest win streak by an Eastern League team this year, prior to falling to the Flying Squirrels on Friday night. It was the longest win streak for Akron since winning 11 in a row in August 2016 en route to winning the Eastern League championship. Last week, they picked up their first six-game sweep in franchise history, taking the entire series at Altoona. For the season, Akron's pitching staff leads the Eastern League in ERA (2.37), shutouts (5) and WHIP (1.17). Akron's roster features five of Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including OF Chase DeLauter (No. 1), OF Petey Halpin (No. 14), RHP Andrew Walters (No. 18), 3B Dayan Frias (No. 19) and SS Kahlil Watson (No. 22). MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list includes five Akron players, including DeLauters (No. 1), Watson (No. 14), Halpin (No. 15), Walters (No. 25) and Frias (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Carson Ragsdale** makes his sixth Double-A start and his second against the RubberDucks. He last pitched on Sunday afternoon and threw five scoreless innings with five strikeouts against the Baysox at The Diamond, allowing three hits with no walks. He faced the RubberDucks on April 11 in Richmond and surrendered one run over four innings, striking out five. Among Eastern League pitchers (min. 20 IP) this season, Ragsdale ranks fourth in strikeout percentage (31.0%) and sixth in K/9 (10.68). He is also ranked ninth in the league in ERA (2.42) and tied for eighth in BAA (189). Last season, he made seven starts for High-A Eugene, going 0-1 with a 2.93 ERA. His season ended in May with an oblique injury. At the time of the injury, he was leading the Northwest League but missed most of the year after having Thoracic Outlet Syndrome surgery in the spring. Ragsdale was selected by the Philadelphia Phillies in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of the University of South Florida. Before making his professional debut, he was traded to the San Francisco Giants on January 9, 2021 for pitcher Sam Coonrod. *For more on Ragsdale, see page two.*

FOR AKRON: Left-hander Jaime Arias makes his fourth start of the season and his fifth overall appearance. Last time out, Arias pitched 3.1 innings and allowed a season-high three runs (one earned) in a no-decision at Altoona on Sunday afternoon. He made his season debut at The Diamond against the Flying Squirrels on April 13 as a reliever and worked one scoreless inning. Dating back to 2022, Arias has pitched 23 games (19 starts) for Akron, going 0-4 with a 5.63 ERA. In 2023, Arias went 1-2 with a 6.05 ERA in 12 games (six starts) between High-A Lake County, Double-A Akron and Triple-A Columbus. Arias signed with the Guardians as a non-drafted free agent in 2020 out of Fresno State University.

AWESOME APRIL: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and ranked third among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (7,926) and Worcester (7,418).

RISPY BUSINESS: In their last eight games since April 25, the Flying Squirrels have hit .146 (7-for-48) with runners in scoring position, averaging 2.4 runs per game (19 total runs). In this week's series in Akron, Richmond is batting .107 (3-for-28) with runners in scoring position and averaging 2.3 runs per game (9 total runs). After being shut out on Tuesday, the Flying Squirrels scored their only two runs on Tuesday on a pair of solo homers.

BISHOP BASHING: In his five-game hit streak dating back to last Saturday, **Hunter Bishop** is batting .368 (7-for-19) with a homer, three doubles, four runs scored and one RBI. He has picked up two hits in each of his last two games at Akron. On Wednesday night, he hit a solo homer for his second Double-A home run. Bishop is playing his first Double-A season and his first season overall since 2022 after missing all of last year with an injury.

WILL POWER: Will Wilson saw his 11-game on-base streak end on Thursday night. That streak is tied for the longest by a Richmond batter this season. Over his last 13 games since April 17, Wilson is batting .333 (16-for-48) with a homer, three doubles, eight walks, six RBIs and five runs scored. Dating back to 2021, Wilson has played 159 games for the Flying Squirrels over parts of four seasons.

PITCH PERFECT: John Michael Bertrand was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday for April 22-28. On Saturday, he pitched seven perfect innings against the Baysox at The Diamond, retiring all 21 batters he faced in order on 68 pitches. He is the first player on Richmond's roster to win one of the Eastern League weekly awards this season.

STRONG ARMS: The Richmond pitching staff has combined for 240 strikeouts this season, third-most in the Eastern League, and is ranked third with a 3.16 ERA. Flying Squirrels starters have combined for a 3.39 ERA this year, which is fourth-best in the league. The Richmond bullpen has the second-lowest ERA (2.95) in the league, trailing only Akron (2.48).

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: There are five relievers on the active Richmond roster who hold a sub-2.00 ERA so far this season. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 10 IP), four Richmond pitchers rank in the top 15 in ERA. **Evan Gates** is fifth with a 0.73 ERA (1 ER/12.2 IP), **Tanner Kiest** is fourth with a 0.77 ERA (1 ER/11.2 IP), **Wil Jensen** is ninth with a 1.20 ERA (2 ER/15.0 IP), which is the lowest in the league for any pitcher who has worked at least 15.0 innings, and **Nick Garcia** has a 1.50 ERA (2 ER/12.0 IP). **José Cruz** has posted a 1.17 ERA (1 ER/7.2 IP) in his six outings.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, John Michael Bertrand is third in ERA (1.71), first in innings pitched (31.2) and 10th in WHIP (1.07). Carson Ragsdale is ninth in ERA (2.42), tied for 10th in strikeouts (27) and tied for seventh in BAA (189). Hayden Birdsong is second in BAA (143), tied for sixth in strikeouts (29) and sixth in WHIP (1.03). Nick Garcia is tied for first in games pitched (9).

PROSPECT WATCH: Eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Reggie Crawford (No. 9), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Crawford is rated as having the best fastball and best slider. Seven players landed on MLB. com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), Crawford (No. 8), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), Victor Bericoto (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).


