### JUMBO SHRIMP WIN THIRD STRAIGHT, 4-2

Jacksonville's pitching staff dominated on Wednesday in a 4-2 win over Norfolk. Zach McCambley set the tone with 3.0 scoreless innings in a spot start and the Jumbo Shrimp racked up 14 strikeouts while yielding only three hits. A pair of two-out walks in the third led to Deyvison De Los Santos' RBI single for the game's first run. Jacksonville added a pair of runs in the sixth. After two bases-loaded walks for Norfolk in the seventh cut the Jumbo Shrimp lead to one, Graham Pauley launched a solo shot in the bottom of the inning to set the final margin at 4-2.

### THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville homered just two times in the seven games from May 2-9 - the fewest total of any Triple-A team. The Jumbo Shrimp have now gone deep in nine consecutive games since that point, their longest streak of the season by far. During this stretch, Jacksonville has bopped 21 long balls, the second-most of any team in the Triple-A. During this nine-game stretch, 21 of the Jumbo Shrimp's 91 hits, or 23.1 percent, have been home runs. Thirty-nine, or 42.9 percent have gone for extra bases.

### GOOD MORNING, GOOD AFTERNOON, GOODNIGHT!

Jacksonville's pitching staff has recorded a whopping 507 strikeouts through 47 games, a rate of 10.8 per game. The Jumbo Shrimp have 51 more punchouts than Norfolk, the team that ranks second in Triple-A. Thus, the Tides' 456 strikeouts are closer to 15th-place Syracuse (408) than they are to Jacksonville in first. In addition to the swings and misses, the Jumbo Shrimp have also shown an ability to limit hard contact; their 87.2 average exit velocity against is the second-best such figure in Triple-A.

### BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry struggled significantly over the 2025 season's first 33 games, going just 13-for-103 (.126/.229/.223/.452) at the plate with 35 strikeouts in 119 plate appearances (29.4 percent). The Queens Creek, Ariz., has been truly excellent since that point. Over his last 126 Triple-A games, Berry is batting .308/.400/.450/.850, cutting his strikeout rate to 14.2 percent with just 71 over 505 PA. Berry ranks tied for sixth in the IL in 2B (11), eighth in steals (15), ninth in OBP (.426) and 15th in average (.310).

### APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY FLOWERS

The Jumbo Shrimp lost for the eighth time in 11 games on April 30 at Durham, dropping the club a season-high 6.0 games out of first place in the International League. Since then, however, Jacksonville has rattled off 12 wins in the last 17 games, winning two of their last three series' in the process and slicing their deficit in the standings to just 2.0 games. Over these last 17 games, the Shrimp have outscored their opponents 112-79 (+33). The club is collectively hitting .274/.348/.469/.817 while holding their opponents to a .225/.335/.387/.722 line. Jacksonville has out-hit their opponents 165-122 over these last 17 games.

### ON THE OFFENSIVE

Heading into play on April 22, Jacksonville had scored at least five runs in a contest just three times in 22 affairs, ranking last in Triple-A in runs (68, 3.1 per game) and each slash line category (.186/.296/.282/.578). The Jumbo Shrimp have now plated at least five runs 18 times in the 25 games since. During this stretch, the club ranks tied for fifth in Triple-A in runs (164, 6.6 per game). They also place in the top 10 in doubles (T-3rd, 53), hits (6th, 243), home runs (T-3rd, 34), average (9th, .274), slugging (7th, .455) and OPS (.808). Jacksonville was hitting just .166 with runners in scoring position over the first 22 games; they are 72-for-253 (.285) in those situations over the last 25 contests.

### DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS

Jacksonville has yielded tied for the second-fewest runs (203) in Triple-A while posting the level's second-best ERA (4.04). While the club leads all Triple-A staffs in strikeouts (507), the Jumbo Shrimp have also done a phenomenal job at turning batted balls put into play into outs; Jacksonville ranks first in Triple-A by turning 72.6 percent of balls put into play into outs. Only four clubs have recorded a rate of greater than 71 percent this season.

### SHRIMP BITES

At 26-21, the Jumbo Shrimp are a season-high five games over .500... Andrew Pintar has reached base at least once in 15 straight games (19-for-55, .345/.439/.636/1.075, 5 2B, 3B, 3 HR, 15 RBIs, 10 BB, 13 R), the second-longest such streak for a Jumbo Shrimp this season (Ethan O'Donnell, 16 games, March 29-April 24).

### ABOUT BRANDON

-White was originally selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 14th round of the 2018 draft out of W.F. West High School (Chehalis, Wash.). He opted to honor a commitment to play at Washington State University, where he appeared in 30 games, including 29 starts, over three seasons (8-12, 5.69 ERA, 131.1 IP, 153 H, 67 BB, 119 K). At Washington State, White was teammates with current Cleveland Guardians first baseman Kyle Manzardo.
