IT'S BEEN A WHILE: Omaha faces off against the Rochester for the first time since 1991, when the then Omaha Royals were part of the Triple-A Alliance. Omaha holds a record of 8-7 against Rochester, including a 4-1 postseason record. Two players on the current roster were alive the last time these two teams met, RHP Brad Peacock (born 1988) and RHP Arodys Vizcaíno (born 1990).

SCORELESS: RHP Ándres Núñez tossed 0.2 scoreless innings Thursday night and is now in sole possession of the longest active streak of games not allowing an earned run in the International League. Núñez has thrown 19.2 innings since last allowing a run, now just one out behind RHP Brad Peacock's 20.0-inning streak for longest on the team this season. Peacock also holds the longest streak of games without allowing an earned run in the International League this season at 18 games, with Núñez needing one more to tie the streak.

**STREAKS: OF Dairon Blanco** is riding a 15-game hit streak that started on May 15. The streak is the longest active hitting streak in the International League and is one game shy of Nolan Gorman's (Memphis) streak for longest overall in the International League this season. His streak is the longest by a Storm Chaser this season, and he becomes just the second player to hit the 15-game on-base streak benchmark, with **INF Michael Massey's** 22-game active on-base streak being the other. His on-base streak is tied for the fifth longest active streak in the International League.

**STREAKS:** Two **RHP** Ándres **N**úñez tossed 0.2 scoreless innings Sunday, bringing his scoreless streak to a team-high 20.1 innings, surpassing **RHP Brad Peacock's** 20.0-inning streak that lasted until June 22. Núñez hasn't allowed an earned run for 18 games, the longest active streak in the International League that started on May 19. Núñez is tied with Peacock for most games without an earned run this season in the league.

**THIEVES:** Two Omaha holds the highest stolen base percentage in the International League at .857, besting Memphis' .850 mark. The Chasers have been caught just 15 times this season, ranking second in the International League, behind Jacksonville. The Jumbo Shrimp have attempted 45 fewer stolen bases this season. Two Chasers rank in the top 10 in the International League in stolen bases. **OF Dairon Blanco** swiped his 19th base of the season on Sunday, now tied for the sixth most in the league. **OF Brewer Hicklen** stole a base on Sunday to bring his total to 18, tied for eighth in the International League. Hicklen is the only member of the top-10 that has yet to be caught stealing while Blanco's .905 success rate is the third highest in the top 10.

FOR OMAHA: RHP Daniel Mengden takes the ball to make his 13th start and 14th overall appearance for the Storm Chasers. In his last start, Mengden threw 4.0 innings in the second game of a doubleheader, allowing one earned run on five hits with six strikeouts. Mengden went nearly a month between Triple-A appearances, spending some time with the Big-League club out of the bullpen. Since the start of May, the Houston native has gone 5-1 with a 3.92 ERA in eight starts and one game of relief. Mengden has thrown three quality starts this season, all in consecutive games between May 28 and June 9. Mengden made his Royals organizational debut on April 8. Mengden spent the 2021 season pitching for the KIA Tigers in the KBO, posting a 3.60 ERA across 120.0 innings in 21 starts with 104 strikeouts and 35 walks. Mengden was originally drafted by the Houston Astros in the fourth round (106th overall) of the 2014 MLB Draft out of Texas A&M University.

FOR TOLEDO: RHP Cade Cavalli heads to the mound to make his 15th start this season for the Red Wings. In his lasts start, Cavalli went 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing only two hits with no walks and seven strikeouts. Cavalli has thrown three quality starts this season, all 7.0-inning performances, holding a 3-0 record and 0.43 ERA in the quality starts. The Bixby, Oklahoma native played collegiately for the Oklahoma Sooners where he was named the 2020 Big 12 Conference Preseason Pitcher of the Year. Cavalli was selected 22nd overall by the Washington Nationals in 2020, working his way all the way up to Triple-A in his first professional season after the 2020 campaign was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
