TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a six-game set with the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, their only meetings of the season.

AST TIME OUT: Aaron Shackelford smacked a homer in his fourth straight game and Altoona rallied for two runs in the top of the ninth to secure an 8-6 win. **Quinn Priester** matched his season-high with 8 strikeouts over 5.0 innings.

SHACK ATTACK: Aaron Shackelford has homered in four consecutive games for the Curve, all of which were two-run shots. Altoona's franchise record for consecutive games with a home run stands at 6 when Brad Eldred homered in each game from 4/26-5/2 in 2005. With his 22 homers on the season, Shackelford is the 10th player in franchise history to homer 20 times in a season, Mason Martin hit 22 homers in 2021 for the Curve. Martin was also the most recent Curve batter to homer in 4 straight games when he did so from 7/3-6 in 2021.

BOMBS AWAY: Altoona swatted a season-best 5 home runs in the Curve's 11-1 win over Binghamton on Wednesday, August 10. Jared Triolo led off the game with a solo homer, the third leadoff homer of the season for Altoona, Aaron Shackelford added his team-leading 21st homer of the season in the second inning and then Endy Rodriguez added his first Double-A homer in the third inning. Connor Scott added a solo shot in the fifth and Liover Peguero smashed a two-run shot in the ninth inning. Altoona was just one home run shy of matching the franchise record of 6, set on July 11, 2014 at Harrisburg.

MMACULATE AGAIN: Right-hander Luis Ortiz fired the fourth immaculate inning in franchise history on Tuesday, August 9 in Altoona's 6-0 win over Binghamton. Ortiz became the first pitcher in franchise history to throw two immaculate innings. With his 8 strikeouts, Ortiz now has 103 strikeouts on the season; becoming the first Curve pitcher with 100 strikeouts in a season since **Taylor** Hearn in 2018. Should he stay on turn in the rotation, he would have 7 more starts in the regular season; giving him a solid chance to set the team's franchise record for strikeouts in a season (Ian Snell, 2004: 142). He would need to average 6 strikeouts per start the rest of the way to lock down the mark.

ENDY'S TIME: Prior to Altoona's series with Binghamton, the Pirates promoted the No. 5 prospect in the system according to MLB. com, C Endy Rodriguez. Named the South Atlantic League's Player of the Month in July after he batted .373/.489/.773 with 6 2B, 8 HR, and 21 RBI in 21 G, Rodriguez ranked highly in several categories in the South Atlantic League at the time of promotion: 7th in BA (.302), 8th in HR (16), 5th in OBP (.392), 2nd in SLG% (.544), 2nd in OPS (.936), 4th in H (96), T-2nd in 2B (23), T-2nd in XBH (42), 3rd in R (63). Rodrigurez has picked up at least one hit in each of his first three games with the Curve, including a key insurance run single in the 9th inning on August 11.

ALL-STAR SWOON: Following the four-day All-Star break, Altoona dropped 12-of-15 games to send their season record under the 500 mark. Altoona dropped 2-of-3 in Harrisburg coming out of the break before dropping 5-of-6 in a series at Bowie and 5-of-6 in a series at PNG Field to Akron. Altoona batted 2-for-33 (.061) with runners in scoring position in their series with Akron.

STOLEN HEARTS: The Curve have stolen 135 bases on the season, on pace to break the franchise record of 159 (2014) with 40 games to play. Altoona has 3 players, Jared Triolo (22), Liover Peguero (21) and Andres Alvarez (20), with 20 stolen bases for the first time since 2014 when Keon Broxton and Alen Hanson each had 25 and Drew Maggi stole 37 bases.

TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL: Altoona pitchers have surrendered 115 home runs across 66 of their 105 games played this season. Altoona allowed a home run in a season-high 8 straight games from July 26 - August 3, falling shy of the franchise record of 11 (5/19-29, 2013).

A TREE-IDENTIFICATION WALK: After drawing just 19 walks in 42 games across April and May, INF Jared Triolo drew 20 walks in 25 games in June. Over his last 41 games (6/21 - Present), Triolo has a .400 on-base percentage which has raised his season OBP mark from .359 to .372. Triolo reached base safely in 19-of-23 games in July, his 56 BB are T-2nd in the EL.

THE ARTISTS FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE B-METS: Managed by Reid Brignac, Binghamton's coaching staff features a wealth of MLE experience with Brignac (9 years), Pitching Coach Jerome Williams (11 years), Hitting Coach Tommy Joseph (2 years, plus 5 seasons in the Eastern League), and Bench Coach Mariano Duncan (12 years). The Ponies feature several top prospects accoring to MLB.com SS Ronny Mauricio (#3), OF Carlos Cortes (#15), C Hayden Senger (#20), C Nick Meyer (#27) and RHP Brian Metoyer (#30).

THE FIRST PONY TO RIDE: Kyle Wilson takes the ball for his Double-A debut for Binghamton. Wilson has made 3 appearances with the FCL Mets and Low-A St. Lucie this season tossing just 4.1 innings on the season, his first innings in pro ball since the COVID-19 Pandemic. A 35th rounder out of Raymore Peculiar HS in Missouri, Wilson's younger brother Kaiden is committed to pitch at LSU.

TODAY IN CURVE HISTORY

2006 - The Curve break a 4-4 tie in the top of the 14th with five runs at New Britain to beat the Rock Cats 9-4

2004 - Ian Snell strikes out 11, including 7 in a row at one point, at New Hampshire over five one-hit, scoreless innings and earned his 10th win of the year behind an 11-run (11-0 win) outburst by the Curve offense.

2021 - The Curve take it on the chin in a doubleheader at Erie, dropping the opener 15-1 and the finale 6-0. Jeff Passantino allows a career-high for Erie. Spencer Torkelson, the #1 overall pick in 2020, goes 7-7 with 1 2B, 3 HR and 6 RBI in the doubleheader.

After using a powerful sinking fastball at South Carolina, has adopted a more traditional four-seam fastball as a pro... Change has helped his fastball play better off of his cutter, slider and changeup... Was rated by MLB.com as the No. 21 prospect in the 2020 draft... Signed with the Pirates for \$2,050,000... Was ranked as the top prep player in the state of South Carolina in 2017 by Perfect Game... Grew up playing shortstop before beginning to pitch during his junior year at Hilton Head (SC) High School... Was the South Carolina 4A Player-of-the-Year in 2017 despite having his season cut short by a torn fingernail... Was a Baseball America Top 500 prospect for the 2017 MLB Draft... Plays the guitar and piano... Does not have any social media accounts and didn't have a cell phone until age 16... Enjoys photography and surfing in his free time... Brother, JJ, was named the 2020 Rookie of the Year for South Carolina's Club Baseball Team after going 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA in three starts during the pandemic-shortened season...
