**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels shut out the Senators, 7-0, their league-leading eighth shutout win of the season. **Greg Farone** tied the longest start of his professional career with six scoreless innings and struck out five. **Shane Rademacher** worked the final three innings and faced the minimum. **Parks Harber** opened the scoring with a sacrifice fly in the third and **Charlie Szykowny** added an RBI single for a 2-0 Richmond lead. In the fifth, **Diego Velasquez** hit a two-run homer, his fourth of the season, for a 4-0 lead. In the seventh, Harber belted a three-run homer, his ninth of the year, to open a 7-0 lead.

**POSTSEASON BOUND:** The June 12 win clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division title for the Flying Squirrels, locking in a postseason berth. The Flying Squirrels will play the second-half division champion in the Division Series. Game 1 will be at the home of the second-half champion on Tues., Sept. 15. Game 2 and, if necessary, Game 3 will be at CarMax Park on Thurs., Sept. 17 and Sat., Sept. 18. If Richmond advances to the EL Championship Series, Game 1 will be at CarMax Park on Sun., Sept. 20. This year marks the fifth postseason appearance in franchise history and the first since 2023.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. This is the second series between these two teams this year and the Flying Squirrels' first trip to Harrisburg. The Flying Squirrels are looking to guarantee at least a series split with the Senators.

**FIREWORKS:** The Flying Squirrels are playing on the road on Independence Day for just the second time in franchise history. Last year, they picked up a 6-1 win in Bowie, Md., against the Baysox. In the franchise's history, the Flying Squirrels are 12-3 on Independence Day. This is Richmond's first-time facing Harrisburg on the Fourth of July.

**STRONG START:** The Flying Squirrels' 10-game win streak from April 4-15 was the longest in franchise history, surpassing an eight-game win streak from May 5-13, 2021, also beginning with the second game of the season. The 50-28 start is the best in team history through 78 games, passing a 47-31 start in 2014. Richmond has won seven series, split five and lost one so far this year. After opening the season with a 27-7 record through May 13, the Flying Squirrels are 23-21 in their last 44 games since.

**RELENTLESS:** In their 50 wins this year, the Flying Squirrels have come from behind in 24 of them. In 17 of the wins, Richmond has taken the lead in the eighth inning or later. The Flying Squirrels have nine walk-off wins at CarMax Park this season, including at least one in each home series. **Drew Cavanaugh**, **Parks Harber**, **Dayson Croes** and **Diego Velasquez** each have two walk-off winners this year. Richmond has three wins after trailing by five-or-more runs this season.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** won the Southwest Division first-half title by seven games over second-place Erie. Richmond leads all 30 Double-A teams in batting average (.273), doubles (155) and sacrifice flies (34) and ranks tied for first in hits (713). The team has combined for 88 homers this year, tied for their season totals in 2024 and 2025. The Flying Squirrels are on pace to set offensive single-season franchise records for batting average, runs, total bases, doubles, RBIs, stolen bases, OBP, SLG, OPS, sacrifice flies and hit by pitches. The Richmond pitching staff has thrown eight shutouts this season, which leads the Eastern League and ranks second in Double-A.

**THE SENATORS** finished the Eastern League's first half in fourth place in the Southwest Division, 9.5 games behind Richmond. They went 3-2 in last week's road series against the Baysox to open the second half. The Harrisburg roster features five players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects list, including LHP Alex Clemmey (No. 7), INF Devin Fitz-Gerald (No. 9), OF Sam Peterson (No. 14), OF Ethan Petry (No. 15) and C Caleb Lomavita (No. 21). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects includes five Harrisburg players, including Fitz-Gerald (No. 5), Clemmey (No. 12), Petry (No. 13), Peterson (No. 23) and Lomavita (No. 27).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Charlie McDaniel** makes his sixth Double-A start and his second against the Senators. He last pitched on Sunday at CarMax Park against Akron and allowed five runs over three innings before his outing was ended by a long rain delay. In the first game of that series on June 23, he picked up a win after throwing seven scoreless innings, allowing three hits with no walks and seven strikeouts. McDaniel went 3-1 with a 3.99 ERA in nine starts with High-A Eugene before being promoted to Double-A on June 2. He was the Northwest League Pitcher of the Month for April after going 1-0 with a 1.10 ERA (2 ER/16.1 IP) in four starts. He pitched his first professional season in 2025 and split the season between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, going 8-6 with a 3.68 ERA in 23 outings (12 starts). McDaniel signed with the Giants as a non-drafted free agent out of Presbyterian College in 2024 after being named First-Team All-Big South in his senior season. **For more on McDaniel, see page two.**

**FOR HARRISBURG:** Left-hander Jared Simpson makes his third start and 30th appearance of the season. He last pitched on Wednesday against the Flying Squirrels and threw a scoreless sixth inning. He has pitched six consecutive scoreless appearances spanning seven innings of work since June 16. His last runs allowed were on June 13 at CarMax Park against the Flying Squirrels when he surrendered two in the seventh inning. Those are the only runs Simpson has surrendered since May 19, spanning 13 outings and 16.2 innings pitched for a 1.08 ERA in that stretch. Simpson was selected in the eighth round of the 2023 MLB Draft by the Nationals out of the University of Iowa.

**IT'S BO TIME!** In his last 27 games since June 2, **Bo Davidson** is batting .308 (33-for-107) with 12 homers, three doubles and 24 RBIs, adding 15 walks. From June 4-7, he homered in four consecutive games, a new Flying Squirrels franchise record. From June 2-June 7, he picked up at least one RBI in six consecutive games, one shy of the franchise record. His 11 homers in June were the most in a calendar month in franchise history, passing eight by Jarrett Parker (May 2013) and Sean Roby (April 2022). His 18 homers are tied for fourth-most in a season in franchise history, even with Jarrett Parker (2013) and Mario Lissou (2014). Davidson has 26 career homers with Richmond since being promoted to Double-A last July, which ranks ninth in franchise history.

**SIO LATER:** Jean Carlos Sio has six homers and 18 RBIs in his last 18 starts since June 10. He began the stretch with his first Double-A homer on June 10 at CarMax Park against Harrisburg, a solo shot. The following game on June 11, he went 2-for-5 with a solo homer and a two-run triple. In the division-clinching win on June 12, he drove a two-run single in the first inning. On June 14, he hit a game-tying, two-run homer in a comeback win. On June 17, Sio drove a two-run, go-ahead homer in the eighth in Bowie. He hit a solo homer on June 19 in Bowie. He hit a three-run homer on Thursday night in Harrisburg. In nine games against the Senators this year, Sio is batting .269 (7-for-26) with four homers and 11 RBIs.

**JACK ATTACK:** In his last 20 games since June 5, **Jack Payton** is batting .408 (29-for-71) with a homer, five doubles, a triple, 10 RBIs, seven walks and 11 runs scored. He has nine multi-hit performances in his last 18 games dating back to June 9, including six two-hit games and three three-hit games. On Thursday in Harrisburg, he went 3-for-4 with a double. Against the Senators this year, Payton is batting .480 (12-for-25) with a homer, a double, a triple, two walks, three RBIs and four runs scored. He is riding an eight-game hit streak since June 23, during which he is batting .400 (12-for-30) with three doubles and six RBIs.

**GO, DIEGO, GO!** In his last five games since last Sunday, **Diego Velasquez** is batting .600 (9-for-15) with a homer, two doubles, three walks, three RBIs and two stolen bases. He has eight hits in four games against the Senators this week, including a three-hit game on Thursday and a pair of two-hit games. On Friday night, Velasquez hit his fourth homer of the season. Since joining the Flying Squirrels in July 2024, Velasquez has played 234 games. In Richmond's franchise history, Velasquez ranks second in sacrifices (18), third in walks (114), sixth in OBP (.370, min. 400 PA), sixth in stolen bases (38) and sixth in hits (228).

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Bo Davidson** is tied for second in homers (18), tied for fourth in RBIs (50) and ninth in total bases (131). **Jonah Cox** is first in triples (5) and fourth in stolen bases (27). **Charlie Szykowny** is ninth in extra-base hits (31). **Parks Harber** is tied for sixth in doubles (18) and 10th in batting average (.285). **Tyler Vogel** is first in saves (11) and tied for fourth in wins (6). **Mitch White** is tied for sixth in saves (5). **Trystan Vrieling** is first in shutouts (1), tied for first in complete games (1) and tied for sixth in BAA (.237). **Cesar Perdomo** is first in WHIP (1.11), first in BAA (.216), tied for first in strikeouts (89) tied for eighth in innings pitched (72.1) and eighth in ERA (3.98).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Richmond's roster features four players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Bo Davidson** (No. 3), **Parks Harber** (No. 16), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 24) and RHP **Yunior Marte** (No. 29). **Adrian Sugastey** is rated by Baseball America as the top defensive catcher in the Giants organization. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Davidson (No. 6), Harber (No. 13) and INF **Maui Ahuna** (No. 18) and Marte (No. 25).

### THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

**1989:** The Richmond Braves beat the Rochester Red Wings, 4-3, at The Diamond in front of a sellout crowd of 12,490. Down 3-2 entering the bottom of the eighth, Mark Lemke tied the game with a double. With two outs, David Justice singled Lemke in for a 4-3 lead, one of his three RBIs in the game. **2016:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Reading Fightin Phils, 18-1, in the most lopsided win in franchise history. Matt Gage started and allowed one unearned run over seven innings. He also hit a three-run homer in the sixth and finished with four RBIs. Carlos Moncrief hit a pinch-hit grand slam in the eighth. C.J. Hinojosa had four hits, including a homer. Chris Shaw had three hits and drove in three runs. **2022:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Reading Fightin Phils, 15-7, at The Diamond. In the first inning, Sean Roby hit a two-run homer. It was his 21st of the season, setting a new franchise record. He passed the previous mark of 20 set by David Villar in 2021 on the same day Villar made his MLB debut for the Giants in Arizona.
