LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox clinched their second consecutive series win with a 6-2 victory on Sunday in Altoona. Bowie took the first lead of the game with three runs in the second inning on RBI hits from **Reed Trimble** and **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** The Baysox lead grew to six in the sixth inning thanks to RBI from **Collin Burns** and **Jud Fabian**. Starting right-hander **Alex Pham** pitched a career-high seven innings and struck out three to pick up the win.

START ME UP

In the month of August, the Bowie starting rotation has the second-lowest ERA in Double-A at 2.34. The rotation also owns the second-lowest WHIP (1.00). In last week's series at Altoona, the starters combined to throw 30.1 innings with just seven earned runs allowed (2.08 ERA).

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday after going 9-for-20 (.450) with four extra base hits, including four consecutive multi-hit games, in Altoona. Beavers has now reached base in his last 12 games and in 80 of 98 played this season. The Orioles No. 8 prospect is second in the Eastern League in walks (57) and third in stolen bases (27).

BASALLO BASHES

C/1B **Samuel Basallo**, the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, is second in the Eastern League in total bases (171) and is second in hits (107). On Friday, Basallo recorded his sixth three-hit game of the season. The No. 3 O's/No. 11 MLB prospect leads the league this month with 21 hits in 61 at-bats (.344).

BRADFIELD TO BOWIE

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** is scheduled to make his Double-A home debut this week at Prince George's Stadium. The Orioles No. 6 prospect recorded his first Double-A hit and RBI in his debut on Tuesday at Altoona. His 61 stolen bases is second-most in all of Minor League Baseball. Bradfield was drafted by the Orioles with the 17th overall pick in 2023 out of Vanderbilt.

THE JOSEN ONE

IF/OF **Tavian Josenberger** swiped four bases on Saturday, a new career-high for one of the newest Baysox members. No Baysox player had stolen more than three bases in a single game until last night. In his first Double-A series, the 22-year-old went 5-for-19 with an RBI and six runs scored. Josenberger is tied for 11th in all of Minor League Baseball with 49 stolen bases.

REED IS ROLLIN'

OF **Reed Trimble** went 5-for-16 in his first Double-A series at Altoona, including three doubles and five RBI. The 24-year-old switch hitter has stolen a career-high 28 bases this season without being caught. Trimble was drafted with the 65th overall pick in Competitive Balance Round B in the 2021 Draft out of Southern Miss.

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST

Bowie has scored in the first inning in eight of its last 12 games. When the Baysox score first, they are 38-18 this season compared to 16-41 when they do not. The Baysox have scored the second-most first inning runs in the Eastern League (67) along with Somerset.

SIZING UP THE SEAWOLVES

Entering this week, the Erie SeaWolves are second in the Southwest Division with a record of 25-19. The Double-A affiliate of the Tigers won the first half in the Southwest Division. Four of the Tigers top 30 prospects are on the SeaWolves active roster - RHP Jackson Jobe (No. 2), IF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 8), RHP Troy Melton (No. 12), and RHP Eric Silva (No. 29).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Wilkel Hernandez makes his 23rd start of the season. Hernandez has a 5.02 ERA in the second half. In his most recent start on Wednesday vs Akron, he recorded only one out and gave up three runs on two hits and two walks. The 25-year-old was a former Angels farmhand before being traded to the Tigers in 2017.

Baysox are 4-2 when he starts. Started first two outings of season and threw at least four scoreless innings each. Began season on 60-day IL. Sent on a rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on 6/4 before continuing rehab assignment in High-A Aberdeen on 6/16. In three rehab starts with IronBirds, threw 10 IP and struck out 13 over 3 BB to a 6.30 ERA.

2023: Spent entire season with Double-A Bowie primarily as a starter. Posted a 6.04 ERA in 18 games (11 starts) over 53.2 innings with 70 strikeouts. Struck out sixth-most batters on the team. Punched out five or more batters eight times. Did give up 12 homers, tied for fourth-most. Was on the IL from 7/13 - 8/19. Returned from the IL on 8/19 and made five appearances to finish out season. Pitched in the Arizona Fall League for Mesa Solar Sox. Appeared in five games (two starts) and threw 9.2 innings with 15 strikeouts over nine walks.

2022: Spent entire season with High-A Aberdeen. Pitched in 24 games (14 starts) and threw 88.2 innings with 97 strikeouts to a 3.25 ERA. Recorded most wins (11) and 10th-most IP in O's system. Threw five scoreless innings as part of a combined no-hitter on 6/18. Started two postseason games and allowed just one run over nine innings, including four scoreless innings in South Atlantic League Championship Series.

2021: Debuted professionally with Single-A Delmarva. Pitched in six games (two starts) and struck out 16 batters over 13 innings without allowing a walk.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Orioles in the 16th round of the 2021 Draft out of UC Irvine. Posted a career 4.03 ERA in 19 appearances (18 starts) across 96 innings. Transferred to UC Irvine in 2020 after spending two seasons at Ohlone College. Oldest of six siblings. Has worked as a baseball umpire. Native of Pleasanton, CA. Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.
