JACKSONVILLE OPEN SEASON WITH 6-5 DEFEAT

Both **Charles Leblanc** and **Lorenzo Quintana** homered in Tuesday's season opener, but the Jumbo Shrimp were edged 6-5 by the Worcester Red Sox. The WooSox scored the game's first run in the third inning, but a **Lewin Díaz** two-run double put Jacksonville in front in the bottom of the frame. Worcester tied the score in the fourth and scored three in the fifth to grab the lead. Leblanc's home came in the fifth, and after another Red Sox tally in the sixth, Quintana lashed a two-run rocket the other way to draw the Jumbo Shrimp within one. However, Jacksonville mustered just one other hit the remainder of the night for the loss.

DON'T CRY... SMILE BECAUSE IT HAPPENED

Jacksonville finished the 2021 season, which marked the club's return to Triple-A for the first time since 1962-68, with a 75-55 (.577) record - the club's best mark since an 81-59 (.579) tally in 2014. The 2021 campaign represented Jacksonville's first winning record since that 2014 season, and the Jumbo Shrimp won with plenty of dramatics; Twenty-one of Jacksonville's 75 victories came in the club's last at-bat. Those close victories have helped the Jumbo Shrimp go a whopping 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer, the second-best record in the league in contests determined by those slim margins.

IT TAKES A VILLAGE

The Jumbo Shrimp finished 2021 with a strong 75-55 (.577) record, something the club accomplished despite a whopping 287 roster moves. Jacksonville used a remarkable 77 different players in 2021, shattering the previous club record of 65 set in 2018. Of those 77 players, 38 were pitchers, which tied a club record. The Jumbo Shrimp had 21 different pitchers start a game in 2021, again marking a franchise record.

MEET THE SHRIMP

Jacksonville's Opening Day roster features three of the Miami Marlins' top 10 prospects according to *MLB Pipeline* in **Max Meyer** (No. 3), **JJ Bleday** (No. 6) and **Peyton Burdick** (No. 10). In addition to some strong young talent, the Jumbo Shrimp also have 14 players on its Opening Day roster with major league experience. Jacksonville and the Marlins boast a long-standing affiliation that dates back to 2009.

POWER UP?

Though Jacksonville lost Tuesday's season opener, the club is hoping that home runs from **Charles Leblanc** and **Lorenzo Quintana** will mark some encouraging signs for 2022. No Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. The last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its league in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers.

ROAD WAS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp boasted a 39-26 (.600) mark away from 121 Financial Ballpark in 2021, ranking the club in a tie for fourth for the most road victories in Triple-A. Jacksonville's .600 winning percentage away from the First Coast equaled both the 2006 and 2014 Jacksonville Suns, who each posted 42-28 (.600) away records, for the best road winning percentage for any Jacksonville team since at least 2005. In 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp ranked 28th in Triple-A in runs scored at home, mustering just 256 (3.9 per game) of their 577 tallies (44.4 percent) at 121 Financial Ballpark. The club's .672 home OPS ranked dead last in the level. Meanwhile, on the road, Jacksonville placed 14th in runs scored in away games (321, 4.9 per game) and 13th in OPS (.758).

WHAT CAN DAREN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

The 2022 season will mark Jumbo Shrimp manager **Daren Brown's** third stint as a Triple-A skipper. The 54-year-old piloted Triple-A Tacoma in Seattle's organization from 2007-13 and again in 2019, tallying 494 victories, which marks the most wins of any manager in Rainiers franchise history. Overall in his MiLB career, Brown holds a 1,260-1,257 (.501) record as a minor league manager, needing just 40 victories to reach 1,300 for his career. Brown led Tacoma to consecutive division titles in 2009 and 2010, and during that latter season, helped the Rainiers win the franchise's first outright Pacific Coast League Championship since 1969.

SHRIMP SKEWER

Since 2005, Jacksonville is 10-7 (.588) on Opening Days, but the Jumbo Shrimp have lost three of their last four season lid-lifters.

ABOUT BRAXTON

-The Miami Marlins' first-round pick in 2016, Garrett made his professional debut in 2017 but lasted just four starts until an injured elbow forced him to undergo Tommy John Surgery. Garrett went under the knife on June 20, 2017 and missed the rest of the 2017 campaign, as well as the entirety of the 2018 season. While rehabbing, however, he roomed with fellow Marlins prospect Jordan Holloway, who had underwent Tommy John Surgery just five days before Garrett did so.

-Garrett began his high school career at Foley High School in Alabama. However, he moved to Florence when his father, Steve, became the Florence Falcons' head baseball coach.

-Under the tutelage of his father, Garrett was named Alabama's Mr. Baseball as a junior and the state's Gatorade Player of the Year and a first team USA Today All-American as a senior, when he posted a 0.53 ERA with 131 strikeouts in 65.1 innings.

2021 SEASON

-Garrett was promoted on May 15 to Miami. He made a three-inning relief appearance that night at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles before being optioned back to Jacksonville the following day. The Marlins have recalled and optioned Garrett several more times throughout the 2021 season.

-Garrett's best major league start came on July 24 against San Diego, a game in which he yielded just two runs on four hits in 7.0 innings with 10 strikeouts against one walk.

2020 SEASON

-Garrett made his major league debut for the Marlins in game two of a doubleheader on September 13, 2020 against the Philadelphia Phillies. He ceded just one run on three hits in five innings, striking out six against two walks.
