The Nuts are 8-13 against West Michigan this season, 3-6 at LMCU Ballpark, with all 24 of the scheduled matchups taking place in the second half. Lansing has lost its last six games, including dropping the first three games of this series.

**On the Air:** Jesse Goldberg-Strassler calls the game on StreamGuys, and Dan Hasty & Nate Wangler deliver the action on MiLB TV and Bally Live.

**Last Night: Whitecaps 7, Lugnuts 3.** On a rainy Thursday night, the debuting **Drew Conover** faced seven batters with two outs in the bottom of the fourth and did not record any outs, issuing five walks and allowing an RBI single to **Jim Jarvis** and a three-run single to **Max Anderson** in a pivotal five-run Whitecaps rally.

**On Deck:** The Lugnuts play the Whitecaps through Sunday, closing out their 28th season in the Midwest League. Lansing's next home game arrives April 1 in the 2025 Crosstown Showdown vs. Michigan State, followed by Midwest League Opening Day vs. Great Lakes.

**Punching Their Ticket:** The Double-A Midland RockHounds clinched the second-half Texas League South Division title last night with a doubleheader split against Amarillo. Midland features 2024 Lugnuts **Euribiel Ángeles**, **Henry Bolte**, **Brayan Buevas** and **Will Simpson** in its starting lineup and **James González**, **Will Johnston**, **Colton Johnson** and **Chen Zhong-Ao Zhuang** on its pitching staff.

**Transaction:** Right-hander **Drew Conover** made his Midwest League debut last night, becoming the 48th different player on the team this year (25 position players, 23 pitchers) and the 950th different player in team history. He is also the third Rutgers Scarlet Knight on the squad, joining **Josh Kuroda-Grauer** and **Ryan Lasko**.

**A's Dominate Weekly Honors:** Lugnuts lefty **Will Johnston** was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week for August 26-September 1, blanking Fort Wayne over five two-hit innings with eight strikeouts (on 58 pitches, 45 strikes) in Game 2 of a doubleheader win last Wednesday. Additionally, former Lugnut **David Leal** was named the Texas League Pitcher of the Week, picking up a pair of wins with 6 1/3 combined hitless innings for Midland, Las Vegas infielder **Logan Davidson** was named the Pacific Coast League's Player of the Week after slashing .524/.524/1.000 with two doubles, one triple, two homers and 10 RBIs on 10 hits, hitting for the cycle on August 30, and former Lugnut **Lawrence Butler** was named American League Player of the Week, going 14-for-28 with six home runs, his second time winning the weekly award. Butler went 1-for-4 with a single yesterday, halting a franchise record nine-game extra-base streak.

## TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2010:** In the final game of the season, the Lugnuts routed host Lake County, 11-0, behind four-hit games from Brad McElroy and Jake Marisnick (raising Marisnick's average with the Nuts to .220). Marisnick also had two of the Lugnuts' five stolen bases in the game, and Casey Lawrence (7 IP, 2 H, 5 K) combined with three relievers on a five-hit shutout. The Nuts finished the season with a 70-69 record. The Captains, meanwhile, went on to win the MWL championship in their first year in the league.

**2016:** Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., made their unofficial Lugnuts debuts, competing in the pregame Home Run Derby at the 10th annual Crosstown Showdown presented by Auto-Owners Insurance (where they were outthomered by eventual champion Connor Panas, who hit 14 homers in the 1st round and 14 more in the championship round to best MSU's Dan Durkin). Then Bichette supplied an RBI triple in the game itself, Christian Williams hit a two-run homer, and the Lugnuts beat the Spartans, 4-1, before a crowd of 8,432. Cavan Biggio went 2-for-3 with two stolen bases and a run scored.

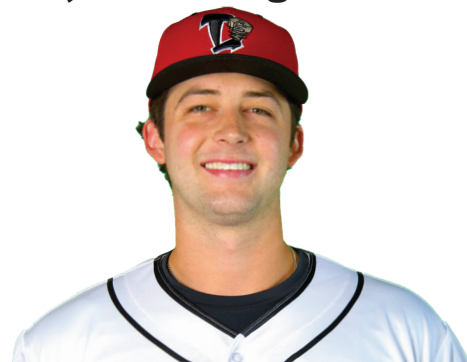
**Hometown Hero:** Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

**The Buc Starts Here:** Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

**Onward to Pitt:** Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeout innings in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five... the last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in the 2016 draft, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016.

**2022 Professional Debut:** After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

**2023 with the Lugnuts:** Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27.
