This will be the third time in Bradley's career that he is facing a Braves affiliate. He currently holds 2.25 ERA with an O-1 record versus Braves opponents in his career.

August 24, 2013 On this day in Hot Rods history, Bowling Green routed the Fort Wayne TinCaps 7-0. After scoring on an error in the first inning, Justin O'Connor kept the scoring up in the second with a solo homer. Tyler Goeddel had an RBI double in the fifth and another run came in on an error, giving the Hot Rods a 5-0 lead. One more error pushed in the final two runs for Bowling Green, ending the score at 7-0. Future big leaguer Blake Snell tossed three innings and struck out six batters in a scoreless performance. Stone Speer picked up his third win of the year, hurling four innings and striking out two in the Hot Rods 76th win of the season.

Opponents batted just .219 against the righty, while fanning 57 times and walking 19 times... Bradley surrendered 29 runs over the season with only 18 of them being earned... Opposing batters took him deep four times over their 42 total hits... 2018: During his first taste of minor league baseball, Bradley posted a 1-4 record and 5.09 ERA in 23 innings pitched... He made 10 appearances overall and started nine times... He faced a total of 116 batters, letting up 26 hits and 13 earned runs... Bradley was able to wiff 24 batters while walking 12 and hitting seven... He finished the season with a 1.65 WHIP and a .277 opponent batting average... Personal: Bradley was one of three players selected in the 2018 MLB Draft out of Redan High School... He was the highest selection out of his teammates... Redan High School was one of only two high schools in the nation that had three players selected in 2018... Redan high school has produced 19 players that have been drafted and six players that reached the MLB, including Brandon Phillips, Wally Joyner, and Dominic Brown... 
