

#### MAY 16th SCRANTON/WILKES-BARRE (28-12) at WORCESTER (19-22) 6:05 pm

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders LHP Edgar Barclay (3-2, 4.86) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa (2-1, 5.21)

All Even After Two – The Worcester Red Sox and the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders (AAA-New York Yankees) – who have split the first two games of this series in a 17-hour span from Tuesday night until Wednesday afternoon - play game three of their 6-game set tonight at 6:05 pm (live on NESN+ and on NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network). The WooSox won the opener on Tuesday evening, 8-4 but the RailRiders knotted things at a victory apiece with a 1-0 win yesterday morning/afternoon.

*One Has Been a Lonely Number* – Worcester's 1-0 defeat yesterday dropped them to 0-7 in 1-run games this season. They are the only team in the International League without a 1-run victory this year. In fact, every other IL club has at least three 1-run wins to their credit. Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games. The Sox are 3-5 in 2-run games this season. Last year they were 13-10 in that category.

**Red Sox vs. Yankees** – Scranton/Wilkes-Barre owns the best record in the International League at 28-12, 700. Only the Modesto Nuts (A-Seattle) of the California League have a better record (25-9, .727). The WooSox and RailRiders are meeting for the first time this season with their 6-game series that is the first half of Worcester's 12-game homestand at Polar Park. This week/weekend is Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's only visit to Worcester all season as the clubs play again tonight & tomorrow at 6:05 pm, Saturday at 4:05 pm, and Sunday at 1:05 pm in the RailRiders final game at Polar Park this year. The WooSox do make two trips to Moosic, PA to face the RailRiders this season...the teams begin the official 2nd half of the IL schedule with a 6-game series from June 25-30 and then play another 6-game set at Scranton/WB from July 23-28. Also of note, the Boston Red Sox and the New York Yankees have not yet met this season and won't until a 3-game weekend series at Fenway Park from June 14-16.

*Distance Apart* – The WooSox are currently in 6<sup>th</sup>-place in the IL East and 9½ games behind front running Scranton/Wilkes-Barre which matches their season-high deficit. The Sox had climbed back to the .500 mark after their May 5<sup>th</sup> victory for the first time in a month since they were 3-3 on April 5. They have not been over .500 since they were 2-1 on March 31.

**Rivalry Renewed** - Worcester is 34-39 all-time vs. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre including a 21-22 mark at Polar Park compared to 13-17 at PNC Field in Moosic, PA. The clubs finished 12-12 during the 2023 season series with the WooSox posting a 7-5 record here at Polar Park while the RailRiders went 7-5 at home in Moosic. Worcester went 10-14 vs. Scranton/WB in 2022 as the clubs split the 12 games at Polar Park but the RailRiders won 8 of 12 at PNC Field. During their inaugural 2021 season, the WooSox were 11-12 vs. the RailRiders going 7-10 at home but 4-2 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

*HomeGoods* - The WooSox – who have won 7 of their last 9 home games at Polar Park – have begun their longest homestand of the season that includes these 6-games vs. 1<sup>st</sup>-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre followed by 6 more games against the defending International League Champion Norfolk (AAA-Baltimore) and top prospect INF Jackson Holliday next week/weekend. The 12-game WooSox homestand (1-1 thus far) runs through Sunday, May 26.

**Home Getting Sweeter & Sweeter** - Worcester has also won 10 of their last 14 home games dating back to April 16. As a result, the WooSox are 11-8 at home after going 4-games over the .500 mark at Polar Park on Tuesday for the first time this this season. Worcester went 43-33 at home last year.

What Have You Done for me Lately – Worcester is 6-6 in their last 12 games and they have won 9 of their last 16 games since April 28.

Daydream Believers – Worcester has had much more success this season in day games (13-10) than at night (6-12).

*Four of a Kind* – The WooSox had a season-high 4-game winning streak (from Game 2 on April 14 – April 19) that came immediately on the heels of a season-long 4-game losing skid (April 10 – Game 1 on April 14).

*Hit Me With Your Best Shot* – Sox batters are 1<sup>st</sup> in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 34 times this season.

**Rankings** – Worcester is 15<sup>th</sup> in the IL in team batting with a .240 average while Scranton/WB is 12<sup>th</sup> at .248. On the pitching side, the Sox are 13<sup>th</sup> in team ERA (4.92) while the RailRiders are 1<sup>st</sup> with a 3.96 ERA.

Comeback Kids – Worcester has 9 CFB victories this season including 3 wins in their last at-bat of the game.

**Series Math** – Worcester is 3-4-0 in their first seven series of 2024 (3 wins, 4 losses, and no splits). They finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The WooSox went 8-3-2 in their 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

*April Recap* - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 129-123 in April. The month also featured five postponements, four doubleheaders, 29 player transactions, 10 players promoted to Boston (not including any rehabbers), and a total of 41 players used (19 position players & 22 pitchers). Worcester went 11-14 last April and by the end of April, 2023 they were tied for 5<sup>th</sup>-place and 7 games back. They were in 8<sup>th</sup>-place and 6 GB at the end of this April.

*May So Far* – Worcester is 7-7 in May. Sox pitchers have a 4.15 ERA (54 ER in 117 IP) with 11 HRA while Sox batters are hitting .240 this month (103-for-430) with 16 HR.

*A Winning Tradition* – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

*Finish Line* – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7<sup>th</sup>-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1<sup>st</sup> half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half. This season, for the second time ever, the IL will again invoke a split season with the first half starting tonight and ending on June 23 while the second half will run from June 25 – September 22.

**You Need a Scorecard** – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

Two Dozen to Go - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

**PORTLAND SEA DOGS UPDATE** – The Portland Sea Dogs (18-15), like their big brothers in Worcester, lost by a 1-0 score yesterday. The Sea Dogs were blanked at Somerset. Marcelo Mayer stayed hot with 2 singles. Angel Bastardo had a strong start but was the tough-luck loser – 5 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 8 SO. C.J. Liu, just off the injured list, was sharp in relief – 3 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 SO.

#### **WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES** – None today as of early afternoon.

Worcester has already used 48 players this season (21 position players and 27 pitchers) and that does not include LHP Joely Rodriguez who joined the WooSox last week but did not pitch and was placed on the injured list on Sunday with right hip inflammation.

The WooSox have sent 10 players to Boston in the 6+ weeks since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, and RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa. Those ten do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, and RHP Nick Pivetta who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Dalbec and Uwasawa are both back with the WooSox, Heineman is currently on Boston's injured list (rehabbing with the WooSox), and Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
