LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox were walked off for the second time this season on Friday, 2-1 in 10 innings, by the Harrisburg Senators. **Collin Burns** tallied the lone Bowie run on a solo homer in the third. The Senators tied the game in the fourth before the Baysox bullpen posted five consecutive scoreless innings to take the game to extras. Harrisburg's J.T. Arruda hit an opposite-field double to lead off the bottom of the tenth, plating the winning run from second.

BASALLO BITS

C/1B **Samuel Basallo** has reached safely in 20-consecutive starts, dating back to 5/21 and has hit safely in 11-consecutive starts. During that stretch, he's hit .351 with a 1.042 OPS. Basallo's five home runs during that stretch are seventh-most in the league. The 19-year-old is the youngest player in the Eastern League this season. He currently has the fifth-most hits (63) and seventh-most home runs (10) of all qualified players.

SETH IS SHOVIN'

RHP **Seth Johnson** has been on a roll for the Baysox in his last handful of starts. The O's No. 10 prospect has not allowed a run across his last 10 innings of work. Johnson has allowed just two earned runs across his last five starts (20.2 IP), good for a 0.87 ERA during that span (2nd in EL amongst starters). Johnson's eight strikeouts last Tuesday against Binghamton were his most at the Double-A level and the most at any level since he struck out a career-high 11 on May 20, 2022 - his last start before his Tommy John Surgery.

ON-BASE BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 44 of 51 games started in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect leads the team in OBP (.360) and leads the team in walks (31), the sixth-most in the Eastern League. Tuesday was the ninth time Beavers reached base at least three times in a game this season.

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

Bowie's **Jud Fabian** hit his 11th home run of the season on Thursday night, tying him for the third-most long balls in the Eastern League this season. Fabian hit a league-high six homers in the month of May and has three thus far in June. He's hitting .242 through 52 games this season after hitting just .176 in 64 Double-A games last season. His batting average on balls in play has jumped 70 points in that span.

TRAFFIC JAM

The Baysox have struggled to come up with the big hit so far during their week in Harrisburg. Bowie is hitting .227 this season with runners in scoring position - seventh in the Eastern League, but is just 2-for-27 (.074) this week, with 32 runners left on base. Four of Bowie's five runs this week have been via a solo home run.

BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (290.1) and strikeouts (333). The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.17 WHIP, which is good for third-lowest in Double-A.

SCOUTING THE SENATORS

Entering this week, the Harrisburg Senators sit at 32-25 on the season - tied for second in the Eastern League Southwest division and just a game out of first place. Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, the Senators are led by second-year manager and former Baysox player (1999) Delino DeShields. Harrisburg's roster includes four of the Nationals' top 8 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - OF Dylan Crews (WSH No. 2/MLB No. 6), IF Brady House (WSH No. 3/MLB No. 36), IF Yohandy Morales (WSH No. 4/MLB No. 88), and OF Robert Hassell III (WSH No. 8).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Andry Lara is tonight's projected starter for Harrisburg. The No. 28 prospect in the Nationals' system, per MLB Pipeline, Lara began the season with a second stint in High-A Wilmington and was promoted to Harrisburg by mid-May. He has gone at least six innings with three earned runs or fewer allowed in all five of his Double-A starts. The international free agent signing out of Venezuela in 2019 features a fastball, slider, and changeup.

Enters season fully healthy for first time since '22 after rehabbing from TJ surgery in '23

Traded from TB to BAL on 8/1/22 in three-team deal that sent Trey Mancini to HOU

Arsenal: Fastball (94-96), Curveball (75-79), Slider (Mid-High 80s), Changeup (86-89)

2024: In his two most recent starts vs BNG last week, threw a total of 7.2 scoreless innings and gave up just 2 H over 6 BB and 12 K. On Tue. 6/4 vs BNG, struck out season-high 8 batters over 4.0 scoreless innings. First game with 8+ K since 5/20/22 with High-A Bowling Green. Has allowed just 2 ER over last five starts spanning 20.2 IP (0.87 ERA). Still looking for first Double-A win. Baysox are 6-5 when he starts but have won four of last five. Owns a 3.86 ERA in five road starts. Finished month of May with a 2.79 ERA in five starts after recording a 4.38 ERA in four April starts. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

2023: Placed on 60-day injured list to begin season by Triple-A Norfolk. Sent on rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on August 19. Made one start before being sent to Single-A Delmarva on August 22. Made one start with Shorebirds, then assigned to High-A Aberdeen on August 29. Made two starts with IronBirds. Struck out five in three shutout innings on Sept. 6 vs Greenville. Assigned to Double-A Bowie on Sept. 13. Struck out four in three innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits and two walks in lone start of season against Harrisburg.

2022: Started season in High-A Bowling Green. Made seven starts and struck out 41 batters over 27 innings to an ERA of 3.00. Placed on injured list in late May with right forearm inflammation before discovering that he suffered a torn UCL and needed Tommy John surgery. Traded from TB to BAL in a three team deal on August 1 that sent Trey Mancini to Houston - just days before his operation in Texas.

2021: Entered first full season in minors with Single-A Charleston. Made 23 appearances (16 starts), pitched 93.2 innings and struck out 115 batters, good for fourth in the TB system. Posted an ERA of just 2.88 and allowed 33 walks.

2019: Debuted professionally with TB rookie ball affiliates in Princeton and GCL Rays.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Rays out of Campbell with the 40th overall selection in the 2019 Draft. At the time, was the highest-drafted player in Campbell history. A former two-way player at Louisburg (N.C.) junior college as a shortstop before committing to pitching full time at Campbell. Was his first time pitching since age 12. Convinced his junior college coaches to let him pitch in games after clocking 92 mph on a teammate's Pocket Radar during an off day.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
