Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds take on the Durham Bulls in game three of the six-game series. The Sounds were held to one-hit in last night's 4-0 loss. Right-hander Robert Stock will start for Nashville, facing Durham's Evan McKendry.

Robert Stock: 33-year-old Robert Stock makes his seventh appearance and fourth start of the season this evening. The right-hander is 0-3 with a 9.39 ERA (15.1 IP/16 ER) with the Sounds. His last outing was a start on April 29 vs. Omaha. He gave up five runs (4 ER) on six hits in 3.0 innings, taking a no decision. Stock was transferred to the development the day after that start and was reinstated earlier today. The Bellevue, Wash. native went 9-10 with a 3.60 ERA (165.0 IP/66 ER) in 29 starts for the Doosan Bears of the Korea Baseball Organization in 2022. He signed as a minor league free agent with Milwaukee on January 26, 2023. Stock has pitched in the big leagues with San Diego, Boston, Chicago-NL and New York-NL. He was drafted by St. Louis in the second round of the 2009 First-Year Player Draft.

Evan McKendry: 25-year-old Evan McKendry makes his fourth start in his ninth appearance with Durham this season. The right-hander is 4-0 with a 4.36 ERA (33.0 IP/16 ER) for the Bulls. McKendry was named the IL Pitcher of the Week for May 8-14 after tossing 7.0 scoreless innings and holding Charlotte to a couple hits with six strikeouts on May 12. He has taken the win in each of his last three appearances. Last year, McKendry went 0-5 with a 3.99 ERA (94.2 IP/42 ER) across 23 games (19 starts) between Double-A Montgomery (20) and Durham (3). He was taken by Tampa Bay in the ninth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Miami.

Tough Night in Durham: The Sounds were held to one hit last night for the first time since September 6, 2022 at Charlotte. Nashville also lost that contest by a 4-0 score. Joey Wiemer's seventh-inning double was the only hit.

Turn Up The Stereo: With the night off yesterday, infielder Andruw Monasterio is riding a 19-game on-base streak, the third-longest by a Sound this season behind Abraham Toro (31) and Jon Singleton (27). Over the span, he is hitting .324 (22-for-68) with 18 runs scored, a double, three homers, 14 RBI and more walks (17) than strikeouts (16).

It's Miller Time: Reliever Tyson Miller struck out three over 3.0 innings for his fifth scoreless outing in Triple-A this season. Miller boasts the lowest ERA among Sounds relievers with at least 15+ innings pitched, checking in at 1.45. It's also tied for the fourth-lowest ERA among relievers with 15+ innings pitched in the league.

Pitcher Perfect: The Sounds pitching staff boasts the second-best ERA in the league at 3.95, trailing only Norfolk's mark of 3.64. Nashville hurlers also boast the best WHIP at 1.33 and the fewest walks with 155. The bullpen has the lowest ERA among relievers at 3.39 (196.1 IP/74 ER).

Good Luck Lucas: Reliever Lucas Erceg was acquired via trade by Oakland for cash. Erceg, who pitched in parts of last and this season for the Sounds, went 5-2 with a 4.28 ERA (54.2 IP/26 ER) across 46 appearances and two starts in his career with Nashville.

Take a Walk, Take a Walk: First-baseman Jon Singleton walked three times last night, bringing his season total to 31. It was his sixth multi-walk game of the season and third of three or more free passes. He ranks fifth in the International League and ninth in Triple-A in base on balls. Singleton led all of Minor League Baseball with 117 walks last season, which also set a Sounds single-season record.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects, which has been updated due to the recent graduations of INF Brice Turang and OF Joey Wiemer. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 620-538 record during an eight-season span.

- Originally drafted by St. Louis as a catcher in the second round of the 2009 draft...hit .241 with 10 HR and 70 RBI over three seasons before converting to full-time pitcher in 2012.
