Jersey Shore BlueClaws (18-34) at Bowling Green Hot Rods (29-23)

Bowling Green Ballpark – Bowling Green, Kentucky (opened 2009) RHP Estibenzon Jimenez (4-2, 6.81) vs RHP Garrett Edwards (4-2, 2.83) Series: Game 3 of 6 (Bowling Green leads season series 2-0 of 6)

Last Game Recap...Adrian Santana had four hits and scored three times while Marcus Johnson threw six innings and gave up just two runs as Bowling Green bested Jersey Shore 8-2 on Wednesday afternoon at Bowling Green Ballpark...Dylan Campbell homered and stole a base for Jersey Shore...Aaron Combs took the loss, allowing two runs in 2.2 innings of work.

Welcome to the Blue Grass...The BlueClaws are in Bowling Green (BG leads 2-0) for the first time since 2022 when they went 2-4...The holt Rods came to ShoreTown last year and the BlueClaws lost the first game and won the next five, which marked the first five games of a team record 11 game winning streak.

State of the Teams...The BlueClaws went 1-5 last week in Greenville, winning Sunday after dropping the first five games of the series...They are still winless in series this year, going 0-8-1, with their lone split coming in Lakewood against Aberdeen from May 6th – 11th...Bowling Green went 4-2 in Greensboro last week after a 6-6 homestand against Asheville and Greenville...They are 1.5 games up on Hub City in the SAL Southern Division.

Going, Going, Gone...Last year, the BlueClaws had four players hit more than six home runs (Jordan Dissin – 9,
Leandro Pineda – 8, Felix Reyes – 8, and Troy Schreffler – 8), though for the first time in team history, nobody hit

10...This year, they already have four players with five or more (Dylan Campbell – 6, Carson DeMartini – 6, Bryson Ware – 6, Kehden Hettiger – 5).

DC Bouncing Back...Dylan Campbell homered on Wednesday at Bowling Green, his sixth of the season and second since May 20th...He is 8-29 since May 25th with two doubles, a home run, and six stolen bases...Gampbell stole 42 bases last year with Great Lakes (A+, Dodgers) and came over to the Phillies in a January trade...He was originally a 4th round pick of the Dodgers in 2023 from the University of Texas.

DeMartini Homers Again, Heating Up....Carson DeMartini homered on Tuesday after he hit two homers in Greenville and now has three home runs on the trip...DeMartini is 15-48 with five home runs and 12 RBIs since the start of the Brooklyn on May 20°....He now has six home runs on the season, five since May 22nd (his first was a three-run shot in the seventh inning of the home opener on April 8° against Aberdeen)...DeMartini has eight professional home runs after hitting two with Clearwater last year...A 4th round pick last year from Virginia Tech, DeMartini hit 46 home runs in three years in Blacksburg, including 21 in 2024 as a junior.

Welcome Saul...Saul (Sah-OOL) Teran threw a 1-2-3 inning with two strikeouts in his BlueClaws debut on Wednesday at Bowling Green...He joins the BlueClaws from Clearwater where he gave up two earned runs in 18 innings with 31 strikeouts and three walks...He also spent last year with the Threshers, going 3-1 with a 3.96 ERA and 36 strikeouts in 25 innings pitched...Teran, 23 years old, signed with the Phillies in February of 2021...RHP Josh Hejka was transferred to Reading.

Big Flies in Big Moments...Eduardo Lopez has four home runs on the year and a knack for the big moment...June 1st at GVL (2-run HR to break 7-7 tie in 12th inning)...May 24th vs BRK (3-run HR to put BlueClaws up 8-6 in 6th inning)...April 12th vs ABD (3-run HR to put BlueClaws up 8-7 in 5th inning of seven inning game)...Lopez joined the Phillies in December in the Minor League Rule-5 Draft after spending the last two years with Greenville in the South Atlantic League.

Ware 'em Out...Bryson Ware twice last week in Greenville (Thursday and Friday)...He now has six on the year, five in May, and four since May 22nd...He had two hits in both ends of the 5/25 double-header, including a long ball...Since May 9th, he is 17-56 with seven doubles, five home runs, 12 RBIs, and three walks...Prior to the current stretch, Ware had been 0-20 in May and 2 for his previous 35...Ware was an 8th round pick in 2023 from Auburn University...He hit 10 home runs in 2023, nine with Clearwater and one with the BlueClaws.

Getting Higgy With It...Matt Higgins hit his second BlueClaws home run and his 19th professional home run on Tuesday at Bowling Green...Since May 15th, Higgins is 11-34 with two doubles and a home run plus six RBis...Higgins joined the BlueClaws on May 8th after he was released by the Giants while playing for Double-A Richmond...Higgins had played in the Giants system since 2022 after signing out of Bellarmine (KY).

Hetti-Gone...Kehden Hettiger homered on Tuesday at bowling Green after he went deep Friday in Greenville, giving him five on the season and 10 in his career...He is 10-27 with a double, triple (off Mets RHP Frankie Montas) and two home runs since May 24th...Hettiger homered in his first BlueClaws at bat on 4/17 at Greensboro and hit a walk-off home run to beat Aberdeen on 5/6 at ShoreTown Ballpark...He was an 11th round pick in 2023 (Sierra Canyon HS, CA) and turned 21 on May 25th.

Jordan's Back...Jordan Dissin returns to the BlueClaws to start a minor league rehab assignment (5-20, 3 walks)...Dissin hit .214 with nine HRs with the BlueClaws last year while throwing out 28% of opposing base-stealers...He went 4-18 at the start of the season with Jersey Shore before going to Reading, where he was 8-34 and placed on the IL on May 5th.

Walka-Thom...Luke Davis has drawn 29 walks in just 121 plate appearances so far this season...Davis has at least two walks in seven games this season and had a team-record tying four in a 4/18 game at Greensboro...<u>The BlueClaws High-A record is 60 walks by Baron Radcliff in 408 plate appearances in 2022</u>...The 22 year old Davis signed with the Phillies in July out of Long Beach City College where he was the South Coast Conference Player of the Year.

Lock It Down...Paxton Thompson earned his second save of the year in the win in game two on 5/25 against Brooklyn...Jaydenn Estanista got his third save of the season, tying him for the team lead, and seventh professional save, in the win on Saturday, his second save of the series after he saved Tuesday's game (his first save was on 4/30 at Hudson Valley...Tommy McCollum (promoted to Reading on 5/1), has three.

Big Innings...The BlueClaws have allowed four-plus runs in an inning 22 times this season, once on Tuesday (tied with Asheville for the most in the league), in 20 different games over which they are 1-19...Their lone win in a game in which they allowed four runs in an inning was game two of the 4/12 double-header against Aberdeen, an 8-7 come-from-behind win (Eduardo Lopez go-ahead home run in the 5th of the seven inning game)...15 of the 22 innings have included multiple walks.

From the Draft... Carson <u>DeMartiniis the lone member of the Phillies 2024 draft class to open the season with the BlueClaws</u> (4th round pick, Virginia Tech)... This is the third straight year only one member of the previous year's draft class opened the season with the BlueClaws (2024 – 3B Zach Arnold, 11th round, 2023; 2023 – OF Troy Schreffler, 15th round, 2022)... DeMartini hit the game winning home run in the Spring Breakout game against the Pirates on March 14th... He had 46 home runs at Virginia Tech including 24 as a junior last year... Aaron Combs was an 8th round pick last year by the White Sox and traded to the Phillies (for LHP Tyler Gilbert) on New Year's Day.

New to the Phillies...The BlueClaws roster includes six players that were acquired by the Phillies in the off-season: RHP Augusto Calderon (Minor League Rule-5 from the Cardinals), RHP Aaron Combs (from the White Sox for LHP Tyler Gilbert), OF Dylan Campbell (from the Dodgers for international bonus pool money), RHP Josh Hejka (from the Mets in February for cash considerations), OF Eduardo Lopez (Minor League Rule-5 from the Red Sox), and OF Elio Prado (Minor League Rule-5 from the Orioles)...C Luis Caicuto was a Minor League Rule-5 pick from the Diamondbacks in December of 2023...The Phillies were the only team to use six picks in the 2024 Minor League Rule-5 Draft.

Comebacks...The BlueClaws erased a 4-0 deficit on May 10^{th} to come back and top Aberdeen 9-8, matching their largest comeback win of the season...Their win on 4/17 at Greensboro was their first of the season in which they trailed after the 8^{th} inning – they had five such wins last year (last one was 7/21/24 at Brooklyn when they tied the game in the 9^{th} inning on an RBI double from Felix Reyes and scored three times in the 10^{th})...Meanwhile, the BlueClaws lost a 7-0 lead on 4/18 at Greensboro, their largest blown lead since also losing a 7-0 at Greensboro, on 5/31/15, and the fourth time since 2011 (4/19/12 at Hagerstown and 4/22/11 at Asheville) they have lost a seven run lead...The BlueClaws gave up two in the ninth to fall on 5/3 at Hudson Valley, a game they led in the ninth after a Jordan Viars tie-breaking home run put them up 4-3 earlier in the inning.

Power Index...Devin Saltiban led all current BlueClaws with 18 home runs in 2024 (17 with Clearwater)...Jordan Viars had 14 last year, 12 with Clearwater and two (both in the final series of the season) with Jersey Shore...Dylan Campbell hit 10 with Great Lakes in the Dodgers system.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have one walk-off win this year – a 5/6 win over Aberdeen on a home run by Kehden Hettiger...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins in 2024 –July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), plus July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen.

Going For Five...The BlueClaws enter 2025 with four straight winning halves, both halves in 2023 and 2024, all four halves managed by Greg Brodzinski...The BlueClaws had 10 straight winning halves from 2006 through 2010, all 10 halves in that five year stretch, a streak snapped when they went 33-35 in the first half of the 2011 season.

New to ShoreTown...Of the 31 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 13 are making their BlueClaws debuts this season...Of the remaining 18, 14 were with the BlueClaws at the end of the 2024 season (the remaining four were with Reading: RHP Andrew Baker, RHP Tommy McCollum, C Jordan Dissin, IF Zach Arnold)...Baker, McCollum, and Dissin have all been promoted to Reading, though Baker has since returned.

Just Grand...Bryan Rincon's grand slam on 5/20 vs Brooklyn was the BlueClaws first since Jordan Dissin's on June 11, 2024 at Greensboro...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...126 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show. Mick Abel made his Phillies debut on 5/18 to become the first to debut this year...Two debuted last year (Ben Brown debuted with the Cubs and Sam Aldegheri debuted with the Angels)...Aldegheri, who was with the BlueClaws from Opening Day 2024 through July 6th, joins Orion Kerkering (2023) as the only players to ever play for the BlueClaws and in the big leagues in the same year (non-rehab).

Just Win Baby...The BlueClaws are the only team in the South Atlantic League and High-A to win more than 70 games in both 2023 (73-58) and 2024 (74-58).

Bull Back for a Third...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2025 after leading

the BlueClaws to a 73-58 mark in 2023 (and a postseason berth) and a 74-58 mark in 2024...He is the first manager to lead the BlueClaws in three seasons (PJ Forbes in 2004-05, Steve Roadcap in 2007-08, Mickey Morandini in 2012-13, Shawn Williams in 2015-16 and Marty Malloy in 2017-18 are the five managers to manage the BlueClaws for two seasons)...Brodzinski was a coach with Lehigh Valley in 2022 and on the Phillies staff in 2020 and 2021...He is a graduate of Bishop Eustace Prep in Pennsauken, New Jersey.
