Last Game: The Delmarva Shorebirds saw their three-game winning streak end on Saturday, as they were defeated by the Hill City Howlers 8-4. After Hill City scored a run in the first inning, the Shorebirds came back with two in the top of the third on an RBI double by **Felix Amparo** and an RBI fielder's choice from **Braylon Whitaker**, putting Delmarva ahead 2-1. The lead was brief for the Shorebirds, as Hill City tied the game on an RBI double by **Cannon Peebles** in the bottom half of the inning. **Reiner Herrera** then hit a two-run homer to give the Howlers a 4-2 advantage. **Miguel Rodriguez** made it a one-run game in the fourth with an RBI single, but it was all Howlers from there, as they put three more runs on the board in the bottom of the fifth and one more in the sixth to go up 8-3. **Junior Aybar** drove a run home with a sacrifice fly in the ninth, but it was not enough in an 8-4 loss.

Sizzling Sanchez: After a tough start and an unlucky run of injuries, **Jordan Sanchez** has turned it on in a major way. Since the start of June, the Orioles' No. 16 prospect is hitting .306, with five doubles, four home runs, 25 RBIs, and 11 multi-hit games across 30 starts.

Make Way for Lo Re: **Jaiden Lo Re** has quickly made an impact at the top of Delmarva's order. In 33 games, Lo Re has 39 hits and is batting .331, with 14 multi-hit games and a 12-game hitting streak. He has been an on-base regular with a .448 OBP, thanks to 25 walks compared to 12 strikeouts over 146 plate appearances. The Orioles' 5th-round pick in 2025 has been an elite contact hitter early in his career, swinging and missing on just 7.3% of pitches he swings at. Lo Re's incredible June earned him the Orioles' Minor League Player of the Month honors.

Hot Adriander: After going hitless in his first four starts with the Shorebirds, **Adriander Mejia** has heated up for Delmarva. Over his last eight games, Mejia is 11-for-34 (.323) at the plate with four doubles and four multi-hit games. He joined the Shorebirds on June 30 after a dominant run in the FCL, where he hit .320 with 4 home runs and 28 RBIs in 32 games.

Play the hits, DJ: **DJ Layton** has been the Shorebirds' most productive bat in what has been a breakout campaign for the 20-year-old. Layton leads the team in several offensive categories, including walks (62), RBIs (38), runs (52), OBP (.394), OPS (.784), doubles (16), and stolen bases (30). Layton has reached base safely in 41 of his last 44 games and earlier in the season had a 23-game on-base streak, the longest by a Shorebird since 2021.

Hot Rod: **Christian Rodriguez** has emerged as Delmarva's ace this season. Rodriguez leads the league in innings pitched (94.2) and ERA (2.57) and strikeouts (100). He has five quality starts this season, the most by a Delmarva pitcher since 2019, when **Ryan Wilson** had 8 and **Hector Guance** had 6. C-Rod has not allowed an earned run in any of his four July starts, spanning 19.2 innings.

Whit Can Hit: **Braylon Whitaker** has been a revelation for the Shorebirds as their primary leadoff hitter. The former 19th-round pick from 2024 leads the team in hits (74) and batting average (.276), which ranks ninth in the Carolina League. He also paces the Shorebirds in multi-hit games with 18 and is starting to find his power swing, hitting his first two professional home runs on June 28 at Fayetteville and on July 3 at home against Charleston

About the Howlers: The Shorebirds make their only trip to City Stadium in Lynchburg, Virginia, this week as they continue their nine-game road trip. The Hill City Howlers, formerly the Lynchburg Hillcats, began playing Delmarva in 2021. Last season was the first time the Cleveland Guardians' affiliate won the season series against the Shorebirds, going 11-5 versus Delmarva en route to their league title.
