SHOREBIRDS BOUNCE BACK IN GAME 2: The Delmarva Shorebirds evened the series with the Salem Red Sox on Wednesday night as they picked up a 7-3 win. After falling behind 2-0 in the top of the first, the Shorebirds worked their way back with an RBI ground-out by **Mac Horvath**, with **Randy Florentino** providing a solo home run in the second to tie the game. Horvath then put the Shorebirds in front with his first Single-A home run in the third. **Anderson De Los Santos** scored **Stiven Acevedo** with an RBI single to give Delmarva a 4-2 edge after three. The bullpen would lock in for the Shorebirds the rest of the night led by **Raul Rangel** who tossed four innings of relief, **Luis Barroso** and **Randy Beriguete** would finish it off by combining for the final 9 outs and with the Shorebirds putting up three insurance runs in the eighth, they would cruise to a 7-3 victory on Wednesday night.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Deivy Cruz toes the slab for the Shorebirds on Thursday night against Salem right-hander Yordanny Moengro in a battle of aces. Monegro has really come on strong for the Red Sox since being added to the roster on June 20 as he makes his eighth start for Salem tonight, owig an ERA of 2.56 in 31.2 innings. Mon-egro is now one of the top prospects in the Red Sox organization as he comes in at No. 22 per MLB pipeline. The right-hander is coming off a start where he punched out 11 batters, matching his career-best which he also did this season on June 25 against Down East in his first Single-A start.

SPEED, I AM SPEED: Enrique Bradfield Jr. has quickly made his presence known with his speed upon his arrival last week. The 1st round pick from Vanderbilt 11 bases without being caught in his first five starts as a Shorebird and swiped 4 bases on Sunday against the Carolina Mudcats, the most by a Delmarva player in a single game this season. More impressively, Bradfield has reached base at a .552 clip so far thanks to 9 walks he's drawn in his brief Single-A tenure.

FEAR THE BEARD: 10th Round pick, Matthew Etzel has been on fire since he made his debut with the Shorebirds on August 8. In six games so far, Etzel is batting .310 with 2 home runs, 9 RBI, and has stolen 7 bases. His highlight performance was on Sunday against the Carolina Mudcats where he drove home 6 runs with 4 of them coming on his go-ahead grand slam in the fifth inning. His 6 RBI is the most by a Shorebird in a single game this season.

ON THE RUN: The Shorebirds currently ranked 11th in the league in stolen bases, but have been running much more lately as they have 35 steals in the month of August, which is the second most in the league in that span. Delmarva ran often last week against Carolina swiped 21 bases and were caught only three times.

A LITTLE EXTRA: The offense for Delmarva leads the league in extra-base hits this season with a total of 263. They are top five in the league doubles (162), triples (29), and home runs (76). The Shorebirds had 11 total extra base hits in the previous series against Lynchburg.

MORE ARMS ON THE WAY: The Delmarva Shorebirds added more players from the 2023 Orioles' Draft Class including 3rd Rounder Kiefer Lord, 12th Rounder Blake Money, and non-drafted free agent Ty Weatherly. In addition, Zach Peek joins the Shorebirds staff on MiLB Rehab Assignment who is currently on the IL for the Bowie Baysox.

LAST BATTLE WITH SALEM: The Shorebirds will look to finish their season series against the Boston Red Sox affiliate with a winning record. Delmarva is currently 11-9 versus Salem and have take 2/3 in a pair of three-game sets, and won 4/5 in Salem's only trip to Delmarva at the end of April.

TODAY'S STARTER: Deivy Cruz gets the start in Game 3 against the Salem Red Sox, making his 21st appearance and 13th start of 2023.

LAST OUTING (8/11 @ CAR): Cruz earned his team-best, 8th winning decision last time out on Friday in Carolina as he went five innings on the mound for the 6th time this season, not allowing any runs on just two hits in a 7-1 win.

vs. SALEM: This will be the fourth time in 2023 Cruz will pitch against the Salem Red Sox, earning a win the last time he saw them on July 16 as a reliever. He went 4 innings in that appearance and did not allow a run as he took the Shorebirds to the finish line in a 2-1 win. On the season, Cruz is 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA in 12 innings versus Salem with 12 strikeouts and 6 walks along with a .128 opponent batting average.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: At 18 years old, Deivy Cruz was a bright spot in the in the Orioles organization pitching most of the season in Delmarva. He began in the FCL and made 3 starts that covered 13 innings, striking out 17 with 4 earned run allowed. Was moved up to the Shorebirds on June 21 and would appear in 13 games, 12 starts where he finished with an ERA of 4.02 and a 2-5 record. Opponents hit .224 against Cruz as he struck out 52 with 37 walks during his time in Delmarva. He was very effective in his first two months in a Shorebird uniform as he allowed just 3 earned runs across his first 6 starts that covered 26.1 innings in June & July.

REVERSE SPLITS: Despite being left-handed, Cruz has handled righthanded batters better than lefties as he owns an opponent batting average of .188 versus righties with an opposing OPS of .616



FELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

MANAGER



Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

PITCHING COACH



Bleday enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. From there, Bleday spent two season in the Astros minor league ranks before making the jump to coaching in 2019. He is the brother of current Oakland A's Outfielder J.J. Bleday.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

HITTING COACH



Josh Bunselmeyer takes over as the Shorebirds Hitting Coach in 2023 after spending the last three seasons as a hitting coach for the Orioles between the Florida Complex League and the Dominican Summer League. Before coaching, Bunselmeyer played independent ball for the three season in the Frontier League as a utility player after playing college baseball for Saint Louis University.

FUNDAMENTALS COACH



Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.

DEVELOPMENT COACH



Collin Murray is the Shorebirds Development Coach and this is his second season as a coach in Delmarva and in the Orioles' organization. Prior to joining the Orioles, Murray worked with three other MLB clubs (Tigers, Marlins, and Angels), most recently as a Baseball Information Assistant with the Detroit Tigers in 2021.
