LRST TIME OUT

(SYRACUSE, NY - Sept 8) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders beat the Syracuse Mets 8-7 in eleven innings. In the series finale, the RailRiders took an early lead and fought back against a late rally for their fifth win on the week.

For the third straight contest, the RailRiders scored in the first frame. Caleb Durbin legged out a single and with the bases loaded Oswald Peraza sent him home. In the fourth inning, SWB took charge. Jorbit Vivas, T.J. Ruffield, and Taylor Trammell had three straight singles to load the bases. JC Escarra smashed a grand slam to right for a 5-0 lead. It was his sixth homer on the week, totaling 12 runs driven in. On the flip side Edgar Barclay was sharp sitting down the first dozen batters he faced. He let up just one run in five innings of work on a pair of hits. Barclay struck out three in his second start of the week. Syracuse got on the board in the fifth and sixth frames. Newcomer José Azocar notched an RBI single for a 5-1 score. The Mets tacked on two more thanks to four straight hits for a 5-3 score. The RailRiders took a run back in the next inning. Greg Allen was hit by a pitch and stole two bases to get in scoring position. Jasson Dominguez roped a sacrifice fly to left for Allen to manufacture a run. In the eighth, Oswald Peraza led off with a knock and stole second. He came home on Ruffield's 66th RBI of the summer. It was 7-3 SWB. Syracuse fought all the way back in the final frame to tie things up. Carlos Cortes sent a solo shot over the fence in right center off of Anthony Misiewicz. Then Joe Hudson followed with a three-run blast of his own putting the game at seven apiece. Neither team was able to plate a run in the tenth so the RailRiders saw the 11th inning for just the second time this summer. With Taylor Trammell as the pace-of-play runner, Durbin sent a ground ball to the right side to move him over. Greg Allen notched a sacrifice fly into right and Trammell raced home. It was 8-7 SWB. Yerry De Los Santos (W, 2-1) got two big outs in the final frame helped by sharp defense. Oddanier Mosqueda (S, 5) entered and recorded a strikeout to end the ball game.

NEWS & NOTES

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - JC Escarra found his groove at the plate this week at Syracuse. Escarra went 8-for-17 to bat .471 in five games. The lefty hit six home runs to help drive in a dozen runs, a fifth of the RailRiders runs scored in the series. He also scored nine of his own while walking, three times, more than he struck out, once. In the series opener, JC worked a double and walked before homering in his final plate appearance of the evening. He began Wednesday's contest with another two long balls, recording one in three consecutive at-bats. The 29-year-old swatted one more each on Friday and Saturday again in his first at-bats of the day. In the series finale, Escarra launched a grand slam for his sixth homer of the week, just the second hit by SWB this summer.

PLAYOFF PUSH - The RailRiders sit tied for second with three other teams in the second half as they are four games back of Columbus in the International League. Lehigh Valley is ten games out of the leader as there are 13 games left to play.

OFFENSE OUTSTANDING - The SWB bats were outstanding last week, boasting the third highest average, .314, on the week. The team has tallied the most runs scored, 60, and the most homers, 16. This was the most long balls the team has hit in a single week.

MAGIC MAN - Josh Maciejewski is set to make his 17th appearance, tenth start of the season for the RailRiders. Maciejewski has a 6.02 earned run average in Triple-A. He made four outings with NYY after his Major League debut for a 2.57 ERA. The lefty also pitched 12.2 innings for a 7.71 earned run average in Double-A.

ON THE MOVE - The RailRiders have reached 200 stolen bases for the first time in franchise history. After the team swiped six this week they have tallied 217, topping last year's 174 total. This is the most in the International League and just 20 behind the league record set by Omaha last year. They also have the second most in Triple-A behind Tacoma's ridiculous 259.

WHO CAN GO? - The RailRiders active roster currently contains nine players that are also on the Yankees 40-man roster. There are four pitchers, including one starter. The team also features five position players who are eligible for a quick call-up, including #16 Jorbit Vivas, Oswald Peraza, Ben Rice, and Carlos Narvaez also remain on the big league 40-man.

VERSUS LEFT - The RailRiders have seven of fifteen arms as lefties on their pitching staff right now. Three of them are set to be a part of the starting rotation. Southpaw pitchers have held opposing batters to a .230 average against this summer. Lehigh Valley hitters have worked a .255 average against lefties.

SAVE SITUATION - SWB recorded three saves last week to total 38 on the season. They are tied for the most saves in the IL with Omaha and Nashville. Anthony Misiewicz leads the team with eight.
