TUESDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Senators, 3-2, in 11 innings to open the series on Tuesday. Richmond won the game with a walk-off single by **Andy Thomas** in the bottom of the 11th. It was the first extra-inning win of the year for the Flying Squirrels. Richmond starter **Mason Black** allowed two hits over five scoreless innings, his longest outing the year, extending his scoreless streak to 13.1 innings. The Senators broke the scoreless tie with two runs in the sixth. James Wood hit an RBI double and Frankie Tostado brought in a run with a single. The Flying Squirrels tied the game, 2-2, in the bottom of the sixth. Thomas and **Brandon Martorano** worked bases-loaded walks. **Juan Sanchez** threw three scoreless innings out of the bullpen. **Evan Gates** threw a scoreless top of the 11th.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. Richmond played six games in Harrisburg from April 11-16 and dropped four of them, three by one run. The Flying Squirrels return to Harrisburg for a three-game series from July 14-16. The Senators will play a second six-game set at The Diamond from August 15-20.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS were 14-7 through their first 21 games but are 15-28 since May 3. For the year, Richmond starters have thrown 229.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 322.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.28 ERA, which is the second-lowest in Double-A and is sixth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

THE SENATORS are in fourth place in the Southwest Division, five games behind first-place Erie. They have dropped six-of-their-last-eight games, including four-of-six in last week's series at home against the SeaWolves. The Harrisburg offense has scored 273 runs, the fewest in the Eastern League this year. Harrisburg relievers lead the league with 20 saves. Harrisburg's roster features seven of Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF James Wood (No. 1), OF Robert Hassell III (No. 2), RHP Jackson Rutledge (No. 6), RHP Cole Henry (No. 13), 3B Trey Lipscomb (No. 17), LHP Mitchell Parker (No. 24) and OF Jacob Young (No. 27). Hassell is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best strike-zone discipline in the system. Evan Lee is rated as having the best curveball in the system. MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects list includes Wood (No. 1), Hassell (No. 2), Rutledge (No. 11), Henry (No. 12), Lipscomb (No. 18) and Parker (No. 22).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Ryan Murphy makes his 12th start of the season and his second against the Senators. He last pitched last Thursday at Bowie and allowed two runs over four innings. In his last three starts since June 4, Murphy is 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA (3 ER/12.0 IP). He last faced the Senators on April 12 at FNB Field and allowed a season-high-tying four runs over four innings in a no-decision. Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, N.Y., and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. Murphy is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 20 Giants prospect and No. 27 by MLB.com. For more on Murphy, see page two.

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Jackson Rutledge makes his 12th start of the season and his second against Richmond. Last time out, he worked a season-high seven innings against the SeaWolves last Thursday and surrendered two runs in a no-decision. He pitched against the Flying Squirrels on April 13 in Harrisburg and allowed two runs over five innings to pick up his first win of the year. On the season, Rutledge is ranked second in the Eastern League in WHIP (1.11), sixth in innings pitched (62.1), tied for sixth in BAA (.218) and seventh in ERA (3.18). Rutledge was selected in the first round (17th overall) of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Nationals out of San Jacinto College in Texas. This year marks his first season at the Double-A level.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, the Flying Squirrels are again at the top of the level in average attendance (6,670) and rank first in total attendance (220,103). The team's average attendance is the 12th-highest among the 120 full-season teams in Minor League Baseball.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: On Tuesday, **Andy Thomas** lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 3-2 win with a walk-off single in the top of the 11th inning. He drove in two runs in the game. It was the second walk-off win for the Flying Squirrels this season. Over his last four games since last Friday, Thomas has picked up five RBIs.

LEDVE LUCI: On June 4, **Marco Luciano** hit a grand slam and a two-run homer in the Flying Squirrels' 11-2 win. It was the fourth multi-homer game of his career. He went deep again with a two-run homer on Sunday afternoon and added a 432-foot, opposite-field two-run shot last Wednesday at Bowie. Since he began his season with his Double-A debut on May 3, his nine home runs are tied for the ninth-most in the Eastern League. He is also tied for the team lead in homers this year. Luciano went on a five-game hit streak from June 10-14, during which he hit .588 (10-for-17) with four homers, a double, five walks and 10 RBIs. Since then, he has gone 1-for-18 in his last four games.

ALRIGHT, ALDRETE: Carter Aldrete homered three times in last week's series in Bowie. He went deep in the first two games of the series, launching a solo shot on Tuesday and adding another solo homer in the first game of Wednesday's doubleheader. In the series finale on Sunday, he hit a three-run homer in the first inning to give the Flying Squirrels an early lead. For the season, he is tied for the team lead with nine home runs. Since his promotion to Double-A on July 23, 2022, Aldrete has the most home runs (15), RBIs (55), hits (85), doubles (19) and extra-base hits (34) of any Flying Squirrels player.

WELCOME BACK, WADE: Wade Meckler was reinstated from the injured list last Saturday after missing 12 games. In his five games back from the IL, he has reached base 10 times (six hits and four walks). In his first game back, he reached base three times with two walks and a two-run double. He went 3-for-5 with a double on Saturday night. For the year, Meckler leads all minor league hitters (min. 140 PA) in batting average (.408), is tied for sixth in OBP (.472) and sits second in BABIP (.454). He has picked up 15 hits and nine walks in his 12 Double-A games since being promoted from High-A Eugene on May 17.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny was assigned to the Richmond roster on June 13. In his season debut for the Flying Squirrels that night at Bowie, he hit a first-inning homer on the second pitch of the game. On Sunday, Matheny added three hits, including two doubles, and drove in three runs. In his seven games with Richmond this year, Matheny has three doubles, a homer, five RBIs and six walks.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Hayden Cantrelle is seventh in OBP (.402). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for third in triples (3). Kai-Wei Teng is eighth in strikeouts (68). Mason Black is tied for first in games started (13).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is also rated as the No. 63 prospect on Baseball America's Top 100. In Baseball America's "Best Tools" list, Luciano is rated as the best power hitter, Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and best athlete, Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp is rated as having the best curveball and José Cruz is rated as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes 10 Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2, No. 18 overall), Brown (No. 5), Whisenhunt (No. 8), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 25), Murphy (No. 26), Cruz (No. 29) and Meckler (No. 30).
