Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Rorik Maltrud** to the mound tonight, looking to bounce back from last night's loss (5-0 with a 2.89ERA in 14G after a Clipper loss). The Cubs will counter with LHP **Braxton Garrett**. Columbus is 16-22 (.421) versus left handers this year. Garrett has never pitched against the Clippers in his career, as tonight will be his 48th game in the IL (2021-26 with Jacksonville).

vs. the Cubs

Since a 5G win streak against Iowa from 5/12-6/14/24, the Clippers are 21-20opposing the I-Cubs (36-27 in the last 63G). Individually, **Milan Tolentino** has hit the Cubs at a .330 clip (35x106) with 10HR and 26RBI in his career (30G). **Kahlil Watson** has hit .317 (19x60) with 4HR and 12RBI in 16G, while **Kody Huff** has hit .302 (26x86) with 2HR and 17RBI in 22G (**Cooper Ingle** has 3HR, 10RBI in 13G).

Start with a Bang

Over the last 31G, the Clippers have plated 222 runs (most in the IL, 7.2 per), with 150 (68%) tallied in the first four innings of the game, including 52 in the 1st. Opponents have only 71 in the first four innings of the last 31G, but are outscoring the Clippers 108-72 thereafter. Last night was the first time in over a month (7/26 at St. Paul), that the Clippers were held scoreless through the first four innings.

Back to the Launch Pad

Columbus leads all of pro baseball in homers hit since 7/28 (68, accounting for 49% of runs: 110 of 222) and have allowed the 8th most (53, 2nd in IL; accounts for 45%: 81 of 179). Huntington Park has been breached 79 times in the last 19G, but only five times in 3G this week (all for the Clippers; Columbus pitching has not had 4G with 0HR at home since a 5G run from 5/24-6/5/25, 2G vs. Iowa).

700 Club

The lineup drew 3BB last night for the second straight game (8.2 per game in prior 5G), giving them an IL-high 697BB (+57 on 2nd place; Iowa leads with 671BB issued). The Clippers are pacing for 776BB (in 147G), a total that would obliterate the club record set in 1983 (741 in 140G). Since 2023, 11 teams in the IL have reached 700BB, including nine in 2023 (zero seasons of 700BB from 1985-2022).

Big Time Production

Kyle Manzardo has hit safely in each of 16G since 8/15 (.344, 22x64, 3HR), while collecting 21RBI (RBI in 13G of streak). In his career with Columbus, Manzardo has played only 127G (559PA), but he has still managed 69XBH (.561SLG), including 31HR, against just 56 singles. Additionally, he has scored 99 times with 91RBI, while keeping his strikeout rate under 20% (106K, 19%; 85BB, 15%).

King Ralph

Dating to 7/28, **Ralph Velazquez** leads the IL in HR (17, +6), RBI (41, +8) and SLG (.820, +84) and, aside from going 0x21 in 6G at St. Paul (7/21-7/26), is hitting .337/.421/.674 since 6/18 (20HR, 55RBI). Though Velazquez has not homered in the last 5G (14AB), he has 8BB in 23PA (8BB in prior 23G, 102PA) and has 11RBI in his last 10G (1HR in 35AB, had 16HR and 30RBI in previous 20G, 76AB).

Another High

A day after his 20G on base streak was snapped (tied career long, .382OBP from 8/2-9/1), **Kody Huff** got back to work with a multi-hit game last night. Huff is hitting .429 (12x28) over his last 7G, including a 4x4 performance on 8/23 vs. St. Paul, after a 19G slump from 7/26-8/22 (.134, 9x67). He has yet to go deep on the current hotness (5HR during slump), though he does have 6XBH (.600SLG).

Power and Speed

Milan Tolentino got to the doorstep of 20HR on Tuesday, while also embiggening his steal total to 17, as he attempts to secure the second 20-20 season in franchise history. He scored the first such season last year and, since the start of 2025, he is tied for 1st in the IL with 40HR (t-25th with 37SB). After poking a grand slam on 8/18, he went 3x37 in his next 10G (8/19-8/29; 5x14, 2HR in 4G since).

Turner It Up

Tyresse Turner made his Triple-A debut last night, becoming the 67th player to appear for Columbus (28th position player). Columbus has seen only 156 roster moves this season, compared to 215 through 9/4 last year (ended with 221). The Clippers sent **Austin Peterson** to the Majors today, as he is the 100th Clipper to appear on an MLB roster this year (will be 11th debut when he plays).

This Date in Clipper History

9/4/1996

Columbus opened the semi finals with an 11-5 thumping of Norfolk. **Dave Eiland**, six years removed from his Clipper of the Year and IL Most Valuable Pitcher season, picked up the win on the mound for the Clippers. Eiland would also get the start in game one of the Governors' Cup finals in 1996, setting the tone for Columbus' sweep of Rochester with a complete game in the Clippers' 5-2 win over the Red Wings.

First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,494 to 1,444).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 185-146 (.559) in pitch reviews, with batters going 93-87 (.517) and pitchers/catchers going 92-59 (.609). They have run out of challenges in 48G and have not challenged in 8G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-4 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-37 when playing past regulation (.598, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 92G to require extra play, 73 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 844, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 157 through 132G (on pace for 175SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 46CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (51; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

Crazy Eighthths

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 185 runs while crafting a .889OPS (over 60 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 121 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +64 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 305-187 from innings 5-7).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 80 grand slams and 1,995RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.43 through 132G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). Additionally, the staff is pacing to give up 204HR (would be 2nd most in franchise history; 214HR allowed in 2023).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 8th in the IL this year (.980), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 71G this season (41-30, .577), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Good Baseball

CJ Kayfus bunted a runner into scoring position with a single on 7/5 vs. Louisville, with that runner kicking off a 5-run inning that led the Clippers to victory. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 90-23 (.796) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 7-2 mark this season (.778, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers have the 8th most last at bat wins this year (15, three off the lead) while playing in the 13th most games decided in the last at bat (28, Norfolk has 39). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 102G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 49-53 (.480, 16th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-79, **Joe Altobelli**-80, **Frank Verdi**-81, **Bucky Dent**-87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-10). This season marks Tracy's seventh year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 457-467 (.495), 427-421 with Columbus (.504).
