SLIDE IN ST. PAUL: The Omaha Storm Chasers fell behind early on Friday, trailing 5-0 after the second inning in an eventual 7-3 loss to St. Paul. **LHP Daniel Lynch** allowed 10 hits, which tied a career high, and yielded seven runs, which tied a season high from his previous start at CHS Field on 6/10. Right-hander **Josh Winder**, who made his Triple-A debut with the Saints, held the Chasers hitless for 5.1 innings before **INF/OF Erick Mejia** lofted a single in the sixth inning. Two batters later, after Winder had exited the game following his eighth strikeout, **INF Gabriel Cancel** launched a two-run homer off the batter's eye. Right-hander **Jace Vines** and right-hander **Grant Gavin** combined for 2.1 scoreless innings with four strikeouts and zero walks in relief for Omaha.

PITCHING PROBLEMS: Over the last 10 games, Chasers pitching has a 7.05 ERA, including a starting pitcher ERA of 8.02, with only five of the team's 10 starts on the road trip lasting at least 5.0 innings. On the year, Omaha starting pitchers have combined for a 5.55 ERA. The Chasers have allowed at least six runs and double-digit hits in four of the last five games. However, Chasers pitching has combined for just one walk in the last 17.0 innings, including issuing zero walks in a game for the second time this season on 7/2. The bullpen has a 5.45 ERA during the road trip (and a 4.34 ERA for the season), but has not allowed a run in its last 6.0 innings.

ROCKY ROAD: The Storm Chasers have lost four of their last five games, the first time this season Omaha has lost four games in a five-game span. Through 10 games of the current 12-game road trip, Omaha has a 4-6 record. On the season, the Chasers are 14-13 on the road and 19-5 at Werner Park. In 27 road games, the Chasers are batting .259/.336/.478 with 48 home runs. The team's 5.88 ERA in away games is second-worst in the league. At home, the Chasers are batting a league-best .282 (1st) / .346 (T-4th) / .523 (1st) with 49 home runs and a 3.63 team ERA.

HISTORIC HOMER PACE: The Storm Chasers lead Triple-A East and all of Minor League Baseball with 97 home runs in 51 games, averaging just under two home runs per game. Omaha is on pace to hit 247 home runs in the 130-game season, which would break the franchise record of 231 set in 1999 (141 games). The 1999 Omaha Golden Spikes' 231 home runs in a season was a modern Pacific Coast League record until 2019, when El Paso hit 258 home runs in 140 games. If the 2021 season included all 142 initially-scheduled games, Omaha would be on pace for 270 homers. The Sacramento Solons hit 305 home runs in 1974 while playing home games in a converted football stadium with a left-field fence located 233 feet from home plate. Omaha's 97 homers are also more than 14 teams in Major League Baseball. The Chasers have at least one home run in 43 of 51 games this season, notching a 30-13 record when hitting at least one home run. Omaha has recorded 23 multi-homer games, including three four-homer games, five five-homer games, and one seven-homer game.

RED, WHITE, AND BUBBA: **OF Bubba Starling** was named to Team USA's roster on Friday for the upcoming Olympic Games in Tokyo, Japan. Starling is one of 24 players selected to compete for Team USA—12 position players and 12 pitchers—and is one of two players on the roster to have played for Omaha. **OF Jack Lopez**, who currently plays for Worcester (BOS), was also named to the Olympic Team roster. The squad will begin pre-Olympic workouts on Thursday, July 16 at the USA Baseball National Training Complex in Cary, N.C., before traveling to Japan for their first game on Friday, July 30, against Israel. Starling is batting .258 (23-for-89) in 25 games with Omaha this season, tallying six doubles, one triple, and seven home runs.

FOR OMAHA: **RHP Jackson Kowar** makes his eighth start for Omaha and his second since being optioned from Kansas City on 6/23 following his first three Major League appearances. Last time out, Kowar allowed a season-high three runs on six hits (tying a season high in hits allowed) in a season-low 3.2 innings. It was the first Triple-A start for Kowar where he failed to complete 5.0 innings and allow one or fewer runs. Saturday marks Kowar's third start against St. Paul, which he started against twice the opening week of the season. Kowar struck out nine in 5.1 shutout innings in his Triple-A debut on Opening Day on 5/4 and then struck out five in 5.0 innings of one-run ball on 5/9 in the series finale. The right-hander earned Triple-A East Pitcher of the Month honors in May, posting a 1.01 ERA with 36 strikeouts and nine walks in 26.2 innings. At the time of his promotion on 6/7, Kowar led the league in ERA (0.85) and was tied for the league lead in strikeouts (41). In three games (two starts) with Kansas City, Kowar allowed 10 runs on 11 hits in 5.0 innings (18.00 ERA), walking five and striking out two. He allowed four runs on three hits in 0.2 innings in his MLB debut on 6/7 @ LAA.

FOR ST. PAUL: **LHP Charlie Barnes** makes his 10th start of the season with St. Paul and his fourth against Omaha. In his last outing, Barnes allowed seven runs (six earned) on seven hits in 5.0 innings on 6/25 @ COL. In three starts against the Chasers this season, Barnes has allowed 12 runs (10 earned) on 17 hits—including four home runs—in 14.0 innings with 13 strikeouts and two walks. Barnes pitched twice against the Chasers in the series in early June, holding Omaha to one run in 6.0 innings in the series opener before allowing a season-high eight runs (six earned) and four home runs in 3.0 inning in the series finale.

DOPPER RADAR: **INF Alcides Escobar** was traded to Washington on Saturday in exchange for cash considerations... **INF Kelvin Gutierrez**, who started the season with Omaha, was traded to Baltimore on Saturday for cash considerations after being designated for assignment on June 28... **UTL Travis Jones** was transferred from Double-A Northwest Arkansas on Saturday and will make his Triple-A debut.
