### TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Oklahoma City Baseball Club continue their six-game series tonight at Dell Diamond with game three. RHP Owen White is scheduled to take the mound for the E-Train while Oklahoma City RHP Eduardo Salazar gets the start for the Baseball Club. First pitch is scheduled for 7:05 p.m.

### **GAME 1 DRAMA**

Round Rock took both games from Oklahoma City during Wednesday's straight doubleheader. They earned a 7-6 victory in game one and a 6-1 victory in game two. C Sam Huff began the scoring in the first frame for Round Rock, lining a double to left field and scoring CF Elier Hernandez and LF Trevor Hauver to make it 2-0. Oklahoma City answered back in the top of the fourth when 1B Kevin Padlo drilled a single down the right field line which scored LF Miguel Vargas. The Baseball Club took a 4-2 lead in the top of the fifth after DH Ryan Ward doubled home two runs, followed by a Padlo sacrifice fly. Huff added a three-run homer on a line drive to right center field in the bottom of the fifth to give Round Rock the lead back at 5-4. The top of the sixth saw CF Andy Pages hit a two-run home run to take the lead back at 6-5 for Oklahoma City. Round Rock took the lead right back in the bottom of the frame with a two-run home run of its own by Hernandez to make it a 7-6 game heading into the final inning. RHP Jesus Tinoco entered and got the final four outs of the game to secure the win.

### DOUBLEHEADER, DOUBLE WINS

After the first five innings of Game 2 were scoreless, Oklahoma City took a 1-O advantage in the top of the sixth thanks to an RBI double by 2B Jonathan Arauz which plated LF Miguel Vargas. The bottom of the frame saw Round Rock explode for six runs. RF Elier Hernandez drove in DH Matt Whatley on a double off the right field wall to tie the game at one. C Andrew Knapp gave the E-Train the lead after his two-RBI single made it 3-1. CF Derek Hill brought home 1B Blaine Crim on an RBI single to make it 4-1. SS Jax Biggers increased the advantage to 6-1 as he drove in Knapp and Hill on an RBI triple. LHP Chasen Shreve closed out the game and the E-Train earned a 6-1 victory in game two.

### **PAINT THE TOWN WHITE**

RHP Owen White is slated to get the start for Round Rock against Oklahoma City. White is preparing for his third start this season and has posted an 8.64 ERA (8 ER/8.1 IP) with four walks and seven strikeouts through his first two starts.

### NO STOPPING THIS TRAIN

After Wednesday, Round Rock is now 35-17 in doubleheaders, including a whopping 23-3 in game ones, since the start of the 2015 season.

### SOME SERIOUS SPEED

Coming off a game in which he hit an inside-thepark home run on Sunday, Express OF Dustin Harris continued to flash his speed, stealing two bases in the front-end of the doubleheader. Harris is coming off a season in which he swiped 41 bags and now has 98 stolen bases in 389 career games.

### CALL SAM HUFF, 877-RUNS-NOW

Round Rock C Sam Huff put on quite the performance in Game 1. He went 2-for-2 with a double and a home run to pair with five RBI. Huff now has 10 RBI in eight games to begin the 2024 campaign. This brings the 26-year-old backstop's career RBI total to 358 in 522 minor league games and 75 Major League games.

### ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. ### **EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS**

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win

campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
