- Dunedin went 0-7 with runners in scoring position and left the tying run on third base in the ninth inning in a 3-2 defeat to Lakeland on Thursday afternoon.

- Blue Jays starter Juaron Watts-Brown was strong through four innings, surrendering only an RBI fielders choice off the bat of Max Clark in the third.

- The game was defined by a two-out rally in the bottom of the fifth, after Watts-Brown had retired the first two batters of the inning. Five straight Flying Tigers reached, highlighted by RBI knocks from Kevin McGonigle and Samuel Gil.

- Arjun Nimmala marked his return to the Jays with a solo homer in the eighth that got Dunedin on the board. Later in the inning, Edward Duran drove in Victor Arias on a sac fly to make it 3-2.

- In the ninth, Robert Robertis struck a leadoff walk, stole second, but was left on third to end the contest.

### OPPORTUNITY KNOCKS...

In the last two losses to Lakeland, Dunedin has gone 1-10 with runners in scoring position. Of Dunedin's eight hits in the last two games, five have gone for extra bases.

### MR. ROGERS' TURNAROUND

Across his last two outings, Grant Rogers has delivered 9.1 scoreless innings, allowing just four hits in that span. The strong stretch snapped a string of four consecutive starts in which Rogers allowed 3 earned runs or more.

### NICE TO SEE YOU, NIMMALA

In his first game with Dunedin in over a month, Arjun Nimmala lifted a solo home run yesterday - his fourth of the season in Single-A. Nimmala was placed on Dunedin's development list on May 14, and then was assigned to the FCL Blue Jays on June 3. In 8 FCL contests, Nimmala went 5-21 with a home run. Nimmala was the Blue Jays first round draft pick last season, and is the organization's third-ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

### JAMMIN' BATS IN JUNE

Dunedin's pitching staff is in the midst of its best month of the season, pitching to a 3.26 ERA in 22 games in June, the fourth best mark in the FSL. Lakeland's 2.86 mark is tops in the circuit. In May, the Blue Jays turned in a 4.70 ERA - the second-worst in the league.

### ALLERGIC TO BLOWOUTS

Thursday's 3-2 loss marked Dunedin's 26th one-run game this season - the second-most in the FSL, behind Bradenton's 27. The Jays are 12-14 in those contests. 50 of the Blue Jays 71 games this season (70%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 25-25 record in those games. Nine of the team's last 10 have been decided by three or fewer.

### VAMOS, VICTOR

Outfielder Victor Arias' .288 average and .857 OPS lead the Blue Jays in June. The hot month comes after a cool May in which Arias batted just .211. On June 14, Arias went 4-5 with 2 home runs and 8 RBIs - the most runs driven in by a D-Jay in a single game since 2021. Arias' .796 OPS is 6th in the FSL among qualified hitters.

### ROAD COOKING

Dunedin's pitching staff has proved to be more effective on the road than at home. At TD Ballpark, the Jays have posted a 4.30 ERA in 343 innings. On the road, the staff's ERA stands at 3.49 in 291.1 innings - the second best road ERA in the FSL.

### SERIES SUCCESS

Last week's series victory marks six straight sets with a split or better for the D-Jays. Across the last six series, Dunedin has earned three splits and three series wins.

### HOPE SPRINGS ETERNAL IN THE SUMMER

Dunedin has opened the second half 2-3. The D-Jays' 34-32 mark in the first half was the team's best first half record since 2019 (41-24). Last season, Dunedin finished in last place in the FSL West in the second half with a 30-36 record. In 2022, Dunedin won the second-half title with a 38-25 record after going 28-38 in the first half.
