YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Curve, 6-2. Altoona moved ahead, 1-0, in the fourth inning with an RBI double by Lolo Sanchez. Richmond tied the game, 1-1, in the fourth with an RBI single by Carter Williams. Later in the inning, the Flying Squirrels took a 2-1 lead with an RBI double by Ismael Munguia. The Curve tied the game, 2-2, in the fifth with a run-scoring groundout by Domingo Leyba. Riley Mahan gave the Flying Squirrels a 5-2 lead with a three-run homer in the fifth and Luis Matos added an RBI infield single in the eighth to pull ahead, 6-2. Evan Gates worked the final four outs for his third save.

TŪDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. Today marks the second of 18 games between the Flying Squirrels and Curve this season. Altoona will return to The Diamond for a six-game series from June 6-11. The Flying Squirrels will head to Peoples Natural Gas Field in Altoona for a six-game series from August 1-6. The Flying Squirrels are 11-7 this year against opponents from the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels are 8-5 in games following a win.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won nine-of-the-last-12 games and are in first place in the division, 3.5 games ahead of Altoona. After starting the season 4-0 for the first time in team history. The Flying Squirrels offense ranks first in the Eastern League in batting average (.253), runs (118), RBIs (104), OBP (.349) and OPS (.743) while ranking second in hits (171) and SLG (.394). The Richmond pitching staff leads the league in strikeouts (222) and ranks second in ERA (3.17).

THE CURVE are in second place in the division, 3.5 games behind the Flying Squirrels. Altoona has won seven-of-its-last-11 games and three-of-its-last-five. Last week, they won three-of-five at Reading. Sunday's finale was canceled. The Curve roster includes five of Baseball America's Top-30 Pirates Prospects: C Henry Davis (No. 3), INF Liover Peguera (No. 7), RHP Jared Jones (No. 11), OF Matt Gorski (No. 16 + best power hitter + best outfield arm) and INF Andres Alvarez (No. 30). Nick Dombkowski is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Pirates organization and Lolo Sanchez is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. The Altoona roster also includes five of MLB.com's Top-30 Pirates Prospects, including Davis (No. 3), Peguero (No. 6), Gorski (No. 17), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 20) and Frazier (No. 23).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Nick Zwack makes his fifth Double-A start. Last time out, he pitched three innings and allowed one run with four strikeouts at Bowie last Wednesday. He was selected in the 17th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Mets out of Xavier and traded to the Giants last August as part of the deal for Darin Ruf. After starting the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, Zwack earned a promotion to High-A Brooklyn, where he went 5-1 with a 1.84 ERA in 14 outings, landing him a South Atlantic League Post-Season All-Star selection. He closed the season with six starts for High-A Eugene following the trade. Zwack, a native of Minneapolis, played his college career at Xavier, where he was a First-Team All-Big East selection in 2021 as a senior. For more on Zwack, see page two.

FUR ALTUDNA: Right-hander Justin Meis makes his fifth start of the season. He last started last Wednesday at Reading and surrendered three runs over 4.2 innings in a no-decision. He has allowed four runs in two-of-his-four starts in 2023. Meis was selected in the 10th round by the Pirates in the 2021 MLB Draft out of Eastern Michigan. He split last year between Low-A Bradenton and High-A Greensboro, going 7-8 with a 4.11 ERA in 26 games (23 starts). This year is his first at Double-A.

STARTING STRONG: The Flying Squirrels lead the Southwest Division with an 14-7 record this year, the best start in team history through 21 games, surpassing the previous mark of 13-8 set in 2018 and 2022. The team's best start through 22 games was 14-8 in 2018 and 2022. This year, Richmond went 4-0 to start the season, the longest unbeaten streak to start a year in franchise

RISPY BUSINESS: For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .312 (62-for-199) with runners in scoring position, which leads the Eastern League. Richmond also has the best batting average in the league with runners in scoring position and two outs at .308 (28-for-91). With runners on base, the Flying Squirrels are leading the EL with a .311 average (100-for-322). The Flying Squirrels have scored four-or-more runs in a single inning 10 times this year.

LUCY, I'M HOME: Shortstop **Marco Luciano** was activated with the Flying Squirrels on Tuesday and is slated to make his official Double-A debut on Wednesday night. He joined the Richmond roster for last year's Eastern League playoffs, going 1-for-8 at the plate in the Division Series against Erie in September. Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 1 prospect and the No. 30 prospect in baseball. MLB.com has him rated as the Giants' No. 2 prospect and No. 20 overall. Baseball America also rates Luciano as the Giants' top power-hitting prospect.

MAHAN MAYHEM: Riley Mahan blasted his fourth homer of the season on Tuesday night at The Diamond, a 419-foot, go-ahead shot to right. He has now homered three times in his last two home games, including two homers on April 23 against the Sea-Wolves. In his last 11 games since April 15, Mahan is batting .311 (14-for-45) with four homers, five doubles and 14 RBIs.

HITZ-GERALD: Tyler Fitzgerald hit his second homer of the season on Saturday night in Game 2 of the doubleheader. In last week's series, Fitzgerald hit .421 (8-for-19) with a homer, a triple, four doubles, two walks and two RBIs. He was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on Tuesday. At the time of his promotion, Fitzgerald ranked third in the Eastern League in batting average (.324), sixth in OBP (.410), third in SLG (.588), fourth in OPS (.998), tied for fourth in hits (22), tied for fifth in doubles (6), first in triples (3), second in extra-base hits (11), third in total bases (40) and tied for third in runs scored (15).

FULL MUNGUIA: After going 0-for-15 over a three-game stretch from April 23-26, Ismael Munguia is batting .467 (7-for-15) with a homer, two doubles and five RBIs over his last three games. He led off last Thursday's game with a homer on the third pitch of the game, his second Double-A home run. In the second game of Saturday's doubleheader, he tied his season high with three RBIs, picking up a pair of RBI singles and a sac fly. Munguia is tied for fifth in the league in hits (22) and second in runs second (16).

MATIS MANIA: Luis Matos reached base in each of his first 17 Double-A games, the longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season, until going 0-for-3 in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader. During the streak, Matos reached base 28 total times with 16 hits and 12 walks. He hit a homer in his Double-A debut in Game 1 of the Flying Squirrels' season-opening doubleheader on April 8 against Reading. For the year, Matos has struck out just nine times in 87 plate appearances (10.3 percent), the third-lowest rate in the league.

TAKE A WALK: Andy Thomas is tied for fourth in Eastern League with 17 walks. He is fifth in the Eastern League with a 23.0-percent walk rate. Last season, Thomas led the Northwest League in on-base percentage (.373) and ranked third in walks (58). He has worked at least one walk in nine-of-his-16 games played so far this season. In last week's series at Bowie, he hit .375 (6-for-16) with a homer, a double, five walks and four RBIs.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Patrick Bailey is ranked second in batting average (.333), ninth in OBP (.400) and eighth in OPS (.881). Tyler Fitzgerald is third in batting average (.324), sixth in OBP (.410), third in SLG (.588), fourth in OPS (.998), tied for fourth in hits (.22), tied for fifth in doubles (.6), first in triples (.3), second in extra-base hits (.11), third in total bases (.40) and tied for third in runs scored (.15). Ismael Munguia tied for fifth in hits (.22) and second in runs scored (.16). Luis Matos is tied for seventh in hits (.21) and tied for fifth in runs scored (.14). Riley Mahan is tied for fourth in homers (.4), tied for fourth in RBIs (.14), fifth in SLG (.554) and tied for eighth in extra-base hits (.9). Andy Thomas is tied for fourth in walks (.17). Juan Sanchez is tied for second in wins (.4). Kai-Wei Teng is first in strikeouts (.30). Evan Gates is tied for sixth in saves (.3).

WHERE THE CURVE RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Domingo Leyba is third in batting average (.326), sixth in OBP (.411), ninth in OPS (.880) and tied for seventh in hits (.21). Henry Davis is tied for first in homers (6), third in RBIs (15), fourth in OBP (.449), first in SLG (.633), first in OPS (1.082), 10th in walks (15) and sixth in total bases (.38). Mason Martin is second in OBP (.452), eighth in SLG (.523), fifth in OPS (.975) and tied for eighth in walks (16). Liover Peguero is tied for fourth in stolen bases (.9).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Luis Matos (No. 5), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Nick Swiney (No. 24) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter and Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).


THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY


