LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox took down the Richmond Flying Squirrels by a 4-3 final on Wednesday night. Bowie was forced to dig itself out of an early 3-0 hole, after right-handed starter Connor Gillispie allowed a two-run home run to Richmond's Shane Matheny in the first, followed by a sacrifice fly RBI from Carter Aldrete in the third. Baysox catcher Silas Ardoin was the hero of the night at the plate, driving in two, including an RBI single in the top of the fourth. A Cedric Mullins RBI grondout and Jackson Holliday RBI fielder's choice in the fifth helped push two more runs across to tie the game, before Ardoin laced a go-ahead RBI double in the eighth to plate Jud Fabian and give Bowie the lead. Despite walking four batters, right-hander Houston Roth was able to work two scoreless innings and pick up the save, while fellow right-hander Keagan Gillies also tossed two scoreless frames to pick up his first Double-A save.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter tonight with a record of 53-51 on the season. Their 20-15 mark in the second half has them leading the Southwest division standings and sitting two games above Bowie. The Baysox are 9-11 against the Flying Squirrels this season, securing a series split in Richmond back in early July. Richmond's 3.81 staff ERA on the campaign is second-best in the Eastern League,. However, their starters own the sixth ERA in the league (4.19) with the fewest innings (380.1). The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants, The Flying Squirrels active roster includes five of the Ĝiants' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pípeline, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 5 SF), RHP Carson Śeymou'r (No. 14 SF), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 23 SF), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 25 SF), RHP Jose Cruz (No. 26 SF).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-hander John Michael Bertrand is tonight's projected starter for the Flying Squirrels. Bertrand is set to make his fifth start at the Double-A level tonight. Opponents have hit .269 against him ,but he has not allowed a home run in his 18 innings. Bertrand is coming off his best start at the level thus far, as he fired five shutout innings this past Thursday in Altoona, allowing just two hits and two walks while striking out four. Bertrand has pitched through three different levels of the Giants' system in 2023, seeing his longest stint in High-A Eugene, where he had his most success pitching to a 2.92 ERA through 49.1 innings while holding opponents to a .196 average. A 10th round pick of the Giants in 2022 out of Notre Dame, Bertrand features a fastball, changeup, slider, and curveball.

COMEBACK KIDS

Recently, the Baysox have made it a habit of coming from behind in games. Bowie has conceded the first run in 15 of its last 17 games. However, in that stretch the Baysox have gone 8-9 overall. This season, Bowie is 17-34 in total when allowing the first run. Nine of the last 11 Baysox victories have come after failing to score first.

STARTING STRONG

This season, Baysox pitching has mainly been powered by the starting staff. Overall, Bowie's 4.43 staff ERA is third worst in the Eastern League. However, Baysox starters have pitched to a 4.03 ERA in 2023 - second-best in the Eastern League and third-best in Double-A, while the 4.93 ERA posted by relievers is the highest mark in the league.

LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook has continued his surge in the Eastern League throughout the summer months, as his .293 average since June 1 is fourth-highest in the league amongst players with at least 200 plate appearances. Cook has also brought the pop, with his 24 extra-base hits in that span sitting at third-most in the league. Cook currently leads active Baysox players in home runs (17), RBI (62 - third-most in the Eastern League), on-base percentage (.322), slugging (.473), OPS (.795), and stolen bases (23).

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers joins Bowie from High-A Aberdeen after one of the best performances across Minor League Baseball in the month of July. The No. 10 prospect in the O's system, per MLB Pipeline, hit .397 last month - second-highest in Minor League Baseball among players with at least 60 plate appearances, while his 1.185 OPS was fourth-best and led the Orioles' minor league system. Beavers also led the Baltimore farm with his .494 on-base percentage in the month of July. He's opened his time in Double-A with hits in five of six games, including three multi-hit contests, and a 9-for-24 (.375) start overall.

ONE RUN REBOUND

The Baysox have still turned a corner in one-run games this season. After Saturday night's win, the Baysox are 12-2 in their last 14 one-run games. Dating back to June 2, the Baysox have faired incredibly well in one-run games, going 16-5. Bowie is 22-14 overall in games decided by one run in 2023 - the third-most one-run victories in Minor League Baseball, while playing in the third-most one-run games. Last season, the Baysox were just 21-29 in suh games, giving them the most one-run losses in Minor League Baseball in 2022, along with the second-lowest winning percentage in the Eastern League in such games. Eight of the last 12 Baysox wins this season have been by a single run.



The only base runner reached on a dropped third strike, wild pitch, and was later caught stealing by C Pedro Severino; according to the Elias Sports Bureau, Means was the first pitcher to throw a non-perfect no-hitter in which the opposing team did not record a walk, hit-by-pitch, or error...Became the second pitcher in AL history to throw a no-hitter with 12+ strikeouts and zero walks, joining Félix Hernández, who had a perfect game on 8/15/12...Threw 26-of-27 first-pitch strikes (96.3%), only missing on the 18th batter of the game with two outs in the sixth inning; the highest first-pitch strike percentage in a complete game since 1990...Became the only pitcher since 2000 to face at least 25 batters in a game and have a higher first-pitch strike percentage was MIN's Brad Radke on 6/30/04 (27-of-28, 96.4%)...Recorded 26 swinging strikes (14 via the changeup, 8 via the four-seam fastball, 3 via the slider, and 1 via the curveball), the most in a game by an Orioles pitcher since pitch tracking began in 2008...Became the first pitcher since Edinson Vólquez on 6/3/17 to face the minimum in a no-hitter and have it not be a perfect game; the last to do so with no walks or hit batters was Terry Mulholland on 8/15/1990...Named the American League Player of the Week on 5/10, the first Orioles winner since Trey Mancini on 9/23/19, and the first Orioles pitcher to accomplish the feat since Arthur Rhodes in August of 1994...Made his first career Opening Day start on 4/2 at Boston, becoming the 41st Opening Day starter in Orioles history... Became the first pitcher in Orioles history to work at least 7.0 innings while giving up one hit-or-less and not allowing a run in a start at Fenway Park...Became the 17th pitcher in Major League history, and first Oriole, to go at least 7.0 innings while allowing one hit-or-less in a start on Opening Day; he is the third pitcher in Major League history to do so without issuing a walk, joining Irv Young (1906) and Jordan Zimmermann (2019)...Joined Mike Mussina (5/30/97) and Jim Palmer (5/12/67) as one of three Orioles to throw at least 7.0 innings, allowing one hit-or-less, no runs, and no walks in a start...Tallied a career-high 12 quality starts, surpassing the 11 he made in 2019...According to Baseball Reference, his 1.6 WPA led the O's, 1.0 higher than the next closest pitcher on the club...Registered a career-long 19.0 scoreless innings streak from 5/5-19...Became the 12th pitcher in Orioles history to strike out at least 200 batters in the first 48 games of their career when he struck out Mark Canha on a foul tip in the fifth frame on 4/30 at OAK...Gave up a career-high 30 home runs, surpassing his total of 23 allowed in 2019; homers accounted for 45 of his 64 total runs allowed (70.3%)...Tallied the first extra-base hit of his career (2B) on 9/20 at PHI...It registered an exit velocity of 102.7 mph, tied for the second-hardest-hit ball by an O's pitcher in the Statcast era (since 2015) with Mike Wright, Jr. (1B) on 5/23/15, behind only a Yovani Gallardo 106.5 mph single on 6/29/16; first extra-base hit by an Orioles pitcher since Zack Britton (HR) on 7/3/11...Spent time on the 10-day Injured List with a left shoulder strain from 6/6-7/20 after being removed from his start on 6/5 vs. CLE in the first inning.

2020: Struck out seven straight Rays batters on 9/20 vs. TB (two in the first inning, three in the second inning, two in the third inning) to match the Orioles dub record for consecutive strikeouts set by Sammy Stewart in 1978...Struck out a career-high 12 batters on 9/20 vs. TB, the only Baltimore pitcher to record double-digit strikeouts in a game in 2020...Led Orioles pitchers in strikeouts (42), tied with RHP Alex Cobb for the most starts (10), and finished second with 43.2 IP...Surrendered at least one home run in nine of his 10 starts...Started the season on the 10-day Injured List (left shoulder fatigue) and was activated prior to his start on 7/30 vs. NYY...Over his final four starts, he went 2-1 with a 1.55 ERA (4 ER/23.2 IP) with three walks and 30 strikeouts...

According to STATS, LLC., he was the fifth rookie in Orioles history (since 1954), and first since 1966 to be named to the All-Star team, joining RHP Chuck Estrada (1960), 1B Jim Gentile (1960), INF Ron Hansen (1960), and C Andy Etchebarren (1966)...

Became the first homegrown Orioles starter to make the All-Star team since Hall of Famer RHP Mike Mussina, who made five All-Star appearances with the O's (1992-94, 97, 99)...His 2.50 first-half ERA (23 ER/82.2 IP) was the best amongst Orioles rookies since 1954 (min. 80.0 IP)...Led all Orioles pitchers in wins (12), ERA (3.60), Quality Starts (11), and WHIP (1.14)...According since 1994 (min. 2001 Pr)...Led all orloses pitchers in wins (12), ERA (3.50), Quality Starts (11), and WHIP (1.1)...According to Baseball Reference, he led the O's and all AL rookies with a 4.5 WAR...Led all rooke pitchers (min. 155.0 IP) in opponent batting average (2.34), and ranked in the top 10 among rookie pitchers in: opponent OPS (2°d - .702), WHIP (2°d - 1.14), K/BB, (2°d - 3.18), ERA (3°d - 3.60), K/9 (3°d - 7.03), winning percentage (3°d - .522), wins (4°d - 12), opponent SLG (4°d - .411), H/P3 (4°d - 13), H/P3 (4°d 4/9 vs. OAK (3.0 IP, 4 H, 5 R, ER, HR, BB, K-L)...Recorded his 100th strikeout of the season on 9/5 vs. TEX when he struck out Nick Solak, becoming the sixth left-handed rookie pitcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to reach the 100-strikeout plateau (last: 2012 – Wei-Yin Chen)...His 121 strikeouts were tied with Erik Bedard for the seventh-most by a rookie pitcher in Orioles history.
