**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Fisher Cats, 6-1. Sebastian Espino gave the Fisher Cats a 1-0 lead with a solo homer in the second and scored on a double steal in the fourth to open a 2-0 lead. The Fisher Cats scored four runs in the fifth on back-to-back homers by Cam Eden and Ryan Gold. The Flying Squirrels broke the shutout in the ninth with a sac fly by **Carter Aldrete**.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. This series is the only set of games between the two teams this year. Prior to this series, the Flying Squirrels and Fisher Cats had not played each other since 2019. This series marks the first set for the Flying Squirrels on the road against an opponent from the Northeast Division this season.

**WE ARE HEADED NORTH:** The Flying Squirrels are in the first leg of a 12-game road trip to New England, their first visit to the league's two northernmost cities since the 2019 season. The two series against New Hampshire and Portland are the Flying Squirrels' only two sets this year on the road against Eastern League Northeast Division Richmond does not visit Binghamton, Hartford, Somerset or Reading this season, although all four of those teams have played or will play in Richmond. New Hampshire is the only Eastern League team that does not visit The Diamond this season.

**TICKET PUNCHED:** The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 10-20 to open the second half. They have lost 12-of-the-last-16 games, including a season-high six-game losing streak from July 14-23. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost seven and split three this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 1,100 strikeouts (11.1 per game) and rank fourth with 125 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 23-26 on the road this year. Richmond is 23-19 in games decided by two-or-less runs. They are 11-16 overall against teams from the Northeast Division, including a 2-2 record in road games.

**THE FISHER CATS** have gone 7-4 since July 23, including winning four-of-six in last week's series at Binghamton. New Hampshire's roster includes eight of MLB.com's top-30 prospects (four active), including INF Orelvis Martinez (No. 2), LHP Ricky Tiedemann (No. 3), RHP Adam Kloffenstein (No. 12), RHP Hagen Danner (No. 17 - on IL), RHP Yosver Zulueta (No. 19), RHP Trent Palmer (No. 23 - on IL), RHP Joey Murray (No. 24 - out for season) and OF Sebastian Espino (No. 25).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his league-leading 21st start of the season. He last pitched last Saturday against the Patriots at The Diamond and worked around five walks with six strikeouts in three scoreless innings. In his last three starts since July 17, Teng has gone 0-1 with a 12.38 ERA (11 ER/8.0 IP). Over his previous five starts from June 18-July 12, Teng went 3-1 with a 2.93 ERA (10 ER/30.2 IP). He is leading the Eastern League in games started (20), ranks sixth in strikeouts (103) and sixth in innings pitched (94.0). Teng spent the entire 2021 season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, going 5-6 with a 4.33 ERA in 21 starts. For the season, Teng led the High-A West with 142 strikeouts, ranked tied for second with 21 games started, tied for first with one complete game and sixth with 95.2 innings pitched. He also ranked fourth in the Giants system in strikeouts. Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins out of Taiwan in 2017. During his second season in 2018, he was traded to the Giants along with outfielder Jaylin Davis in exchange for right-handed pitcher Sam Dyson. **For more on Teng, see page two.**

**FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE:** Right-hander Andrew Moore makes his second Double-A start and fourth Double-A appearance. Last time out, he worked four innings and allowed three runs in a no-decision at Binghamton on Sunday. Moore was signed by the Blue Jays as a free agent on June 14 and began his season with Triple-A Buffalo, where he went 0-1 with a 7.71 ERA in four outings. Moore pitched one game for the Flying Squirrels in 2019, his only outing as a member of the Giants organization. In that start on May 8, 2019, he allowed five runs in 1.2 innings in a loss to Trenton at The Diamond. He was claimed off waivers by the Mariners nine days later and was called to the majors for one start that June. Moore was originally drafted by Seattle with the 72nd-overall pick in 2015 out of Oregon State.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (296,258) and average attendance (6,172). Richmond is 14th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

**POWER SURGE:** The Richmond offense has hit 125 home runs this season, which is fourth in the Eastern League. **Sean Roby** is tied for second in the league with 23 homers on the season, with 19 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 173 home runs. The Flying Squirrels have already hit more homers than entire seasons in every season except 2021, including 2010 (71), 2011 (83), 2012 (76), 2013 (109), 2014 (74) and 2015 (61), 2016 (83), 2017 (93) and 2019 (84).

**BACH TO FORM:** On Tuesday, **Brett Auerbach** went 4-for-4 with a solo homer, his 12th of the season. It was the second four-hit game of his career, tying a career high. He added a two-run homer in Wednesday's win. Auerbach has picked up at least one hit in seven-of-his-last-11 games since July 23. He also homered in three straight games from Saturday through Thursday.

**ALRIGHTY, ALDRETE:** On Tuesday night, **Carter Aldrete** hit a grand slam for his first Double-A homer. It was Aldrete's third grand slam of the season. He hit his first of the year with High-A Eugene on June 15 at Vancouver. He hit another grand slam on June 29 for the Emeralds against Everett and also hit a three-run homer in the same game, picking up a career-high seven RBIs. He has hit four grand slams in his professional career. His first came on July 15, 2021 for Eugene at Spokane. On Friday night, he brought in Richmond's only run with a ninth-inning sacrifice fly.

**GO, DIEGO, GO!:** After hitting .173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, **Diego Rincones** is batting .308 (45-for-146) with six doubles, seven homers and 28 RBIs over his last 39 games since June 7. Rincones snapped an 0-for-26 slide with a ninth-inning single on Friday night.

**ROBUST:** **Sean Roby** hit his 21st homer of the year on July 4 against the Fightin Phils, moving him ahead of **David Villar** for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He added his 22nd homer on July 7 and his 23rd on July 9. Roby is tied for second in the EL in home runs this year behind New Hampshire's Orelvis Martinez (24). He has hit 19 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvall** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

**FITZ ON FIRE:** **Tyler Fitzgerald** homered five times, all solo shots, over a six-game span from July 10-17 heading into the mid-season break. In that stretch, he hit .421 (8-for-19). He went deep in the series finale against Reading on July 10. He added a solo homer on July 14 in Altoona, hit two solo homers on July 15 and hit another on July 17 in the series finale. In his first four games out of the mid-season break from July 22-27, he went 0-for-14, but he has picked up 10 hits in his last seven games, including a three-run homer on Saturday night, a two-run homer in the series opener at New Hampshire on Tuesday night and three hits on Thursday night.

**DEADLINE DEAL:** On Tuesday, the Giants traded Trevor Rosenthal to the Brewers for outfielder **Tristan Peters**, who had been promoted to Double-A that day. The Giants assigned him to Richmond after the trade. Peters is rated by MLB.com as the Giants' No. 25 prospect. Peters made his Double-A debut on Friday night and picked up a single for his first hit.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Frankie Tostado** is ranked fifth in batting average (.284). **Sean Roby** is tied for second in homers (23). **Shane Matheny** is sixth in OBP (.391) and 10th in OPS (.834). **Mike Gigliotti** is 10th in OBP (.374), tied for eighth in walks (48) and tied for fourth in stolen bases (23). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for 10th in homers (17).

**WHERE THE FISHER CATS RANK:** In the Eastern League, Spencer Horwitz is third in batting average (.297), first in OBP (.413), fifth in SLG (.517) and third in OPS (.930). Orelvis Martinez is ranked first in homers (24), sixth in RBIs (60), tied for seventh in extra-base hits (37) and 10th in total bases (154). Rafael Lantigua is tied for ninth in hits (88) and second in doubles (27). Andrew Bash is tied for first in wins (8).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have five players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Ryan Murphy** (11), **Cole Waites** (19), **Ricardo Genovés** (27) and **Chris Wright** (30). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. Waites is listed as having the "Best Fastball." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (11), **Tristan Peters** (25) and Genovés (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 20 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 23 overall prospect.
