TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue their series at The Diamond in Lake Elsinore, taking on the Lake Elsinore Storm (SD) in game five of the six-game set. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, June 4.

VS THE STORM: This is the 14th of 30 match-ups and the eighth of 15 here at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 6-7 against the Storm in 2024, 1-6 here at The Diamond. Last season, the Quakes won the season-series (17-13).

LAST GAME: The Quakes and Storm went back-and-forth on Friday night at The Diamond, with Rancho eventually succumbing to the Storm in 11 innings, 8-7, their fourth straight loss. The Quakes led 3-0, but watched the Storm rally for the next four runs to take a 4-3 lead. Trailing in the ninth, Samuel Munoz tripled home Josue De Paula, tying the game at 4-4. Rancho took a 7-4 lead in the tenth, only to see the Storm come back and tie the game in the bottom of the tenth. The Quakes loaded the bases with no outs against eventual winner Keegan Collett (1-1) and couldn't score. In the last of the 11th, Noah Ruen (0-1) retired the first batter he faced, but gave up a one-out, walk-off single to Nick Vogt, who drove in Alain Camou, who opened the inning at second base. Kendall George, De Paula, Jordan Thompson and Munoz all had two hits each to lead Rancho's 11-hit attack. Their fourth straight loss overall drops Rancho to 0-4 in extras this year, three of which have come in this series.

APRIL 12: On April 12, the Quakes started the day in second place in the South Division. With a win that night over Stockton, the Quakes moved into first and remained there until last night's game went final. With just 17 games to play in the first half, the Quakes now trail Lake Elsinore by one game, thanks to four straight losses in this series and 11 losses in their last 12 games overall. Lake Elsinore had dropped five of six at home prior to this series, but last night's win gives them four straight overall and first place by themselves for the first time since early-April. For the Quakes, their last 17 games of the first half will be at Lake Elsinore (2), home against Visalia (6), on the road at Fresno (6), then finishing at home with Inland Empire (3).

LACK OF LONG-BALLS: The Jeral Perez two-out homer in Wednesday night's ninth inning was the first home run for the Quakes since Jordan Thompson went yard in a home game against Inland Empire on May 19, ten days and eight games ago. Josue De Paula went yard Thursday night, giving them two straight games with a round-tripper. That streak ended last night. Rancho is second the league in home runs (30), behind only Modesto (39). Lake Elsinore, by contrast, is the least prolific home run-hitting team, with 20 in 47 games, one less than Visalia (21).

BOBBY MILLER: Dodgers' right-hander Bobby Miller makes his second career appearance for the Quakes tonight and his first against the Storm. Last Sunday, Miller made his one and only rehab start, allowing three runs, all in the second inning, on four hits with four strikeouts and two walks in a no-decision against Modesto. Right shoulder inflammation has sidelined Miller for the last six weeks. A first-rounder (29th overall) in 2020 out of Louisville, Miller is 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA in three starts. Dodger rehabbers are sponsored by Yaamava' Resort and Casino at San Manuel.

ISAIAH LOWE: Isaiah Lowe makes his ninth appearance and seventh start for the Storm, his third appearance and second start against Rancho. In two games against the Quakes, he's allowed three runs on three hits over six innings, going 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA. In his last game overall, he allowed five runs on seven hits over 2.2 innings in a loss to San Jose on May 25. Lowe appeared in four games in 2023, including three with the Storm, where he went 0-1 with a 1.59 ERA over 11.1 innings. He's made just four pro appearances since being drafted in the 11th round by the Padres in 2022 out of Combine Academy in Lincolnton, North Carolina.
