FROM THE DOG HOUSE

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The RiverDogs fell 19-2 to the GreenJackets last night, paced by a nine-run seventh inning. The performance marked the third time Augusta has scored 19 runs in a game since 2005 (first time since 6/24/16 at COL), and the most runs the RiverDogs have allowed since August 2 of last season in their 19-1 versus at Myrtle Beach.

SETTING THE TONE: The RiverDogs opened the series with an emphatic 9-2 win over Augusta on Tuesday night. Throughout the evening, they were led by three separate three-run innings that included homers from **Angel Mateo** and **Tom Poole**. As a club, the RiverDogs became just the fifth team at any level of professional baseball this year to notch ten-or-more hits while leaving one man or less on base. The RiverDogs have scored 20 runs over their last two games, outscoring opponents 20-4 in the process. On the mound, **Aidan Haugh** was stout, delivering 5.1 innings of one-run ball while fanning seven. In the process, he earned his team-leading sixth win of the year.

BLAKE BACK ON THE BUMP: Left-hander **Blake Morgan** will toe the rubber for Charleston ninth start of the year and fifth with the RiverDogs. Since he was promoted to Single-A on May 27, the southpaw has posted a 1.85 ERA and has fanned 32 hitters over just 24.1 innings. In the process he has limited opponents to just three walks and a .153 average. Last Friday at Wilson, he tossed six dominant innings where he fanned nine and allowed just two runs. Throughout the evening, he induced 22 swings and misses. Including his time in the Florida Complex League, he has punched out 51 hitters to just seven walks across 54.2 innings

TICKET PUNCHED: The Charleston RiverDogs clinched the Carolina League South Division First Half Title with a victory over Wilson on Tuesday night, securing a berth in the 2026 Carolina League postseason. The playoff appearance marks Charleston's first since 2024 and its fifth in the last six seasons since rejoining the Tampa Bay Rays organization in 2021. Charleston is seeking its first Carolina League title since 2023, when the club captured its third consecutive championship. The best-of-three Division Series begins on Tuesday, September 8. Thanks to their first-half division title, the RiverDogs are guaranteed to host Game 2, and, if necessary, Game 3, at The Joe on September 10 and 11.

SUMMER SURGE: Outfielder **Brendan Summerhill** has been tremendous for Charleston in the month of June. He enters the evening holding a 23-game on-base-streak, the second longest by a RiverDogs hitter this season (B. Guerrero - 27). Among players with at least 55 plate appearances this month, his .493 on base percentage is third in Single-A and 21st in Minor League Baseball. Overall, he is slashing .367/.493/.550 with nine extra-base hits, eight runs batted in, and 15 walks compared to just ten strikeouts. Of his 17 games played this month, he has recorded at least one hit in 15 of them, and multiple walks in six of them. Summerhill entered the month batting .205 with just eight walks.

HIGH LEVERAGE HEROS: Charleston has thrived in tight games this season, going 17-11 in one-run decisions and 22-13 in contests decided by two runs or less. Their 17 one-run wins are tied for the most in Minor and Major League Baseball with Richmond. Part of their success has come via their late-inning success. Additionally, they've tallied eight walk-off wins this year. In fact, eight of their 21 home victories have come in walk-off fashion (38%). They are tied with Richmond and Wilson for the most walk-off wins in all of Minor League Baseball this season. The club has also won eight games while trailing in the ninth inning or later, tied for the third most in MiLB.
