This Evening: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, open the second half with the fourth game in a 12-game, 13-day road trip at the legendairy Wisconsin Udder Tuggers, High-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. These are the only meetings between the Nuts and Wisconsin this season. The Lugnuts, who won four of six games in Appleton last season, have won the last two games after dropping the series opener.

Last Night: Lugnuts 4, Udder Tuggers 3. Lansing enjoyed a professional victory, answering Wisconsin rallies in the first and fourth innings with game-tying responses in the second and fifth innings before taking the lead for good on a Max Muncy RBI groundout. Lansing starter Jose Dicochea struggled through four innings, striking out five but allowing five hits and four walks. The relief work that followed was exceptional, with John Beller (2 IP, 1 H, 4 K) and Christian Fernandez (3 IP, 1 H, 3 K) blanking Wisconsin the rest of the way.

On the Air: Today's game is available on Bally Live and MiLB TV with Chris Mehring, and an audio-only broadcast via StreamGuys with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play Wisconsin through Sunday, take a day off on June 26, and then continue the two-week road trip with a six-game series at the Great Lakes Loons, whom they swept to open the season. The next Lugnuts home game will be on the 4th of July against the Lake County Captains.

Midwest League off day **Lansing Lugnuts at Great Lakes Loons**

Turn the Page: Today begins the second half of the Midwest League season. Each team's record resets to 0-0, with the second half determining who will meet first half champions Great Lakes and Cedar Rapids in the first round of the postseason.

Streaks: Jack Winkler, who received a scheduled off day yesterday, has hit safely in his last seven games, batting .481 (13-for-27) over that span to tie his season long hitting streak. Additionally, he has reached base in nine straight games. Outfielder Junior Perez enters tonight on a ten-game on-base streak.

Roster Movement: Infielder Alexander Campos and infielder Drew Swift have each been promoted, with Campos transferred up to Triple-A Las Vegas and Swift promoted to Double-A Midland. The transactions leave the Lugnuts with only 25 active players on the roster. 12 position players and 13 pitchers, a throwback to the roster maximum before 2021 (when the roster maximum in High-A was lifted to 30).

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts turned two more double plays yesterday, giving them 18 double plays in their last 11 games and a league-leading 62 double plays this year. The Double-A Midland RockHounds, a level above the Lugnuts on the Oakland organizational ladder, have 63 double plays in 66 games to lead the Texas League.

Born to Run: The Nuts have stolen seven bases this series to give them 95 steals for the year, tied for third most in the league. Lansing leads the MWL with 36 steals this month (swiped in 18 games).

The Cycle: Jack Winkler's cycle on Wednesday afternoon was the first for Lansing since Ryan Gold achieved the feat vs. Dayton on April 18, 2019. The other cycles in team history: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend).

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and Alexander Campos (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts Oakland's last two first-round selections. Max Muncy was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and entered the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. Daniel Susac was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect.

Big League Nuts: Five former Lansing Lugnuts have made their MLB debuts this season, bringing the total to 178 all-time. Four have debuted with Oakland: Ryan Noda, 3/30; Hogan Harris, 4/14; Mason Miller, 4/19; and Garrett Acton, 5/14. Most recently, Samad Taylor debuted for Kansas City on June 18 w/ a walk-off RBI single.

History vs. Wisconsin

The Lugnuts are 84-60 all-time vs. the Timber Rattlers, 44-25 at home and 40-35 in Appleton. After not meeting in 2021, the Nuts won four of six at Wisconsin in 2022.

That series included the Midwest League debut for Mason Miller on August 28, allowing one run (a Ben Metzinger HR) in two innings. Miller made three appearances total for the Nuts last year; this year, he made his MLB debut on April 19. Unfortunately, he was placed on the Injured List on May 8 (UCL sprain).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2016: In the opening game of the second half, future Major Leaguer Ryan Borucki struck out eight in eight innings, and the Lugnuts beat the West Michigan Whitecaps, 5-1, at Cooley Law School Stadium.

2022: Jack Winkler and Lawrence Butler each homered, with Winkler's second roundtripper bouncing out of the glove of leaping Beloit left fielder Tevin Mitchell and over the top of the wall, but the Sky Carp scored three runs in the tenth inning to beat the Nuts, 6-4, in front of 6,291 at Jackson Field. It was the final game of the 66-game first half. In the loss, Lansing outfielders Gabriel Maciel and Lazaro Armenteros suffered hamstring injuries and departed early.


Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg).

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... only two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.
