SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

PITCHING IS THE WAY: The Biloxi Shuckers enter today with a 1.97 team ERA, the third-lowest in Double-A and the fifth-lowest in Minor League Baseball... The Shuckers are one of five teams in Minor League Baseball with a team ERA under two... The Shuckers have allowed three runs or less in each of their last four games.

🏆 The staff's 1.97 ERA is a franchise-best (since 2015) through nine games and makes Biloxi the ninth Southern League team since 2005 to have a team ERA under 2.00 through nine games.

🏆 The Shuckers are the 19th Double-A team and 61st full-season team in Minor League Baseball (Single-A through Triple-A) to have a team ERA under 2.00 through nine games since 2005.

ABOUT THAT BULLPEN: During the Shuckers three-game winning streak, the bullpen has yet to allow a run over 13.0 innings... The Shuckers bullpen is one of three in Minor League Baseball with at least 10.0 innings and no runs allowed over that span... The Shuckers are joined by the Eugene Emeralds (A+, SEA) and the Nashville Sounds (AAA, MIL).

🏆 The Shuckers are the only Southern League team in 2024 to throw at least five scoreless innings in relief without allowing a run in back-to-back games.

🏆 It marks the first time a Southern League bullpen threw at least five shutout innings in back-to-back games since May 23 and May 24, 2023, when the Chattanooga Lookouts achieved the feat.

WHY DO WE LIKE HIM? HE GETS ON BASE: Of Carlos Rodriguez is tied for the longest-active on base streak in the Southern League, having reached base in eight straight games... Rodriguez reached base in all six games at Mississippi in the previous series, including a hit in five of six games... Rodriguez recorded three on base streaks of at least 17 games in 2023, including a career-high 18 games between July 30 and August 23, 2023.

NOW THAT'S WHAT I CALL A HIT: The Shuckers enter today on a three-game winning streak, outscoring the M-Braves 14-4 and tallying 30 hits over that span... Over the span, the Shuckers rank second in the Southern League in average (.280) and on-base percentage (.388).

🏆 OF Eduardo Garcia, OF Noah Campbell and INF Eric Brown Jr. are tied for the fourth-most hits in the Southern League over the last three games... Each have tallied five, including two extra-base hits from OF Eduardo Garcia.

LET'S GO PROSPECTING: The Biloxi Shuckers roster features five Brewers Top-30 prospects, including RHP Jacob Misorowski (No. 2, No. 31 overall), the organization's best pitching prospect... With INF Joey Ortiz graduating from prospect status on Saturday, four Shuckers moved up a spot in the latest rankings... The four are; INF Brock Wilken (No. 6), INF Eric Brown Jr. (No. 11), RHP Bradley Blalock (No. 17) and C/1B Wes Clarke (No. 24).

TODAY'S STARTER // LHP NATE PETERSON (0-0, 0.00): After 4.2 scoreless innings in his Double-A debut in game two on Thursday's doubleheader, Peterson makes his first home start in a Shuckers uniform... Peterson's start on Thursday was part of a stretch where the Shuckers starting rotation allowed one run or less in seven straight starts... Peterson allowed two hits and worked around three runners in scoring position... Of his five strikeouts, three were on his slider and two came on his curveball.
