YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 10-2. **Hayden Cantrelle** gave Richmond a 2-0 lead in the second with a two-run single. In the third, the SeaWolves scored four runs to take a 4-2 lead. **Danny Serretti** worked a bases-loaded walk, **Gage Workman** scored on a wild pitch, **Chris Meyers** brought in a run with a groundout and **Brady Allen** hit an RBI double. In the fourth, **Jace Jung** drove a three-run double to open a 7-2 lead. **Serretti** added an RBI single in the sixth and **Trei Cruz** hit a two-run single in the seventh to extend the lead to 10-2.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Today is the final game of 2023 regular season. The two teams first met for a six-game series at The Diamond from April 18-23, with Richmond taking four-of-six. In their last trip to UPMC Park, the Flying Squirrels lost the first five games before winning the Sunday finale from May 9-14. The SeaWolves returned to Richmond and won five-of-six from May 30-June 4.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 46-29 in their last 75 games since June 18, the best record in the Eastern League in that span, and have gone 12-4 in their last 16 games. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 4.02 ERA is third-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 5091 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 674.0 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.85 ERA, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A. Richmond hitters have homered 39 times over the last 23 games since August 22, which is the second-most in the minors during that time frame, behind Triple-A Sacramento (41). This year, the Flying Squirrels have won 73 games, the third-most in franchise history. A win today would give them the second-best win percentage (.536) in a season in franchise history, trailing only 2014 (79-63, .556).

THE SEAWOLVES won the Southwest Division's first half and are locked into the postseason for the second straight year. The Erie offense leads the Eastern League in batting average (.248) and hits (1,126) while ranking second in runs (711), total bases (1,894), homers (171), RBIs (669), OBP (.338), SLG (.417) and OPS (.755). Erie's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Jackson Jobe (No. 3, No. 53 overall), 2B Jace Jung (No. 4, No. 98 overall), RHP Ty Madden (No. 5), RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 8), SS Danny Serretti (No. 16) and LHP Brant Hurter (No. 18). MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes six Erie players, including Jobe (No. 3, No. 54 overall), Jung (No. 4, No. 67 overall), Madden (No. 6), Flores (No. 7), Hurter (No. 12), Serretti (No. 25) and RHP Tyler Mattison (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Wil Jensen** makes his fourth start of the season. He last pitched on Thursday against the SeaWolves and allowed one run over two innings. In September, Jensen has a 0.96 ERA (1 ER/91 IP) over four outings. On the year, Jensen leads the team and ranks eighth in the Giants system in wins (7). He has stranded 86.7% of his baserunners this year, which leads the minors (min. 85 IP). Jensen leads the Eastern League (min. 85 IP) in ERA (2.65) and also leads the league in relief innings pitched (75.0). This year, Jensen has a 8.18 ERA (10 ER/11.0 IP) against the SeaWolves compared to a 1.82 ERA (15 ER/74.0 IP) against the rest of the Eastern League. Last year, he reached Double-A in mid-July and went on to pitched eight games (five starts) for Richmond, going 2-2 with a 4.91 ERA. Jensen was signed by the Giants as a free agent from Pepperdine University in 2020. **For more on Jensen, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Jackson Jobe makes his Double-A debut. He has made 15 starts this season across three levels, most recently pitching with the High-A West Michigan Whitecaps, where he went 2-3 with a 3.60 ERA in eight starts. On the season, Jobe has posted 0.93 BB/9 IP and a 2.6% walk rate, which are both the lowest in the minors (min. 50 IP). Jobe was the 2021 Gatorade Oklahoma Player of the Year before being selected with the third-overall pick in that year's MLB Draft. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 3 Tigers prospect and No. 54 overall. MLB.com has Jobe rated as the No. 3 Tigers prospect and No. 54 overall.

PLAYOFF CHASE: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Southwest Division's second-half title with a win on Thursday, locking in their spot in this year's Eastern League Playoffs. They will face the SeaWolves in the Division Series next week, beginning on Tuesday at The Diamond. Somersett and Binghamton have clinched postseason spots for the Northeast Division. The Flying Squirrels have reached the playoffs for the fourth time in team history, including 2011, 2014 and 2022.

POWER SURGE: The Flying Squirrels have homered 39 times in their last 22 games dating back to August 22, which is the second-most in the minors during that span. On August 31 in Hartford, the Richmond hitters combined for eight home runs, which set a new single-game franchise record. It was also tied for the most homers by a team in a single game in the minors this year, even with an eight-homer performance by Sugar Land at Albuquerque on May 7. It was also the most homers in an Eastern League game since the Harrisburg Senators homered eight times at Erie on June 18, 2006. In last week's series against the RubberDucks at The Diamond, they homered nine times. Richmond has six homers in the first five games of this week's series.

COMING UP CLUTCH: Of the Flying Squirrels' last 17 wins, they have scored the winning run in the seventh inning or later in 11 of them. On August 17, **Victor Bericoto** hit a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning the beat Harrisburg after Richmond entered the inning trailing, 6-2, tying the largest ninth-inning comeback in franchise history. On August 19 against the Senators, **Sean Roby** won the game with a walk-off sacrifice fly in the bottom of the ninth. On August 23 at Portland, **Jimmy Glownke** hit a go-ahead single in the top of the ninth inning at Portland to give Richmond a 9-8 win. On August 27 in the second game of a doubleheader at Hadlock Field, the Flying Squirrels rallied after trailing, 8-6, down to their final out in the seventh before **Brady Whalen** and Bericoto hit back-to-back homers to tie the game and **Logan Wyatt** hit a two-run, pinch-hit homer for a 10-8 win. On August 30 at Hartford, Wyatt broke a 4-4 tie with a solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win. On September 2, **Will Wilson** hit a go-ahead single in the eighth, starting a burst of seven runs over the next two innings in a 10-3 win. In the series finale at Hartford on September 3, Richmond scored five runs in the seventh to take a 9-6 lead and won by that score. On September 6 against Akron, the Flying Squirrels picked up a walk-off win in the 10th on an error. On September 7, Wyatt hit a go-ahead single in the bottom of the eighth in a 6-5 win over the RubberDucks. On Saturday night, **Andy Thomas** broke a tie with an RBI single in the eighth for a 5-4 win. On Wednesday, Bericoto hit a two-run, go-ahead double in the eighth in a 6-3 win.

BIG HITS BY BERICOTO: **Victor Bericoto** continued his recent surge with a go-ahead homer on Thursday night. It was his 11th home run with Richmond. He leads the Giants organization with 27 homers and 86 RBIs this season. In his last 19 games since August 24, Bericoto is batting .306 (22-for-72) with eight homers, six doubles and 19 RBIs. He hit a walk-off single on August 17 to beat the Senators and belted a game-tying homer in Portland in a comeback win on August 27. In this week's series at Erie, he is batting .429 (6-for-14) with two homers, two doubles and four RBIs. He also landed on ESPN's SportsCenter Top-10 Plays with a diving catch in right field on Wednesday.

WHALEN'S WARMING UP: In his last 15 games since August 27, **Brady Whalen** is batting .349 (22-for-63) with three homers, five doubles and 13 RBIs, raising his season batting average from .203 to .266. He had hit safely in each of his last 11 games dating back to September 1, the longest active hitting streak in the Eastern League, until going 0-for-4 on Saturday night.

MARTY PARTY: **Brandon Martorano** is batting .353 (6-for-17) with two homers, three RBIs and four walks in his last six games dating back to September 3. He has also homered three times in his last nine games since August 27. On Wednesday, he went 2-for-3 with a walk and a solo homer. Martorano is now tied for 11th in Richmond franchise history with 22 career homers.

LONGBALL LOGAN: **Logan Wyatt** saw his nine-game hit streak end on Wednesday, but over his last 18 games since August 20, he is hitting .333 (21-for-63) with five homers, four doubles, six walks and 14 RBIs. On August 27 in the second game of a doubleheader, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer with two outs in the seventh to lift Richmond to a 10-8 win over the Sea Dogs. On August 30 at Hartford, he launched a go-ahead, solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win. His 17 homers between Eugene and Richmond this season are tied for the fourth-most in the Giants organization. Wyatt also hit a go-ahead single last Thursday in the eighth inning to beat Akron.

GLDW SHOW: **Jimmy Glownke** is batting .328 (22-for-67) with three homers, three doubles, 10 walks and eight RBIs in his last 22 games since August 23. He started this most recent hot stretch on August 23 at Portland, when he hit a two-run homer and picked up two RBI singles, matching his season high with four RBIs for the game. On the year, Glownke is batting .325 (41-for-126) in road games, including all seven of his Double-A homers, compared to .171 (20-for-117) at The Diamond. Last Monday, Glownke was named the Eastern League Player of the Week for his performance at Hartford from August 29-Sept. 3.

ALL ABOARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Since joining the Richmond roster on June 13, **Shane Matheny** leads the team in RBIs (43), OPS (.798), hits (62), doubles (16), triples (2), walks (51), extra-base hits (29), total bases (115) and runs scored (44), is tied for first in homers (11) and ranks second in OBP (.361) and SLG (.437). His 89 walks this year between Richmond and Sacramento are the most by a Giants minor leaguer since **Brandon Belt** had 93 in 2010. Matheny is now second in Richmond franchise history with 142 career walks and tied for fourth with 27 career home runs.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 5 - on IL), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 7 - on IL), RHP **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 12), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 16), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 17 - on IL) **RHP Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and RHP **William Kempner** (No. 30). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and **Jose Cruz** as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).
