## FROM THE CROWS NEST

WELCOME TO THE STRETCH RUN: After dropping both games of the doubleheader last night (3-0 L, 9-0 L), Bradenton is off to a 16-18 start in the second half, currently 1.5 games behind Clearwater and 1.0 game behind Fort Myers for the FSL West's final playoff spot. With 33 games to go, the Marauders are eyeing their first postseason appearance since 2021 when they won their second FSL title. After taking two of three from the Mighty Mussels earlier this week, they have secured the season-series win which gives them the tie-break advantage if the two teams finish with even records at the end of the season. The Marauders enter tonight 8-11 versus the Threshers this season, meaning Clearwater has already clinched the tie-break advantage over them.

NAVARRO'S TURN: Left hander Reinold Navarro will take the ball tonight as the Marauders seek the bounce-back win against the Threshers. Over two outings and 0.2 innings with Bradenton, Navarro has walked eight batters and allowed seven runs. He was unable to record an out after walking four and allowing a hit during his previous outing last Saturday versus Dunedin. His hardest bolt of the night registered at 99.0 mph, marking the hardest pitch from any Marauder left hander since statcast began measuring in FSL games. It also slots as the 3rd hardest by a southpaw in the FSL this season. His slider sat at 83.2 mph. Over nine appearances and eight starts with the FCL this season, the Dominican Republic native pitched to a 2.81 ERA over 25.2 innings. In the process, he fanned 47 hitters and allowed just seven hits (.088 BAA). In his career, the southpaw has surrendered just three extra-base hits against 221 batters faced (.147 opp. SLG). This season, he's topped out at four innings of work three times, and has punched out a career-high eight hitters in three seperate starts. 2025 marks his first year in the states after signing as an International MilB Free Agent in January of 2024. He was named a Dominican Summer League All Star in 2024.

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK: Sammy Stafura made his Marauders debut last night, finishing 3-for-4 and a home run shy of the cycle. On Wednesday, the Pirates acquired Stafura and LHP Taylor Rogers from the Cincinnati Reds organization in exchange for third basemen Ke Bryan Hayes. While Rogers was flipped to the Chicago Cubs before the trade deadline, Stafura remains in the Pirates system and has been assigned to Single-A Bradenton. The 20 year old is currently ranked as the No. 7 prospect in the Pirates system by MLB Pipeline. He was drafted by the Reds in the second round of the 2023 draft out of high school in Cortlandt New York. In 88 games with the Daytona Tortugas this season, he slashed. 262(3/393/41) with four home runs and 28 stolen bases. In two games against Bradenton to begin the season, he went 3-for-6 with a double and RBI. The Marauders will face the Tortugas at LECOM park from August 19-24.

**TONY TATORS:** Pirates No. 21 prospect (MLB Pipeline) **Tony Blanco Jr.** demolished his first Single-A homer last night in the bottom of the sixth inning on Wednesday night after sending a fastball 415 feet to left field, that cleared the confines of LECOM Park. The ball left his bat at 118.9 miles per hour, marking the hardest-hit ball in Single-A this season, clearing the next closest batted ball by 4.4 mph. Only five batted balls at the Major-League level have been hit harder this season. He joins Oneil Cruz (3) and Vladamir Guerrero Jr. (2) on the list. Only him and Cruz (122.9 mph) have left the yard with such batted ball quality. He was activated and assigned to Single-A Bradenton on Saturday, July 19 at Jupiter. Blanco began the season on the injured list and just completed a two-game rehab assignment with the FCL Pirates where he went 1-for-G with a home run. In 30 FCL games last year, Blanco Jr. batted .305 and slugged .505 with four homers. His father Tony Blanco played 62 big-league games for the Washington Nationals in 2005 and spent eight seasons in the Nippon Professional Baseball League in Japan.

MARAUDERS MASHERS: The Bradenton Marauders return from the All-Star Break as one of the best home-run hitting teams in all of Class-A. Their 82 longballs this season are tied for the most in the Florida State League and Class-A (San Jose - California League). 126 of their 456 total runs have been generated via the long ball (27.6%). They're 29-23 when leaving the yard at least once, and 17-28 when not homering at all. They've seen four players launch 9+ home runs this season, more than any other team in the FSL (A. Plaz, Y. De Los Santos, K. Griffin, J. Severino)

**BURNING THE BASE PATHS: Yordany De Los Santos** stole his 40th stolen base of the season on Friday, adding to a career-best mark (34 between FCL/Single-A in 2024). In the process, he passed **Jesus Castillo** (2023), for the most single-season stolen bases by a Marauder in franchise history. He ranks first in the Florida State League and seventh in Single-A. Moreover, he sits only behind **Konnor Griffin** (44) for the most swipes in the Pittsburgh Pirates system. They are the ninth and tenth 40+ stolen-base seasons in Pirates-MiLB history. The two are approaching **Rich Thompson** for the most in a season by a Pirates minor leaguer when he stole 58 in 2005 between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis.

REINOLD NAVARRO'S HIGHS

Left hander **Reinold Navarro** will take the ball tonight as the Marauders seek the bounce-back win against the Threshers. Over two outings and 0.2 innings with Bradenton, Navarro has walked eight batters and allowed seven runs. He was unable to record an out after walking four and allowing a hit during his previous outing last Saturday versus Dunedin. His hardest bolt of the night registered at 99.0 mph, marking the hardest pitch from any Marauder left hander since statcast began measuring in FSL games. It also slots as the 3rd hardest by a southpaw in the FSL this season. His slider sat at 83.2 mph. Over nine appearances and eight starts with the FCL this season, the Dominican Republic native pitched to a 2.81 ERA over 25.2 innings. In the process, he fanned 47 hitters and allowed just seven hits (.088 BAA). In his career, the southpaw has surrendered just three extra-base hits against 221 batters faced (.147 opp. SLG). This season, he's topped out at four innings of work three times, and has punched out a career-high eight hitters in three seperate starts. 2025 marks his first year in the states after signing as an International MiLB Free Agent in January of 2024. He was named a Dominican Summer League All Star in 2024.
