CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: On Thursday, the Captains were swept by the TinCaps in a seven-inning doubleheader, evening the series and ending the Captains' seven-game losing streak.

GAME 1: Despite putting runners in scoring position in the first inning, the Captains were held hitless in their final 19 at-bats against TinCaps LHP Miguel Cienfuegos, falling 3-0.

Although RHP **Carter Spivey** (1-1) suffered his first career Minor League loss, he did throw his second straight quality start. The righthander went a career-high six innings in his second consecutive start, allowing three runs (two earned) on five hits, fanning two, and walking none. 1B **Maick Collado** extended his hit streak to a thenteam-best 10 games with a first-inning single.

GAME 2: In a designated away game originally scheduled for April 11 in Fort Wayne, Indiana, the TinCaps prevailed by a final score of 3-1.

RF Angel Zarate tallied a double and a sacrifice fly, and CF Guy Lipscomb, 3B Tyresse Turner, and C Kevin Rivas recorded a single. RHP Zane Morehouse spun two scoreless innings of relief and was one of just two Captains relievers to pitch in the doubleheader (RHP Josh Wolf pitched a scoreless seventh inning in Game 1).

ON THE POND: After playing in yesterday's doubleheader, Captains INFs Maick Collado and Nate Furman extended their onbase streaks to 15 and 14, respectively. Collado holds the thirdlongest active streak in the MWL, while Furman has the fourthlongest.

CONGRATS, CCI: 19-year MLB vet and 2007 AL Cy Young Award winner CC Sabathia was named the 48th member of the Cleveland Guardians Hall of Fame on Thursday. While he did not pitch for Lake County, Sabathia went 2-0 with a 1.08 ERA in three starts for its predecessor, the Columbus RedStixx (Columbus, Georgia).

21st SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,758 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,386-1,372 (.503).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with ts 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

STRONG STARTING PITCHING: Lake County's starting pitching staff has been one of the premier units in the Midwest League so far this season. The group ranks top-five in the Midwest League in strikeouts (118, 1st), fewest walks (25, 1st), wins (7, tied for 1st), WHIP (1.18, 2nd) innings pitched (114.0, 1st), and ERA (3.55, 5th).

TOP QUALITY: Through 24 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded a Midwest League-best 7 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs). Cedar Rapids has the next-most quality starts by a Midwest League team so far this season with 4. The other 11 Midwest League teams besides Lake County have a combined 14 quality starts so far this year.

KAYFUS CRUSHING THE BALL: Lake County INF/OF C.J. Kayfus has been one of the Midwest League's premier hitters in his first 14 career High-A games. The 22-year-old ranks top-five in the MWL in batting average (.339, 5th), slugging percentage (.581, 5th), and OPS (.981, 5th).

COLLADO COLLECTING BASES: Captains INF Maick Collado has reached base at an incredible rate in his first 16 career High-A games. The 21-year-old has a .500 OBP, which leads the Midwest League and is tied for 6th in all of Minor League Baseball. Collado also ranks top-10 in the MWL in batting average (.333, 6th) OPS (.931, 8th), and walks (15, tied for 8th). He is also currently on a 15-game on base streak, which is the thirdlongest in the Midwest League. During this stretch, he is hitting .362 (17for-47), 5 runs, 2 doubles, 1 home run, 5 RBI, 16 walks, and a .999 OPS.

MOONEY'S MONSTER START: Lake County INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, has gotten off to a red-hot start in his first 19 career High-A games. The 21-year-old ranks top-seven in the Midwest League in slugging percentage (.597, 2nd), home runs (5, tied for Jord), extra-base hits (11, tied for 5th), total bases (43, tied for 5th), and OPS (.956, 7th). His .306 batting average also ranks 14th in the MWL.

MOONEY'S STELLAR SERIES: Captains INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, <u>was named the second Captain of</u> the Week, presented by Official League, for his performance in last week's series at West Michigan. The 21-year-old hit 8-for-21 (.381), with 7 runs, 3 doubles, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, one walk, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-bypitches. Mooney's 2 home runs (tied for 2nd), 5 extra-base hits (3rd), and 7 runs (tied for 3rd) all ranked top-three in the Midwest League this past week.

MOONEY MAKES, HISTORY: On Saturday, April 27, Captains INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, tied a pair of franchise records. The 2023 seventh-round pick went 5-for-5 with 3 doubles, becoming the 16th Captain to record a 5-hit game, and the 13th to record a 3-double game. Mooney recorded the first 5-hit performance by a Lake County player since Bobby Ison on 8/7/2016 vs. West Michigan, and the first 3-double performance since current Double-A Akron RubberDucks OF Chase DeLauter on 7/9/2023 at Lansing.

PLENTY OF '23 IN LC: Six players on the Captains' current active roster were selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the 2023 MLB Draft. INF/OF C.J. Kayfus was drafted in Round 3, C Cooper Ingle in Round 4, INF Alex Mooney in Round 7, OF Jonah Advincula in Round 8, RHP Jay Driver in Round 9, and RHP Zane Morehouse in Round 14.

LAST TIME OUT: Trenton Denholm made his fourth start of the season back on April 27 at West Michigan. The right-hander spun his second quality start of the season, throwing 6 innings, allowing 1 run on 4 hits with a season-high 8 strikeouts and his first walk of the season in the 8-1 win. **Denholm** threw 60 of his 88 pitches (68.2%) for strikes.

MIDWEST LEAGUE RANKS: Denholm leads the Midwest League and ranks 22nd in all of Minor League Baseball in WHIP (0.84). The right-hander also ranks 8th in the MWL in ERA (2.53), and is second in K/BB ratio (22.00). He also leads the Midwest League and is 22nd in all of MiLB in ground ball rate (55.2%).

AGAINST FORT WAYNE IN '24: Denholm made his 2024 season debut at Fort Wayne back on April 9. He ended up earning the victory, allowing 1 run on 2 hits with 4 strikeouts in 5 innings of work in the 7-2 win.

LAST 10 STARTS: Denholm has posted a 1.91 ERA (10 earned runs in 47 innings) over his last 10 starts, which date back to April 13, 2023.

CAPTAIN ON THE MOUND: In 2023, **Denholm** played a versatile role in his first season with Lake County's pitching staff. The right-hander made 23 appearances (six starts), recording 3 wins and 3 saves in 5 opportunities out of the Captains' bullpen. He was also very efficient on the mound last year, tallying 67 strikeouts to just 18 walks, and compiling a 1.14 WHIP.

HILLCAT ON THE HILL: Denholm pitched his first professional season in 2022, making 23 starts for the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. The right-hander finished the season with a 5-5 record, 4.79 ERA, and 107 strikeouts in 97.2 innings pitched.

AWESOME ANTEATER: Denholm had a strong collegiate career in his four seasons at UC Irvine. As a sophomore in 2019, the right-hander was named the 2019 Big West Pitcher of the Year, as well as a *Collegiate Baseball Newspaper* 3rd Team All-American, after finishing the campaign with a 9-4 record, 1.81 ERA, and 93 strikeouts in 99.2 innings pitched. This season resulted in **Denholm** being invited to the USA Collegiate National Team training camp, and being named to the Golden Spikes Award Watch List prior to both the 2020 and 2021 seasons.

OTHER NOTABLE ANTEATERS: Three-time all-star and former Boston/Baltimore/Cleveland OF Brady Anderson (1983-85), Keston Hiura (2015-17), former Cleveland pitcher David Huff (2004).

BASEBALL IN THE FAMILY: Denholm is related to former MLB catcher Rod Barajas. He played 14 MLB seasons with seven different teams, notably winning a World Series with the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks. Barajas hit .235 in his MLB career, with 812 hits, 136 home runs, 480 RBI, and 187 doubles.
