TODAY'S GAME: The Memphis Redbirds wrap up the first homestand of the season against the Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto Blue Jays) with a doubleheader on Sunday afternoon at AutoZone Park. Right-handed pitcher Ian Bedell gets the start for Memphis opposite right-handed pitcher Jake Bloss for Buffalo in game one. Redbirds left-handed pitcher Alex Cornwell and Bisons righty Andrew Bash battle in game two.

2024 CAMPAIGN: The Memphis Redbirds finished the 2024 season with a 74-74 record. It marked the first time since the 2018 season with a record of .500 or better. The Redbirds went 38-38 at AutoZone Park.

ABOUT FRIDAY: The Memphis Redbirds swept a doubleheader against the Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto Blue Jays) on Friday night at AutoZone Park. Memphis took the lead in the second inning of game one on a third baseman Cesar Prieto two-run home run to left field. The left-handed hitter finished game one 2-for-2 with two runs scored, two RBIs, a stolen base and his second home run of the season. The Redbirds added two more runs in the fifth with RBI singles from first baseman Gavin Collins and second baseman Jose Fermin. Starting pitcher Michael McGreevy (1-1) tossed 5.0 shutout innings in his first home start of the season. The right-handed pitcher allowed three hits, walked one and struck out five. Ryan Loutos (S, 1) converted the first Memphis save chance of the season with a scoreless seventh. The Redbirds took game one by a final score of 4-1. After falling behind 1-0 in the third inning of game two, left fielder Mike Antico doubled in his first plate appearance of the season to lead off the inning. Antico scored to tie the game on a third baseman Jose Fermin fielder's choice. Memphis took the lead with a two-run fourth inning. After a shortstop Michael Helman walk, center fielder Jose Barrero doubled to right-center field for the lead. Two batters later, first baseman Matt Lloyd tallied his sixth RBI of the series with a single to right field. Starting pitcher Quinn Mathews allowed one run on two hits, walked six and struck out four in 3.2 innings pitched. The six walks are a new career high for the left-handed pitcher. Curtis Taylor (1-0) tossed 2.1 innings of shut down relief to earn the win. The right-handed pitcher struck out four, walked one and did not allow a hit. Roddery Munoz (S, 1) struck out one and stranded two to convert his first save of the season.

2025 HOME SLATE: The Memphis is scheduled to open the 2025 home slate at AutoZone Park against the Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto Blue Jays) on April 1 to begin a six-game series. The Redbirds are scheduled to host 75 home games. Key home dates include Easter Sunday (April 20), Fourth of July and 13 Saturday games at AutoZone Park. The Cross-state rival Nashville Sounds (Triple-A, Milwaukee Brewers) are on tap to duel Memphis nine times at AutoZone Park during the season, highlighted by a three-game series July 4-6. The Gwinnett Stripers (Triple-A, Atlanta Braves) come to AutoZone Park for a pair of six-game sets, July 22-27 and August 19-24. The Redbirds will play a season-long nine-game homestand July 4-13. The 2024 All-Star Break will span July 14-17. The home slate wraps up with a six-game series against the St. Paul Saints. (Triple-A, Minnesota Twins) at AutoZone Park September 16-21. Memphis will host the St. Paul and Rochester Red Wings (Triple-A, Washington Nationals) for the first time since the club moved to the International League before the 2021 season. Other home opponents include the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (Triple-A, Miami Marlins), Louisville Bats (Triple-A, Cincinnati Reds), Indianapolis Indians (Triple-A, Pittsburgh Pirates), Norfolk Tides (Triple-A, Baltimore Orioles), Charlotte Knights (Triple-A, Chicago White Sox), and Durham Bulls (Triple-A, Tampa Bay Rays).

MANAGER BEN JOHNSON

Ben Johnson enters his seventh season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his seventh year in the Cardinals organization.

COACHING CAREER

- 348 - 367 managerial record entering 202 season
- Oversaw a franchise record 15-game winning streak in 2021 (7/9-7/25); tied for longest in MiLB that season
- Oversaw a franchise record 200 home runs in 2019; team won 29 of final 40 games and were in contention for division until 2nd to last day of the season
- Spent 2018 as third base coach for the Durham Bulls (Rays' Triple-A)
- Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

PLAYING CAREER

- Drafted by the Cardinals in the 4th Rd. of 1999 Draft; traded to Padres in 2000
- Made MLB debut on June 26, 2005 with the Padres; played 98 games over next three seasons with the Padres and Mets
- Named Padres Minor League Player of the Year in 2005 when he hit a career-high .312 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs as a member of the Portland Beavers
- Played 901 MiLB games over 10 seasons with Cardinals, Padres, Mets and Tigers; hit .262 with 115 career home runs and 473 RBIs

PERSONAL

- Born in Memphis and played baseball at Germantown HS; named Memphis-area HS Player of the Year in 1999; lives with his dad during the season
- He and his wife, Elizabeth, have two children, Ethan and Ruby; reside in Phoenix, AZ

PITCHING COACH DARWIN MARRERO

- Marrero, 44, is beginning his 13th season in the Cardinals organization and third with Memphis.

COACHING CAREER

- Joined the Memphis Redbirds coaching staff following five seasons (2018-22) with Double-A Springfield Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

PLAYING CAREER

- Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

HITTING COACH HOWIE CLARK

- Clark is beginning his third season in the Cardinals organization and second with Memphis

COACHING CAREER

- In 2015, Clark was named the hitting coach of the Delmarva Shorebirds, the Class-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. In February 2017, Clark was named the assistant hitting coach for the Orioles. He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season. [9] On December 1, 2020, Clark was named assistant hitting coach for the Chicago White Sox.

PLAYING CAREER

- Clark played parts of six seasons in MLB with the Baltimore Orioles, Minnesota Twins and Toronto Blue Jays from 2002 to 2008.
- Clark batted .262 with three home runs and 26 RBI in his career

- Signed by the Cardinals as a non-drafted free agent with an invitation to 2025 Major League Spring Training, four days prior to pitchers and catchers reporting. St. Louis become his eighth organization (Twins, Marlins, Rays, Braves, Royals, Dodgers and Orioles) and fifth in the last three years.
- Originally drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in 2012, but did not sign. Played three seasons of Independent League baseball in the Frontier League for the Rockford RiverHawks and Aviators (2012-13), and a season in a men's baseball league in 2014, then the Greys (2015), before the Minnesota Twins signed him as a minor league free agent in August 2015.
- Made his MLB debut with the Miami Marlins on March 28, 2019, and retired Ryan McMahon as his only batter faced. Struck out the side in his next appearance two days later (Trevor Story, Ryan McMahon, Ian Desmond).

- Southern California native graduated from Maranatha High School in Pasadena, Calif., which produced former MLB pitchers Dylan Covey and Tim Worrell.
- Attended the University of Southern California from 2018-21 but did not play his first two seasons because of injury.
- Made 15 starts in 2021 with 65 strikeouts against 21 walks.
- Originally selected by the Chicago Cubs in the 37th round of the 2017 MLB Draft, but did not sign.
