Team W/L in Starts:

**LAST OUTING:** Rodriguez picked up his third consecutive win at Durham on May 10. He went 6.0 innings, four hits, one earned run, and six strikeouts in his second quality start of the season.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** This is Rodriguez's second career start against Jacksonville. His first career Triple-A start came at home versus Jacksonville on September 20, 2023. He went 4.2 innings, allowing five hits, three earned runs, four walks and struck out six.

#### **2024 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Was Nashville's Opening Day starter at Toledo on March 29...took loss
- Earned first win of season on April 28 at Louisville (5.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 6 BB, 1 K)...was just the fourth time a Sounds starter earned the win despite walking six since 2005 and the first since Johnny Hellweg on May 16, 2013 at Salt Lake
- Struck out nine in his best outing at the Triple-A level on May 4 vs. Norfolk
