The Cubs blew a late 3-run lead and gave up a 5-spot in the 7th as the Captains took game 1 of the series, 7-5. Lake County only needed 3 hits in the frame as the Cubs walked 2 batters and hit another. Brody McCullough exited the game after 5 great innings in line for his first win with SB after allowing just 1 earned run. Matt Shaw tallied 2 RBIs and Yohendrick Pinango picked up a pair of knocks.

DEVERS DEALING

Luis Devers was named the MWL Pitcher of the Week on Monday. Devers bookended last series with starts and went 5 shutout innings in both games. On the week last year's Cubs MiLB Pitcher of the Year went 2-0, 10 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 14 K. His 8 K's on Sunday were a season high.

Felix Stevens continued his hitting streak to 15 straight games Sunday with a HR in game one but his streak ended in game 2 of the doubleheader. Felix has 4 HR in his last 22 at-bats, and his last 7 hits going back to the Sunday prior are all XBH (3 2B, 4 HR).

SLAMMING SHAW IN SOUTH BEND

Matt Shaw was taken 13th overall by the Cubs in the 2023 MLB Draft and after playing 3 games in the ACL, he has been sent up to South Bend. Shaw signed for slot value at \$4.85 million. Shaw was the Cape Cod League MVP in 2022 and then crushed his junior year at Maryland... he hit .341 this year with a .445 OBP and .697 SLG, 24 HR and 69 RBI... He also walked 43 times compared to 42 Ks in 62 games. Shaw became the highest Maryland draft pick ever, surpassing John Hetrick who went 17th to the Tigers in 1967. He's also the 6th 1st rounder in Terps baseball history and the 1st since Brett Cecil in 2007. On March 31, 2023 Shaw hit an 0-2 pitch, with 2 outs, and Maryland trailing Iowa 6-3, 507 feet for a go-ahead grand slam.

During streak he's batting .375, .688 SLG, 1.156 OPS... 5 HR, 21 RBI, 14 XBH, 14 BB...didn't play at Peoria or in final 4 games vs West Michigan.

Chrsitian Franklin: On-base in 19 of last 20 games...Since July 20 he's walked 14 times in 18 games...Since July 20 he's batting .340 with 4 HR, 13 RBI, 10 BB, a .459 OBP, .680 SLG and 1.139 OPS

Felix Stevens: hit in 15 of last 17 games... Last 7 hits all XBH (4 HR, 3 2B)...1st in the Cubs system with 21 HR

ABOUT TYLER

LAST TIME OUT: Santana was the first man out of the bullpen Friday at home vs Wisconsin. He went 3 innings and faced the minimum, erasing an Ernesto Martinez Jr. single with a double play off the bat of Joe Gray Jr. Santana served as the Bridge between starter Michael Arias and closer Sheldon Reed, Santana tossed the 6th-8th.

AUG 9: Santana's last 17 appearances have been out of the bullpen. Today he makes his first start since May 19 at Beloit when he went 5 shutout frames and allowed just 1 hit.

Tyler's ERA stood at 5.50 after his outing on July 4th, and he's brought it down 4.46 with great work over the past month.

Responded after tough Peoria outing with the best start of his season vs Cedar Rapids, pitching 4 innings with 2 runs allowed, but with only a walk and 8 K's.

Santana went the final 3 innings vs Peoria on April 26 and allowed 3 runs in the 9th, taking the loss as South Bend fell 3-2. He allowed a 2-out, 2-run single to Francisco Hernandez that gave the Chiefs the lead.
