BEACH CHICKENS NEWS & NOTES

WELCOME TO THE BEACH!: Today marks the first of four games in which the Biloxi Shuckers will transform into the Biloxi Beach Chickens as the Shuckers honor the fun-loving seagulls (i.e. Beach Chickens) that inhabit the Coast's beaches... Brandiose, the award-winning studio behind the Shuckers and King Cakes identities, designed the logo set... Along with the primary Beach Chicken logo, the set includes an alternate logo and a beach-themed jersey for the occasion.

<u>THOU SHALL NOT RUN</u>: **C** Darrien Miller made Shuckers history on Friday during the third inning, throwing out **OF** Wilfred Veras and **OF** Jacob Burke trying to steal second in the same inning... Miller became the third player in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015) to throw out two baserunners in the same inning and the first catcher at the Double-A level to achieve the feat during the 2024 season... Miller joined **C** Dustin Houle (April 16, 2017) and **C** Adam Weisenburger (July 18, 2015) as the third player to reach the mark in franchise history.

<u>HOME COOKING</u>: **INF/OF Noah Campbel**l hit his first home run of the year with the Shuckers on Friday, a solo shot to left off *MLB Pipeline's* No. 56 prospect **RHP Drew Thorpe**... In 10 games at Shuckers Ballpark during the 2024 season, Campbell is hitting .310 [9-for-29] with two doubles, a triple and a home run.

© Campbell's .996 OPS at home ranks as the sixth-highest at home in the Southern League (min. 30 PA)... His .444 on-base percentage at home ranks fifth in the league.

MR. MERKEL'S MADNESS: RHP Nick Merkel tossed 2.2 scoreless innings on Friday, his fourth straight scoreless appearance out of the Shuckers' bullpen... Over six relief appearances of at least two innings, Merkel has tallied five scoreless appearances and 12 strikeouts over 15 innings.

DOWN TO THE WIRE: The Shuckers tied Thursday's game at four in the bottom of the ninth inning with a two-RBI triple from **C Darrien Miller**... The triple was the third game-tying triple in the ninth inning or later in franchise history (since 2015) and the first since **3B/1B Tyler Black** on July 20, 2023 against the Montgomery Biscuits... It's the first time in franchise history that a game-tying triple has occurred at home... The triple was Miller's third career triple and marked his third straight season with a triple.

THE BULLPEN CHRONICLES: RHP Kaleb Bowman tied his MiLB career-high with 3.1 scoreless innings on Thursday, lowering his season ERA to 0.81 over 22.1 innings... Over six appearances in May, Bowman has allowed one earned run in 15.1 innings, a 0.59 ERA... 10 of Bowman's 12 appearances have been scoreless, including six multi-inning scoreless appearances.

<u>LET'S GO PROSPECTING</u>: The Biloxi Shuckers roster features five Brewers Top-30 prospects, including **RHP Jacob Misiorowski** (No. 1, No. 33 overall), the organization's best pitching prospect... The other four are; **INF Brock Wilken** (No. 5), **INF Eric Brown Jr.** (No. 10), **INF Mike Boeve** (No. 13) and **RHP Brett Wichrowski** (No. 14).

<u>TODAY'S STARTER // RHP TJ SHOOK [2-5, 4.46]</u>: Shook makes his ninth start of the season and his fourth start of the year at Shuckers Ballpark... Over his first three starts, Shook has a 1.20 ERA with 23 strikeouts in 15.0 innings... Shook's 1.20 ERA at Shuckers Ballpark is the ninth-lowest at home at the Double-A level (min 15.0 IP)... Over two starts during the Shuckers' last home series against the Montgomery Biscuits, Shook allowed two earned runs in 10.0 innings with 16 strikeouts, including a season-high eight strikeouts in each start.
