**INDIANAPOLIS, IND.** - After coming from behind to take the season opener, the Omaha Storm Chasers scored in six of nine innings Saturday afternoon to beat the Indianapolis Indians 12-1 and secure a series win at Victory Field.

- ✦ All nine Storm Chasers hitters in the starting lineup scored a run and reached base at least once, while eight of nine recorded hits with five multi-hit performances.
- ✦ **Samad Taylor** continued where he left off from Friday night, opening the scoring in the 3rd inning with a sac fly, then **Maikel Garcia** followed behind him with an RBI single to give Omaha a 2-0 lead, his first of 3 RBI for the second straight game.
- ✦ **Logan Porter** deposited the first Storm Chasers home run of the season onto the left field berm in the 4th inning, a 417-foot solo shot that put Omaha further, 3-0.
- ✦ Garcia scored Taylor on a double to open the fifth, then DH **Jackson Reetz** doubled the score to 8-0 with a grand slam to left field, a 408-foot homer.
- ✦ **Nick Pratto** and **Tyler Gentry** each drove in runs in the sixth inning to put Omaha up 10-0, then Reetz added an RBI single in the eighth inning and Garcia brought home another run with a sacrifice fly in the ninth inning.
- ✦ Starter **Austin Cox** struck out 5 over 3.0 scoreless frames and was followed by lefty **Drew Parrish**, who threw 3.0 hitless and scoreless frames.
- ✦ Indianapolis struck for a run on three hits in the 7th inning against **Josh Taylor**, but scoreless innings from **Nick Wittgren** and **Ryan Weiss** ended the day.
- ✦ Omaha's infield turned five double plays, including in each of the last four innings.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### ROSTER RETURNERS

- 17 members of Omaha's Opening Day roster spent time with the Chasers last season.
- ✦ 2 players spent the entire 2022 season with Omaha: pitchers **Austin Cox** and **Andrés Núñez**.
  - ✦ 8 players were on Omaha's Opening Day roster in 2022: pitchers **Austin Cox**, **Jonathan Heasley**, **Marcelo Martinez** and **Andrés Núñez**; catcher **Freddy Fermin**; infielders **Angelo Castellano** and **Nick Pratto**; and outfielder **Dairon Blanco**.
  - ✦ 6 players made their Royals organization debuts in this series, after joining Kansas City in the offseason: pitchers **Brooks Kriske**, **Mike Mayers**, **Evan Sisk**, **Josh Taylor** and **Nick Wittgren** and infielder **Samad Taylor** (acquired in July 2022, did not appear in a game for a Royals affiliate) ... Kriske, Mayers, Sisk and Taylor all made their organization debuts on Friday, while, Taylor and Wittgren both pitched in Saturday's win.

#### COMEBACK KIDS

- Since falling behind 5-0 after the first inning on Friday, Omaha has outscored Indianapolis by a combined margin of 20-2.
- ✦ All 20 of Omaha's runs this season have come in the last 14 innings, after opening the season with four scoreless frames.
  - ✦ Omaha has scored runs in 10 of its last 14 innings, with five of those frames featuring 2+ runs.

#### MONEY MAIKEL

- Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** has opened the season 3-for-9 (.333) at the plate, with 6 runs batted in over his first two games.
- ✦ Garcia drove in three runs in Friday's season opener with a groundout, single and walk, then plated three more on Saturday with a single, double and sacrifice fly.
  - ✦ Six runs batted in ranks 2nd in the International League behind 7 from Norfolk's **Josh Lester** and 3rd in all of Triple-A.
  - ✦ Garcia drove in multiple runs in back-to-back games twice last season, both times with Omaha ... it's the first time in his professional career he's drive in three runs in consecutive games ... having driven in multiple runs in back-to-back games just three times prior to last season, he's now done it as many times with Omaha (42 games) as he has the rest of his pro career (348 games).

#### THREE'S COMPANY

- After managing the Triple-A Omaha franchise from 1995 to 1997 and 2003 to 2013, **Mike Jirsch** returns in 2023 to manage the Storm Chasers, his 15th season at the helm in Omaha and is quickly approaching an incredible milestone.
- ✦ Over his now 15 seasons in Omaha, "Jirsch" has managed 2,015 games ... with yesterday's win, he has a 996-1,018 record (.494 winning %). The team's fifth win this season will mark his 1,000th all-time with Omaha, so he currently sits **THREE** away.
  - ✦ When factoring in three seasons managing lower-level Royals affiliates between 1992 and 1994, Jirsch has managed 2,344 games with a 1,210-1,134 all-time managerial record (.516 winning %).

### MANAGER: MIKE JIRSCHLE • 36

- Mike Jirschele returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Witheridge during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Witheridge's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for *outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field* and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
- Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- He appeared 999 games in the Minor Leagues across 13 years, between 1977 and 1990, including 22 games with the Omaha Royals between 1988 and 1989.



### PITCHING COACH: DANE JOHNSON • 59

- Dane Johnson enters his fourth year in the Royals organization and as the Storm Chasers pitching coach, after joining Kansas City ahead of the 2020 season. 2023 marks his 24th season coaching overall.
- He previously spent one season in the Miami Marlins organization (2019) as a Pitching Consultant and 19 seasons with the Toronto Blue Jays as a Minor League Pitching Coach from 2000-03, Pitching Coordinator from 2004-14 and Major League Bullpen Coach from 2015-18.
- Prior to entering coaching, spent 15 years as a player, including over 280 games in the Minor Leagues and parts of three seasons in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox (1994), Blue Jays (1996) and Oakland Athletics (1997), also playing two seasons (1990-1991) in the Chinese Professional Baseball League.
- Johnson and his wife, Gina, reside in Palm Harbor, Florida. They have two children: a daughter, Madison (31), and son, Cobi (27).



### HITTING COACH: BIJAN RADEMACHER • 52

- Bijan Rademacher (*bi-ZHON RAH-de-moch-err*) joins the Royals as the Omaha Storm Chasers Hitting Coach this year after spending the last two years with the Arizona Diamondbacks as their Minor League Hitting Coordinator (2021) and ACL Hitting Coach (2022).
- Prior to coaching, he spent eight years playing professionally (2012-2019), spanning seven seasons in the Chicago Cubs organization (2012-18) and slashed .280/.361/.402 over 702 career MiLB games, reaching as high as Triple-A. He also played one season in independent baseball (2019) with the New Britain Bees in the Atlantic League, in addition to an offseason in the Mexican Pacific Winter League.
- Over 243 career Triple-A games with the Iowa Cubs, he played 11 games at Werner Park and was a .378 hitter (14-for-37) with one homer and 5 runs batted in while playing in Omaha.
- Rademacher lives in Tempe, Arizona with his wife Melissa.



### BENCH COACH: DAVID NOWORYTA • 33

- David Noworyta (*Nova-REE-tah*) enters his second year in the Royals organization and first as Omaha's Bench Coach, after making his coaching debut in 2022 as the Assistant Hitting Coach for the River Bandits Kansas City's High-A affiliate.
- Prior to coaching, he spent four years playing professionally (2018-21), including three minor league seasons in the Detroit Tigers organization (2018-20), and one with the Independent Pioneer League's Billings Mustangs in 2021. Before signing with Detroit in 2018, Noworyta graduated from the University of Hawaii with a bachelor's degree in communications and journalism, and played in parts of three seasons for their baseball team.
- Noworyta attended Holy Cross Academy (N.J.), where he played baseball and basketball, and was selected by the Royals in the 37th round of the 2014 MLB Draft. He resides in Hainesport, N.J. in the offseason.



### CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINER: JAMES STONE

- James Stone is entering his fifth season as the Certified Athletic Trainer for the Storm Chasers after serving the previous seven seasons with the Wilmington Blue Rocks (Royals High-A), including the 2015 season, in which he was named Carolina League Athletic Trainer of the Year.
- He joined the Kansas City organization in 2010 as the athletic trainer for the Class-A Burlington Bees. He came to the Royals after spending one season with the Central Valley Coyotes (Fresno, California) in Arena Football 2.
- Stone worked three seasons in the Florida Marlins organization, with stops in Jupiter (2008), Greensboro (2007) and Jamestown (2006), winning New York-Penn League Trainer of the Year honors in 2006.
- He was the Strength and Conditioning Coach for the Baltimore Orioles Class-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2005.
- Stone graduated with a bachelor's of science in kinesiology from Cal State-Northridge. He resides in Simi Valley, California with his dog, Ozzie.



### STRENGTH & CONDITIONING COACH: YANNICK PLANTE

- Yannick Plante is entering his third season as the Strength & Conditioning Coach for the Storm Chasers, after being slated to serve in that role with Northwest Arkansas in 2020.
- He began with the Kansas City Organization in 2019 as the athletic trainer for the Burlington Royals (Advanced Rookie, Appalachian League). He was then a staff member of the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League in the fall of 2019.
- Plante has a master's degree in kinesiology from the University of Calgary and a bachelor's degree in human kinetics with specialization in biophysics from the University of Ottawa. He currently lives in Ottawa, Ontario.
