WALCOTT LEADS RIDERS TO SERIES FINALE VICTORY IN MIDLAND:
The Frisco RoughRiders took down the Midland RockHounds on Sunday evening, 5-1, from Momentum Bank Ballpark. Frisco (30-32, 68-62) jumped out in front early in the third. Theo Hardy doubled down the left field line to put the Riders on the board before Sebastian Walcott roped an RBI single into left to give the Riders a 2-0 lead. In the bottom of the sixth, Midland (24-39, 63-69) struck against Jose Gonzalez (2-2) with an RBI single from T.J. Schofield-Sam to draw within 2-1. The unearned run was all Gonzalez allowed over his six innings on four hits while striking out four and walking two. The Riders then added on in the eighth on a two-run triple from Walcott and a sacrifice fly from **Keyber Rodriguez**, producing a 5-1 win. The RoughRiders bullpen threw scoreless baseball the rest of the way with runless innings from Jackson Kelley, Emiliano Teodo and Gerardo Carrillo. Domingo Robles (0-4) was handed the loss for Midland, ceding two runs over his five innings.

#### THREE HOMER GAME, THE Z-QUEL:

Aaron Zavala had an amazing night on August 27th against San Antonio, going 4-for-5 with three home runs, five RBIs, four runs scored and a walk. It was his first three home run game in his career and tied a career best in RBIs and runs scored. Two homestands ago, he walked off the Midland RockHounds with a home run on August 15th for his first walk-off homer with Frisco and second walk-off hit. In his last 26 games, he is hitting .267 (28-for-105)/.339/.505/.844 with eight doubles, five home runs, 21 RBIs, nine walks, 19 runs scored and two steals.

DAVALILLO WINS TEXAS LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE MONTH:

Frisco RoughRiders starting pitcher David Davalillo was named Texas League Pitcher of the Month, Minor League Baseball announced on Thursday. The No. 7 prospect in the Rangers organization made five starts over the month, going 1-1 with a 1.82 ERA. Over his 24.2 innings, he struck out 23 while walking eight and surrendering only 17 hits. Opponents hit .191 against him and he totaled a 1.01 WHIP. The highlight of his month came against Midland on August 14th when he poured in 7.0 shutout innings, striking out one batter and ceding only three hits in a 4-1 Frisco win.

CAULEY'S HISTORIC NIGHT LEADS TO PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARD:

The RoughRiders witnessed an incredible night from Cam Cauley against the Hooks on August 19th, when he tied a franchise record with three home runs. He tied his career-best with four RBIs as well. It was the fifth time in franchise history that a RoughRiders player has hit three home runs in a game and the fifth time in Double-A this season that a player hit three home runs in a game. He followed it up with another home run on Wednesday, giving him four home runs in the first two games of the series. In three games, he is 7-for-11 and has increased his season OPS from .696 to .742. He was placed on the 7-Day Injued List, retroactive to August 22nd.

#### ROTATION ROTATING:

With the RoughRiders' recent promotions of **Trey Supak** and **Ben Anderson** and the trade of **Mitch Bratt**, Frisco only has one remaining starter from the opening rotation of the year (**Josh Stephan**). In 26 August games, Frisco had a 3.48 ERA for starters which was second in the league. **Jose Corniell** (20.0 IP, 1 ER) and **David Davalillo** (46.2 IP, 11 ER) have been incredible to start their Double-A careers.

#### THE BOYS ARE PICKIN' IT:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on defense this season, owning the best fielding percentage (.983) in the Texas League while committing the fewest errors (80). After committing 20 errors in the first month of the season, Frisco owns a .984 fielding percentage since May 1st, which is the third-best in Double-A.

#### WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

#### WALLY'S WORLD:

Rangers top prospect Sebastian Walcott has been incredible for a 19-year-old in Double-A. This season, his walk rate of 12.4 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 20.5 percent, a career low. By stealing his 30th base on September 4th, he joined an exclusive group as one of the only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A, joining Elvis Andrus (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott became the first Texas League teenager to have double-digit homers and 30-plus steals since Roberto Alomar in 1987 (12 HR, 43 SB with Wichita). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively.

-Mills Godwin High School in Virginia, where he helped guide the Eagles to a VHSL state finals berth during his 2019 junior season. Same high school as former RoughRiders pitcher and current Major Leaguer Reed Garrett.

-College of Southern Idaho. Was named Region 18 Pitcher of the year and NJCAA All-American after leading the country with 16.0~K/9. His junior season, he went 8-3 with a 2.04~ERA and set single-season record with 118~K at CSI over his 66.1~IP.

-Before being drafted by the Rangers, he was committed to transfer to Virginia Commonweath University (VCU) for baseball.

-Enjoys fishing, playing basketball and eating sushi in his free time.

#### **2025 SEASON**

-Dominated for High-A Hub City, owning a 1.15 ERA over 15 outings.

-Among those who threw at least 50 innings in the South Atlantic League, he led the league in ERA (1.15) and batting average against (.147), while he was third in strikeout rate (33.6%), second in WHIP (0.84), and second in LOB rate (82.3%).

-As a starting pitcher with Hub City, he went 0.2 with a 0.74 ERA over nine starts while holding opponents to a .128 batting average. As a reliever, he owned a 2.00 ERA in six appearances.

-In his last nine games (six starts) with Hub City, he owned a 0.83 ERA, striking out 48 to 12 walks in 32.2 innings while allowing just a .118 batting average.

#### **2024 SEASON**

-Spent all season with Low-A Down East Wood Ducks as a swingman. As a starter, owne 7.01 ERA while he garnered a 3.00 ERA as a reliever.

#### **2023 SEASON**

-Made pro debut after draft, throwing 3.1 scoreless innings with eight strikeouts for ACL Rangers.
